# Spotlight: Diane Holman



Spotlight features a woman who was definitely born with a huge dose of wanderlust! Her childhood dream of seeing the world has been a major force in her life choices.

Diane grew up in Michigan and her whole family was involved with medicine; father and brother were/are doctors, sister and mother were/are nurses, and she a physical therapist. She was a Wolverine at the University of Michigan and graduated with a BS in Physical Therapy.



After graduation, she married Don, her college sweetheart, and became a Licensed Physical Therapist (LPT). It wasn't long before they embarked on their quest to see the world, which was facilitated by Don's career in the construction industry. In 1977, they made a MAJOR career and lifestyle change. Don went to work for ARAMCO (Arabian American Oil Company) and they moved to Saudi Arabia.

They initially resided in a small company compound remotely located in the Eastern Province. This was close to the ancient oasis of Horuf, which legend recounts may be the site of the Garden of Eden. Diane worked in the dental clinic and they began to enjoy ARAMCO's liberal vacation policy and started traveling the world.
