(Shadow Work was originally only done by hand, Suzanne's patented technique duplicates handwork in that all the color under the fabric shadowing through the fabric is the machine threads themselves, including the outline on top of the fabric. You never have to hoop your fabric and it's easier to do than regular embroidery.)

Nancy L. Burgess

Seamstress, embroiderer, teacher, wife and mom. Nancy has been "creating" fabric art for more than thirty years. She has sewn and crafted just about everything there is in the field of sewing. She has taught both business and creative seminars all over the continental U.S. Ishabibbel, Inc is the wonderful company that Nancy expresses herself through. 
