This is a three-step process

- 1. Fill out the application online and pay processing fee online
- 2. Send your application to Gbile Adewunmi in Indiana no later than Sat. 9/21/2013
- 3. Appear IN PERSON for processing on 10/4/2013 or 10/5/2013

FILLING OUT AND THE ONLINE APPLICATION

Step 1 – Online Application

- A. Click on the E-Passport application hyperlink below https://portal.immigration.gov.ng/passport/epassport
- B. For the Passport type drop down box, select "STANDARD PASSPORT", and click Start Application.
 - Fill in all the required information
 - Processing Country is "United States"
 - Processing Embassy is "New York"
 - Click the "I accept full responsibility for the information provided in this form" check box.
 - Double-check your information!!
 - Click the Submit Application button
 - Print out the completed form (2 copies), then sign and date your application
 - Minors should not sign, they will be thumb-printed

STEP 2

In the next page click "Print Acknowledgment Slip" and print.

STEP 3

- Then click "Proceed to online Payment"
- At this point, you will need to create a Gmail account, if you don't already have one. You can create one at http://www.gmail.com
- Only Credit/Debit card payment is acceptable for online application
- The cost is \$65.00 for each passport application
- Payment is done via "Google Checkout"





E-Passport in Indianapolis Event

- Use your Gmail username and password to sign into Google Checkout
- After paying at Google Checkout. You must wait a minimum of "1hr 24 hrs" before a receipt is available for printing

STEP 4

- After 1hr to 24 hours, go to https://portal.immigration.gov.ng/Payments/ApplicationsPayments.aspx
- And type in your Application # and Reference # available on the "Acknowledgment Slip" printed previously
- Print your Payment Receipt and updated Acknowledgement Slip
- All applicants must conform to all the 4 steps above for the online application to be considered complete


1. Completed Passport Application Form (signed and dated – remember that minors should not sign as they will be thumb-printed)

2. Payment Receipt and Acknowledgement Slips from Nigeria Immigration Website

3. Your email and phone number on a separate sheet of paper for further communications

Notes

- Forms MUST be received no later than Saturday September 21
- Applicants in the same area are encouraged to work together to send one package to Indiana
- If you mail your forms, please use Fed Ex, UPS or Priority Mail with a tracking number
- Your forms, in addition to all those collected in Indiana will be sent to the Nigerian Consulate in New York in one package





APPEARING FOR PROCESSING

Officials from the Nigerian Consulate in New York will be in Indiana for the processing from Friday October 4 to Saturday October 5 2013.

- 1. All applicants **MUST** appear in person for processing
- 2. All applicants must bring a \$60 money order payable to the Consulate General of Nigeria NY
- 3. You can sign up for a processing time slot **ONLY** after you submit your application
- 4. A final schedule will be emailed to qualified applicants by Saturday September 27th

Additional Documentation to bring to your Processing date

Minors

- Signed letter of authorization from BOTH PARENTS signatures should match the signatures on their respective passports and names should match those on the child's birth certificate
- Copy of parents' passports
- Copy of the child's birth certificate

Adults

- Non-Nigerian born applicants must provide a copy of the Nigerian passport and letter of authorization from a Nigerian parent that appears on his/her birth certificate as right of citizenship
- Applicant's birth certificate
