



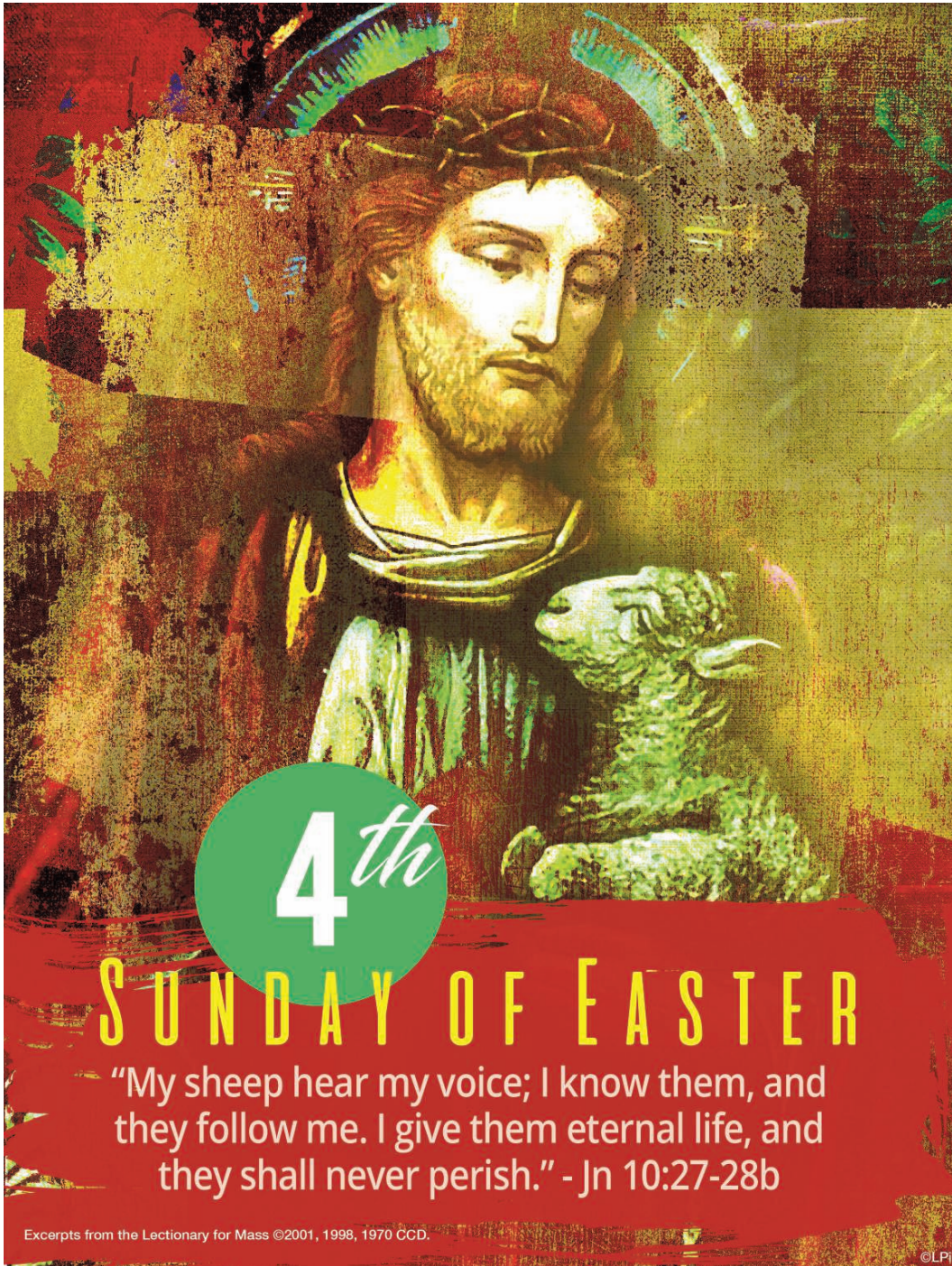

Reading I: Acts 13:14, 43-52 (Paul's and Barnabas' address to the Gentiles)
Reading II: Revelation 7:9, 14-17 (rejoicing of the elect of every nation)
Gospel: John 10:27-30 (words at the feast of the dedication of the temple)

Belonging in the Sheepfold

Jesus' words in the Gospel of Jn 10:27-30 are filled with divine promises for the sheep - his followers: "I give them eternal life; they shall never perish; no one can take them out of my hand." These are strong words of ownership from Jesus, that those who hear his voice and follow him will surely not go unrewarded.

