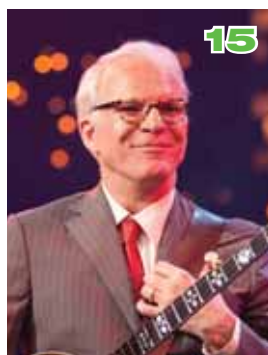

Making a Difference

Recently WCTE's CEO Becky Magura and Mark Dudney went to Washington, accompanied by UCBC member Joe Albrecht, to put a face on the issue of public television funding and how critical it is for our region and for WCTE. A fly on the wall may have heard this...

WCTE is the Upper Cumberland's premier storyteller. There are 360 stations across the country that fill the same role - capturing the culture, history and promise of communities that make America great.

Beyond the programming, WCTE is impacting lives in education, economic development and health care.

A partnership with 22 Head Start centers in this rural region of Tennessee provides on-site educational opportunities for parents, teachers, and child care providers. Recently, WCTE worked with Susan G. Komen for the Cure in the Upper Cumberland and conducted workshops on breast health awareness at all of our 22 Head Start centers, as well as offering information for free mammograms from our regional hospital.

As a result of these workshops, two women were detected with early stage breast cancer. These women had never had a mammogram.

What if WCTE had not been there?

What has made this country great, and continues to make

it great, are the communities that make up the whole. We are a nation of diversity in families, in cultures, in food, in tradition and in business. We have a public broadcasting system that reflects all of this. Each individual PBS station in this country serves a very distinct population. Each station is involved in that community, going far beyond the programming. Each station assists community partners to improve the lives of citizens. It is a public media structure that is unique and has been extremely successful for over 40 years. It accomplishes all of this with minimal federal investment.

That minimal federal investment creates the "lifeline" of public broadcasting and provides critical seed money to leverage a 6 to 1 return.

How's that for a successful public/private partnership?

And we achieve that 6 to 1 return that for only 100th of 1% of the federal budget. That is a penny for out of every \$1000 invested.

One penny.

Is it worth a penny to lose everything that public broadcasting has to offer? Is it worth 100th of 1% to lose public broadcasting?

Seventy percent of Americans say NO!

Let us stand together. Public broadcasting is an investment that is worth making. It was worth making yesterday. It is worth making today and tomorrow. Public broadcasting is on-air, online and on the ground, contributing to the lives of people in every community in America.

Let's keep it that way.

The federal investment that is under debate represents 40% of WCTE's budget and it creates the very foundation that allows our station to serve our communities.

Our station airs programming from PBS but also produces over 200 hours of local content per year AND is currently distributing eight locally produced award winning programs and series for a national audience.

UPDATE

The U.S. House of Representatives recently passed a bill that eliminated all federal funding for public broadcasting. Today, Congress is considering a compromise bill that preserves the vast majority of this funding critical to your local public radio and television stations. Corporation for Public Broadcasting funding went from being completely eliminated to now receiving a 0.2 percent cut in the Continuing Resolution (CR).

Who changed the mind of Congress? You did. Thanks to you, members of Congress realized how essential public broadcasting is to our communities and to their constituents. You spoke up and Congress listened – and for that we say thank you!

Our work is not done. Public broadcasting funding will again be a target when debate on the FY12 budget begins later this week and we will need you to act again to protect this vital public service.

We encourage you to choose 20 people you know care about public broadcasting. We will need millions of advocates across the country to make sure funding for public broadcasting is safe in the coming months.

Historic Milestone for WCTE

Thanks to the Corporation for Public Broadcasting, upgrades have made it possible for WCTE to now reach over 1.3 million viewers in Middle Tennessee and Southern Kentucky.

Recently WCTE-TV doubled the strength of its broadcast signal thanks to a new transmitter and digital antenna, made possible by a grant from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting.

Approximately 33% of television viewers within WCTE's broadcast area use antennas. Those antenna users who could only receive a weak signal before should now be able to pick up a clearer, stronger signal. Cable viewers will also benefit as cable companies

receive their signal from WCTE's antenna transmission.

"What a long way we've come," said Steve Boots, former WCTE CEO, former Upper Cumberland Broadcast Council Board Member and current co-host of WCTE's broadcast of the Smithville Fiddlers' Jamboree.

"I remember when we used to go into people's homes and adjust their coat hanger antennas so they could receive our signal. It pleases me that with the increased signal strength, more people can receive the

programming I've enjoyed for many years."

One of the smallest PBS stations in the country, WCTE makes a big impact, producing more local programming than many of the larger PBS stations. Over 1.3 million viewers in Middle Tennessee and Southern Kentucky have access to WCTE via antenna, cable TV and Dish & Direct networks.

"It would be a shame," said Boots, "if the federal funding dried up and we could not continue our mission."



The counties and parts of counties inside the circle indicate WCTE's antenna and cable reach. The other counties on the map have access to WCTE on the Dish and Direct satellite networks. More than 1,300,000 viewers in over 55 counties in Middle Tennessee and Southern Kentucky have access to WCTE.

the Komen Reach Project



WCTE is proud to partner with the Komen Upper Cumberland Affiliate to create and launch the "Komen Reach" project. This 2011-2012 on-air, in-print and online campaign is designed to help alert women about the importance of a yearly mammogram, early detection and breast health awareness, and increase our region's knowledge of the Komen Upper Cumberland Affiliate grant program.

Each grant recipient project manager will be taught how to use a flip video camcorder and digital social media to tell their stories. Those stories will be presented through a social media network.

The "Komen Reach" project will combine all of the elements of the Komen Upper Cumberland Affiliate's efforts to eradicate breast cancer in our regions, showcasing actions, results and experiences.

