Integrating ERPsim and SAP® into the COB curriculum

Synopsis: As more and more data travel through the wire, there is increasing demands for faster analytics to master the data and integrate it for accurate business decision making. This situation has brought some of the important decision making tasks down to the level of the middle managers. Recent research claims that over 64% of middle managers are being asked to run some sort of advanced and complex queries and further organize the data to help in the business decision making process. This assignment can be stressful if one is not prepared and had no prior knowledge of analytics and data processing in a fast-paced environment.

For decades, business schools have used simulation tools to give their graduates a near real life flavor of the subjects they are learning. These simulations' goal is to equip new graduates with the tools that would help mitigate with the above situation.

In this session, we are going to experience ERPsim in action and discuss how to integrate the tool in our courses.

ERPsim is a unique business simulation technology developed at HEC Montréal that enables the simulation of near-real-life business contexts of large corporate information systems. There are other simulation games which allow you to take a strategic view of an enterprise, but ERPsim is closely coupled with SAP® so participants have to use a real ERP system like they would in a real context.

ERPsim Development Team has trained over 1000 instructors worldwide to use simulation games for teaching ERP concepts to IT professionals and executives. These instructors are faculty members and instructors at universities and colleges, teaching ERP systems in fields such as Business, Management Information System, Computer Science, Operations Management and Industrial Engineering. So far, ERPsim has been used in more than 170 universities worldwide.

Ferris GO App Maintenance - Tuesday, October 23 @ 5 PM

On Tuesday, October 23 beginning at 5 PM, the middle tier servers that the Ferris GO app connects to will require necessary maintenance. During this time the Ferris GO app will still be available on each device it has been installed on, but most app functionality will be unavailable, including signing in to the app.

It was reported shortly after the start of the Fall 2018 semester that some iOS devices were experiencing intermittent app crashes while signing into the app. A solution has been found and will require multiple application upgrades to the middle tier servers.

The anticipated outage time should be no more than 3 hours, unless upgrade issues occur. The Ferris GO app should be available for use sometime after 8 PM.

Ferris State Hockey Returns To Home Ice Against Mercyhurst This Weekend

Big Rapids, Mich. - The Ferris State University men's ice hockey squad returns home to host the Mercyhurst Lakers this Friday and Saturday, Oct. 19-20, inside the Ewigleben Ice Arena.

The Bulldogs and the Lakers will square off in Big Rapids with a two-game set which coincides with Parents and Family Weekend on the FSU campus. Puck drop both nights is set for 7:07 p.m. (ET) and tickets are on sale now.

Fans can purchase advance tickets for all Bulldog home hockey games to guarantee a seat and save over the normal

gameday rates by visiting the FSU Athletics Ticket Office located inside the Ewingleben Sports Complex. Bulldog fans can also purchase all regular-priced tickets in advance 24 hours a day, seven days a week online at StarTickets.com or by calling 1-800-585-3737.

The FSU Athletic Ticket Office's normal business hours are Monday thru Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (ET) with extended hours on Wednesday until 7 p.m. (ET).

Overall, FSU has posted more than 25 total sellouts at the Ewingleben Ice Arena since the second half of a historic 2011-12 campaign in which the Bulldogs reached the national championship game at the NCAA Frozen Four.

The Bulldogs, who have reached the NCAA Final Eight three times since 2012, are in their 44th campaign this fall and again face perhaps one of the country's toughest schedules as they seek their fourth trip to the NCAA Tournament in the last eight years.

The 2018-19 schedule is again highlighted by matchups against nearly every other in-state Division I opponent from Michigan, including non-conference showdowns against Michigan State and Western Michigan. Both will make the trek to FSU's Ewingleben Ice Arena as part of home-and-home showdowns.

Along with the premier matchups against the in-state foes, the Bulldogs will also entertain challenging conference rivals such as Minnesota State, Michigan Tech and Bowling Green as part of a 18-game regular-season home schedule.

Since 2012, the Bulldogs have made three NCAA Tournament appearances and advanced to the NCAA Final Eight all three times. FSU has also won two conference regular-season championships along with capturing the WCHA's Broadmoor Trophy once as the league's Final Five Champion. Along with a Frozen Four berth and national title game showing in 2012, FSU also has reached the regional final and the final eight of the NCAA Tournament in both 2014 and 2016.