Christ identified His Sheep as those who listen to His voice and understand it. To identify the voice of Jesus places us in His sheepfold. The question is how do we hear and identify His voice?

We abide by His voice when we allow ourselves to be guided by the Word of God rather than our personal desires especially when they conflict with the Word of Christ. The sheep of Christ is not a double standard, Christian or a Christian only by convenience. If we are willing to listen to Him only when His teachings align with our ideologies, thoughts and philosophies, but separate from Him when they differ, we become followers by convenience. With such a mentality we cannot be in His sheepfold.

To be in his sheepfold is to trust Him completely, to listen to Him in our various vocations in life and to allow ourselves to be guided by the principles of our faith.

Seton Habitat 2019 Build Update #7

Mother Nature was not cooperating on Seton's fourth Habitat build in Wylie in which Seton was participating with six other Collin County Catholic churches. The last Seton build day was April 6th in which we were rained out for one-half of the day. The following Saturday (the 13th), was St. Gabriel's day to volunteer – and it was rained out. The next Saturday (the 20th), all churches took off that day because it was Holy Saturday, and it was a sunny day. Wednesday the 24th was an open day for anyone to volunteer, and it was rained out. We finally caught a weather break on the 27th, which was St. Anthony's turn to supply the volunteers.

Since Seton's last build date of April 6th, Habitat of Collin County was able to get the roof on (in spite of the recent weather). This enabled them to get the plumbing lines and shower enclosures installed in the house.

The major tasks for the day included:

- Installing the soffit (the underside of the roof overhang);
- Caulking around the windows, soffit, and any other place where required; and
- Installing the folding stairs that lead to the attic.

St. Anthony arranged for a great lunch of fajitas, dessert and drinks.

Rick: St. Elizabeth Ann Seton became a part of my faith journey over 30 years ago when Fr. I found a way to use music to connect with others and help the Holy Spirit shine through the Agape Praise & Worship ministry and choir ministry. I continually encounter Jesus and the Holy Spirit alive and stirring in the inmates we serve through the Kolbe Retreat Prison ministry. The Men's Club and Knights of Columbus provide me with even more opportunities to serve.

SEAS parishioners truly are "Building God's Kingdom in Faith Through Service". I am glad SEAS is our parish home. It has helped make me a better man. My marriage, family, and life are better for it.

Karla: St. Elizabeth Ann Seton has felt like home to me since Rick and I married here in 1986. Although we were not parishioners, we were welcomed and embraced by the community as we began our life together. Later, after spending eight years in Delaware, we moved home to Texas in 1995, and there was no doubt about which parish we wanted to join. I began teaching second grade faith formation classes and our three children received their First Communion at Seton. We also became involved in leading a Seton neighborhood small faith



group that allowed us to build relationships with others in the parish community. As Seton grew, so did we as we became more involved in the life of the parish.

I had considered attending a Seton ACTS Retreat many times over the years and finally in October of 2014, I put my excuses aside and signed up. The retreat was a profoundly healing experience that helped me to connect more deeply with my faith and to feel the embrace of God through the wonderful loving people who serve in ACTS ministry at Seton. Rick and I also enjoyed the Living Your Strengths program where we explored our unique strengths and how we can best use them to enrich our spiritual lives and build up the community of faith at Seton and beyond. I recommend that everyone take advantage of this wonderful ministry at Seton.

I feel so blessed to be a part of the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton community and look forward to many more years of building deep and lasting friendships with the extraordinary people here.

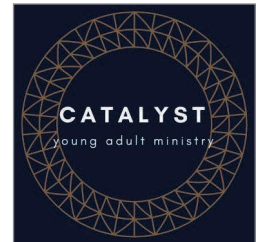

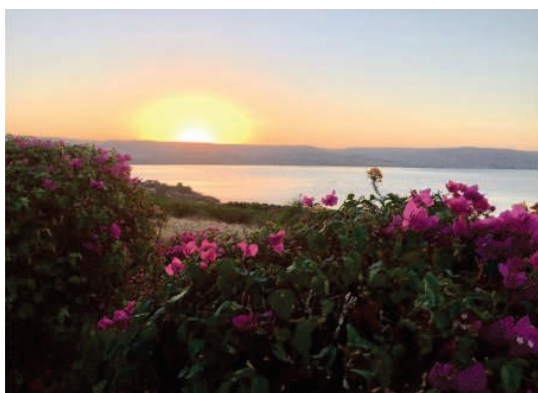
