




WE JOURNEY THROUGH LENT WITH CRS RICE BOWL:

Trying New Foods in Timor-Leste

Timor-Leste has the highest rate of child malnutrition in Asia and many children suffer from stunting, which makes a big impact on a child's growth and future. With training from Catholic Relief Services, families are starting home gardens to grow different vegetables, beans, and other foods that are rich in nutrients like vitamin A and iron. The gardens are built to withstand droughts and flooding, and the families add the food they grow—such as spinach, cabbage, peanuts, carrots and tomatoes—to their daily rice staple, providing more nourishing meals that help children grow and stay healthy. PASTORAL PLANNING UPDATE: Responding to Bishop Matano's letter of June 4, 2020 urging significant progress be made in developing and implementing a pastoral plan for Auburn and Northern Cayuga County and at the request of Fr. Lioi and Fr. Gathenya, the pastoral planning committee for Auburn and Northern Cayuga County has been meeting since last fall to consider and identify the churches and facilities that will be needed to best sustain a vibrant Catholic community. This committee, made up of representatives of each of the churches in our region, is helping us confront the very real challenges facing our Catholic community today and into the future. The committee will be presenting their preliminary findings and plans to the parish and finance councils in a webinar on March 11th followed by an informational session in early April for all parishioners. After considering input received, the committee will finalize their recommendations before submitting them to our pastors in early May. Please pray the Holy Spirit will continue to guide these important and difficult deliberations.

Honoring the Blessed Trinity on St. Patrick's Day

The Shamrock, Seamóg or Seamair Óg, (Irish for clover) are linked to St. Patrick. It is said Saint Patrick used the three leaved Shamrock to explain the concept of the Holy Trinity, (the Father, Son and Holy Spirit), to the pagan Irish during the 5th Century. The Blessed Trinity is a core belief in the Catholic Faith. The Catholic Church teaches us that God invites every human being into the inner life of the Trinity. We become a part of it in receiving baptism. As our faith grows, we grow closer to being a part of the Trinity as we serve God and help our fellow man.