WCTE will also produce, promote and broadcast an hour-long program focusing on the campaign, which will feature the grant recipients, their individual projects, stories, Komen events and the work of this most worthy of organizations in the Upper Cumberland.

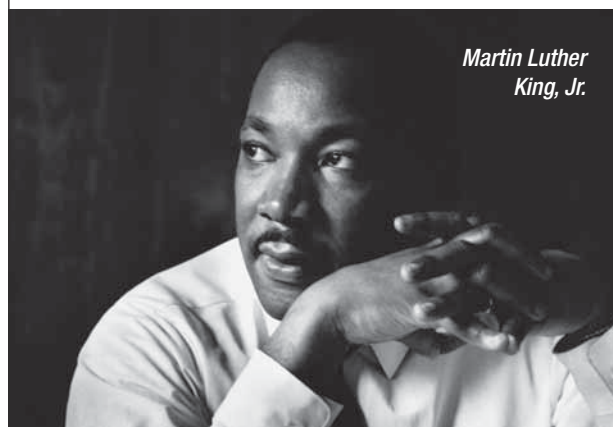

"We were never concerned with who killed Martin Luther King, but what killed Martin Luther King," says former King aide Andrew Young in this film, which tells the wildly disparate yet fatefully entwined stories of an assassin, James Earl Ray, and his target, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., against the backdrop of the seething and turbulent forces in American society that led these two men to their violent and tragic collision in Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968. Based on the book by Hampton Sides (Ghost Soldiers), the program relies on eyewitness testimony from King's inner circle and the officials involved in Ray's capture and prosecution following an intense two-month international manhunt.

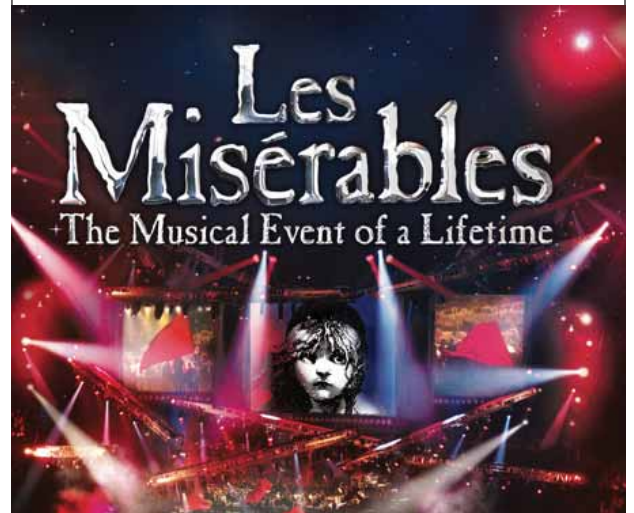

Freedom Riders in Nashville

American Experience presents **Freedom Riders**

Broadcast Marks 50th Anniversary of Original Freedom Rides.
Premieres Monday, May 16

From award-winning filmmaker Stanley Nelson (*Wounded Knee*, *Jonestown: The Life and Death of Peoples Temple*, *The Murder of Emmett Till*) comes *Freedom Riders*, the powerful, harrowing and ultimately inspirational story of six months in 1961 that changed America forever. From May until November 1961, more than 400 black and white Americans risked their lives—and many endured savage beatings and imprisonment—for simply traveling together on buses and trains as they journeyed through the Deep South. Deliberately violating Jim Crow laws, the Freedom Riders' belief in non-violent activism was sorely tested as mob violence and bitter racism greeted them along the way. *Freedom Riders* features testimony from a fascinating cast of central characters: the Riders themselves, state and federal government officials, and journalists who witnessed the rides firsthand. Produced, written and directed by Nelson, *Freedom Riders* premieres on the PBS series *AMERICAN EXPERIENCE* on Monday, May 16, 2011 at 9:00 p.m. ET.

"I got up one morning in May and I said to my folks at home, 'I won't be back today

because I'm a Freedom Rider.' It was like a wave or a wind that you didn't know where it was coming from or where it was going, but you knew you were supposed to be there." — Pauline Knight-Ofoso, Freedom Rider

Despite two earlier Supreme Court decisions that mandated the desegregation of interstate travel facilities, black Americans in 1961 continued to endure hostility and racism while traveling through the South. The newly inaugurated Kennedy administration,

embroiled in the Cold War and worried about the nuclear threat, did little to address domestic civil rights.

"It became clear that the civil rights leaders had to do something desperate, something dramatic to get Kennedy's attention. That was the idea behind the Freedom Rides—to dare the federal government to do what it was supposed to do, and see if their constitutional rights would be protected by the Kennedy administration," explains Raymond Arsenault, author of *Freedom Riders: 1961 and the Struggle for Racial Justice*, on which the film is partially based.

The self-proclaimed "Freedom Riders" came from all strata of American society—black and white, young and old, male and female, northern and southern. They embarked on the rides knowing the danger but firmly committed to the ideals of non-violent protest, aware that their actions could provoke a savage response but willing to put their lives on the line for the cause of justice.

Each time the Freedom Riders met violence and the campaign seemed doomed, new ways were found to sustain and even expand the movement. After Klansmen in Alabama set fire to an original Freedom Ride bus, student activists from Nashville organized a ride of their own.

"We were past fear. If we were going to die, we were gonna die, but we can't stop," recalls Rider Joan Trumpauer-Mulholland. "If one person falls, others take their place."

The Riders' journey was front-page news and the world was watching. After nearly five months of fighting, the federal government capitulated. On September 22, the Interstate Commerce Commission issued its order to end the segregation in bus and rail stations that had been in place for generations.

"*Freedom Riders* tells the story of an overlooked piece of not only civil rights history but American history," says Mark Samels, executive producer of *AMERICAN EXPERIENCE*.
