Discipleship

We're excited to announce a Discipleship opportunity for anyone in our church that would like to participate. Starting on Wednesday night Oct. 7th we will be offering a study called 4 Chair Discipleship. You may have asked the question at some point in your spiritual journey as to, "How does one go from seeking truth about Jesus to knowing Him AND making disciples in His name? That's what this study will address. And don't worry...it's none of our opinions or guesses-it comes right from the Bible & material endorsed by Independent Christian Churches and Churches of Christ.

The International Conference on Missions (which used to be our Missionary Convention) commissioned a Bible teacher to put a process together that would help us better disciple our people and help them to disciple others. Dann Spader of Global Youth Initiative and Sonlife Ministries embraced the challenge and studied Jesus' teachings. He claims that Christ encountered people who were at different stages of maturity as Christians and He challenged them all to move to the next level.

So, our goal will be to provide a clear, succinct, and sustainable model for all of us to work through the process. While I've been a part of discipleship for years, teaching classes, groups and Bible studies I don't think I have ever led one that was focused primarily on discipleship. IF you are interested in this, would you please let us know? We'd like to have a good idea going into it how many to expect and to plan for.

We will meet for 6-weeks and cover topics like Jesus=man and God, our mission and the motive, the method, and concern for the lost. IF we can navigate that far we will take a break for the holidays. Lord willing, we'll return after the first of the year in hopes of completing the discipleship process.

We are really excited about this opportunity! We'll see who God leads to go on this adventure with us. Are you up for the challenge? See you here!




