Journal

Sunday morning I was greeted with: "Who sent out that great card?" If you make your home on Fox Island or in Cromwell, Arletta, or maybe another postal route near the Island you probably found a colorful, eye-catching card in your mail box recently. An invitation to Holy Week services at FIUCC. So how did those cards arrive in local mail boxes?

A group of people who came together during the final Appreciative Inquiry Retreat, in September, focused on the area of Welcome. This group chose to continue meeting. They became an off shoot of the Board of Deacons. Chaired by Jacque Burdette and Tom Morberg it was the brain child of the Welcome Group to mail community invitations. Tom Morberg, John Tupper, and Jacque Burdette were the primary shepherds of the project. There have been a number of positive comments so we know they were in local mailboxes in time for people to plan for Holy Week. In addition to Tom, John and Jacque's contribution, one of our new folks, Holly Newman Dyzban, a professional editor, shared her expertise. Thank you all! Also, thanks go out to Women's Fellowship for a generous donation that got the ball rolling, as well as a few enthusiastic donors.

I appreciate that it is not just an Easter mailing; it is an invitation to Holy Week services including Palm Sunday. We are familiar with Jesus riding into town on a colt or donkey as the crowd shouts *Hosanna in the Highest*, so we wave palms and shout Hosanna on Palm Sunday. What is sometimes forgotten is that coming from the opposite direction the Roman governor approached Jerusalem on a war horse with soldiers as a show of domination. Jesus reflects the words of the prophet Zechariah who announces that the Prince of Peace will ride in on a foal. Palm Sunday is an introduction of things to come throughout the week, throughout the Passover Holiday. It sets the stage for a collision between God's will of peace and grace in the world and the powers of the state.

We know how the story goes yet when we are able to be present for the bitter days before Christ's resurrection we make a statement that we believe God is with us always. We believe that nothing, neither life nor death, or powers or principalities can ever separate us from the love of God. That in the pain and sorrow of the world the one thing that never changes is God's love is steadfast. In the end love wins.

We have a story of great magnitude to share. As we invite friends and neighbors known and unknown, we share the story that through it all the Light lives on. Together we share a week of darkness and light with the promise of Divine Hope – Easter Morning.

Debenture Investment Opportunity

Periodically folks ask when there will be another opportunity to buy debentures. That time is now!

Debentures are the promissory notes that we as a congregation use instead of a building mortgage. This program started in 2004 as a replacement for a standard building mortgage. Our total has slowly crept down from an original level of \$252,668 to its current level of \$171,000 in ten years. We offer debentures to members of the congregation at very competitive investment rates and still finance the building at interest levels that are cheaper than a more traditional mortgage.

Most of this year's investors chose to roll their debenture over at a new rate. One couple chose to cash in their debentures so we have \$15,000 available for purchase on a six year note at 2 ½% paid in February and August of each year. In the history of the program we have never failed to pay interest when it was due. Notes are available starting at \$1000.




