The Composer

Deemed “indisputably unique, confident, and innovative” through the American Prize, Paul John Rudoi’s work stems from a deeply rooted passion for connecting innate human values and universal experiences. Frequently supported through grant programs from the American Composers Forum, the Minnesota State Arts Board, the Metropolitan Regional Arts Council, and the Jerome Foundation, Paul’s award-winning music has been commissioned and performed by various ensembles including Cantus, VocalEssence, the Vancouver Chamber Singers, the British Trombone Society, the Young New Yorkers Chorus, the Milwaukee Choral Artists, and the National Lutheran Choir.

Paul holds a degree in vocal performance from the Hartt School. He has performed and recorded as a tenor vocalist in the male vocal ensemble Cantus.




