Do you have a student who is going to CIY with us this year and you forgot or wasn't able to make the meeting on Tuesday night? No worries. I want to take a moment and share with you a few things that still needs to be done in order for your student to be fully registered and prepared for CIY this year. If you have a student attending MIX this year, your meeting is this week, but the majority of the month's newsletter will apply to you as well!

There are a few very important details that you need to make sure is complete before your student is ready to roll with us. That is:

Paying the remaining balance (\$150 with community service hours/\$250 without).

Online CIY medical release form & TCCC parent waiver form.

Schedule for the whole week.

A lot of students still owe the remaining balance for their camp. Like mentioned above, we try to make camp as affordable as we can. If your student completes 8 hours of community service, we will in return pay \$100 of their camp fee. It is not required that community service is done with TCCC. For all community service hours, you will need to fill out the community service form that is located in my office. If you could pay the remaining balance for CIY as soon as possible, that would be greatly appreciated.

It is required, by CIY, that all students have a completed online medical release form. There are no hard copies of this form. If you need to find the right form for your student, then visit this website: carpenterschristian.church/students-ciy/. There you will find ample amounts of information about CIY MOVE and MIX. All TCCC parent waiver forms will be completed the night that we load up the trailer.

There are 3 very important times to make sure you are aware of as a parent for CIY. The first, Trailer Load Up. We will load the trailer, for each camp, the Sunday before we leave for camp at 6:30 pm in the parking lot. Secondly, on Monday morning, we will meet at TCCC at 8:30 am to prepare for departure. Lastly, we will return on Friday night with your students. Typically, we pull into the church parking lot around 1:30 am. We will remind you of these times as your students camp gets closer!

We are excited for CIY this year. We hope you are too. If you would, pray for us before, during, and after CIY this year. As of right now, we will be taking a group of 85 to CIY MOVE and MIX this year. This is a huge week for our students that can shape and mold their foundation with

Mark 2: 3-5 Jesus Heals a Paralytic

I read this Scripture recently and started to think about this wonderful story. A sick, paralytic man needed healing. I marvel that he had four friends who were determined that Jesus would touch their friend. They couldn't take him through the door because of the crowd, so they went on the roof and tore off enough tiles to lower the mat the paralyzed man was lying on into the house where Jesus was preaching.

I thought about how they must have lowered the man on his mat . . . probably with ropes or cords . . . *what cords of love.* Persistence. Four men who **knew** bringing their friend to Jesus would help him.

I'm surprised Jesus didn't call those friends out for vandalizing the roof . . . but the Scriptures say that is not what Jesus saw. When Jesus looked up He saw **their faith** . . . the faith of four friends who were, in spite of all obstacles, bringing their needy friend to Him. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven" . . . and he was healed.

We live in a world where people are hurting. They need someone to bring them to Jesus. To lay them and their situation, whatever it may be, before Jesus because **we know** Jesus can help them. Everyone needs stretcher bearers like these . . . friends who will carry you when you are at your weakest, friends who not only will pray for you but will do whatever it takes to help you get back on your feet. Dolls of HOPE

TCCC Dolls of HOPE Ministry gather together each month making dolls for children in Harrodsburg and Danville hospitals, Family Protective Services, and the Harrodsburg Police Department. We meet on the 4th

Tuesday of every month January-October at 10 am. God continues to bless this ministry. Our goal is to make over 400 dolls this year. We average 15-25 people each month gathering together sewing, stuffing dolls, and enjoy each other's company. We enjoy a potluck meal each time and also share prayer concerns and have a devotional time.

We have expanded our projects this year to make 200 stuffed bears for boys, underarm pillows for cancer patients, and throws for patients in nursing homes. We also are continuing to ask help with the knitted or loomed toboggans that will help those in need during the cold winter months. You can also help us with this project by making toboggans at home during your spare time.

We use donated and left over fabric to make quilts for Haven Care Pregnancy Center, MCES, Galilean Home, and Thompson VA Center. This year our goal is to make 100 quilts. **Dolls of HOPE Quilting meet the 1st Monday of each month at 10 am.** We are always in need of 100% cotton fabric for the dolls and quilts.

We will continue to collect can goods and non-perishable food items for the Christian Life Center throughout the year. You can help participate in this project by placing your donations in the basket provided in the front lobby. If you have any questions contact:
