SPLINTERS FROM THE BOARD

May 11, 2015

- ⇒ The Board met on May 11 and approved as presented all documents, financials, and reports.
- ⇒ The April average attendance was 385 which was bolstered by the Easter attendance.
- ⇒ Christian Education will honor graduates on May 31st. VBS is August 2-6 from 6-8 p.m.. Sunday School singing started on May 3rd for 10 minutes each Sunday with the children singing in worship once a quarter. Parents are encouraged to send an offering with the children for Sunday School. Children will be allowed to play in the gym during Sunday School from 9:45 to 10 with class being from 9-9:45 and 10-10:15 More supplies will be ordered. A training session was held for teachers on the AV equipment. Revised Safety Procedures were distributed.
- ⇒ Bright Beginnings Daycare reported one employee was let go due to violations of protocol. Wording in the Employee Handbook was strengthened. The State Inspection on March 31 went very well. Gifts were purchased for Teacher Appreciation Week. New tuition charges were approved to begin in August. Playground equipment has been donated and volunteers are installing it.
- ⇒ Exterior Property is having a work day on May 16 at 8 a.m. to install mulch and pull weeds. Shrubs around the external bell-tower light are being removed. New hoses are being purchased. Wayne Hunt removed dead trees at Centarbor. Fuse boxes there will be labeled. Three shrubs have been donated to the Memorial Garden for Larry Hundley and one tree in memory of Betty Dickerson.
- ⇒ Interior Property reinstated Ajax Exterminators for pest control. Dishwasher repaired and new water heater installed for kitchen. It was approved to replace the Fellowship Hall floor.
- ⇒ Joy Ministries served the XYZ luncheon. The ladies will be serving the Reading Club luncheons.
- ⇒ Membership Cmt. reported that 122 children were assigned to 65 adults to be Prayer Buddies. About 75 people attended the New Member Dinner. The committee will do an ice cream social the evening of the Kingsman Concert on Sept. 19.
- ⇒ Stewardship Cmt. met and discussed their roles and budget items.
- ⇒ Youth Cmt. decided that the youth groups will continue to meet all summer. Numbers have doubled in both groups in the recent weeks. Jr. High will now meet at the same time as Sr. High. Scarlet Raven concert has been booked again for August Back to School Event. Revisions to the Children and Youth Handbook were reversed to the original standings. The group will work with Christian Ed to honor the graduates. Promotion Sunday is Sept. 6th. The youth will help Evangelism Cmt. with a Prayer Walk. The youth will assist with the Mother/Daughter Banquet. Once a quarter the youth will lead worship. 30 Hour Famine is on track. Mission Trip for Sr. High and Mix event for Jr. High are proceeding.

MCC CHRISTIAN EDUCATION SUMMER POLICY



The committee will pay for half the cost of camp per child, up to \$110. For example, if a family pays \$140 for one child to attend a week of camp, Christian Education will reimburse them \$70. If a family pays \$250 for one child to attend a week of camp, Christian Education will reimburse them \$110 since that is the maximum amount allowed. If a family chooses to send a child to camp more than one time, Christian Education will only cover half the cost of one camp visit. If a family sends multiple children to camp, Christian Education will reimburse half for each child up to the \$110 each. To be reimbursed, please submit a signed green form with a copy of the receipt. Forms can be found in the church office.

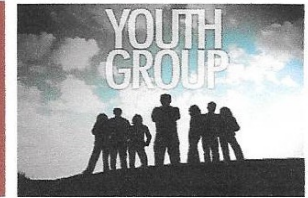
