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TO: ALL BAND STUDENTS AND PARENTS

RE: MUSIC DEPARTMENT PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

Please read the following course requirements to become more familiar with music department policies. The policies were developed to enhance student success and make the band the best it can be. <u>Please sign</u> and return one copy to Mr. Olson by Monday July 31st.

<u>PARTICIPATION/ATTENDANCE</u>: In addition to classroom participation and compliance with instructional requirements, participation also includes: **Mandatory Band Camp (July 31st – August 5th, 8am to 3pm),** performance criteria, in-school rehearsals, out-of-school rehearsals, concerts and graduation.

<u>PERFORMANCE ATTENDANCE</u>: Attendance at all performances is mandatory! Performances include: all football games, Ewing community days, pep rallies, parades, concerts, graduation and all other public performances. Students that do not attend required performances will earn a lower grade. Students and parents are expected to use the enclosed schedule to prevent unexcused student absences.

PERFORMANCE DRESS CODE: All Marching Band performances will be done in **full uniform**. Concert band performances may use either the marching band uniform or the "traditional black and white" concert uniform. This uniform consists of: **Gentlemen-** all black dress pants, an all white (not off white, no polka dots or stripes of any kind) long sleeve (winter concert)/short sleeve (spring concert) dress shirt with a dark non-patterned long tie (preferably black) and all black dress shoes. **Ladies-** all black skirt and an all white top (not off white, no polka dots or stripes of any kind. Tops must have a collar and sleeves) **OR** an all black dress and of course, black dress shoes. Mini skirts, black jeans, sneakers and sandals are prohibited. Students that do not meet the performance dress code will not perform.

<u>SCHOOL SPORTS/ATTENDANCE</u>: Students that participate in fall school sports will alternate between band and the school sport. This alternation will occur anytime there is a marching band performance/rehearsal conflict with a school sport scrimmage, game or practice. The Marching band student may not miss a performance for a sport practice.

ABSENCES/PARENT NOTES: Any absence from a rehearsal or performance requires a parent/guardian note containing the date of the absence, the reason for your child's absence and a phone number where you can be reached. Please submit this note at least 3 days in advance of the absence. Absences caused by illness must be substantiated by a doctor's note. Once the note has been submitted, it will be reviewed by the marching band staff and will either be recorded as an unexcused or an excused absence. The following are examples of some unexcused absences: work conflicts, transportation problems, college trips, vacation, doctor/dentist appts. (except in emergency situations) etc. The following are examples of excused absences: Death in the family, severe illness, school sport (provided you are alternating between band and the sport for each conflict), etc. Please understand that these attendance requirements are necessary to: 1. put a complete band on the field. 2. Eliminate holes in the drill. 3. Provide consistent instrumentation. 4. Enhance student accountability.

<u>GRADING PROCEDURE:</u> Grading will be based upon participation, attendance at band camp, rehearsals and performances, and music performance tests. Students will be tested on all music. All marching band show music must be memorized. Stand music does not need to be memorized. The student must purchase a 10 page flip folder for stand music. Flip folders are mandatory for all students for all rehearsals and performances. During each rehearsal we will work for high caliber musical and marching standards. Emphasis will be placed on cooperation, self-discipline, behavior, following directions and self evaluation of performance.

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<u>BEHAVIOR</u>: Improper behavior will not be tolerated at any time. Students that refuse to cooperate will be dealt with by teacher detention, parent conference or removal from the group. Please follow these common sense rules to promote a positive learning environment: **SIMPLE COMMON COURTESEY!**

- 1. No talking while the director is on the podium.
- 2. No talking while a rehearsal is in progress.
- 3. Immediately upon entering the room, get out instrument and music find your seat. Warm up quietly!
- 4. If you have a question, raise your hand.
- 5. No food or drink in the IMR PLEASE!
- 6. All instruments are to be placed in their respective place in the storage room.
- 7. Do not trade instruments, use the one you are assigned.
- 8. You are responsible for repairing damaged or non-working assigned instrument(s).
- 9. Follow directions given by the director and/or drum majors.
- 10. Have a positive attitude.
- 11. Students that are uncooperative/disruptive or not participating will be removed from the program.
- 12. All students that play reed instruments must supply their own reeds.
- 13. NO CELL PHONES!! They will be confiscated and turned into the office with a write up.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation to all football games, parades, trips or competitions is for EHS Band students and parent chaperones only. No others will be permitted. <u>Students must ride the bus both to and from a location. No exceptions.</u> Please understand that this rule is required for the safety of all students. Students that drive may not "follow the bus" or drive to an event. Transportation is provided to all away football game performances. All students are required to travel <u>seated</u> in their seat with <u>seat belts fastened</u> and act in a manner that will represent Ewing High School positively. Students that cannot follow these guidelines will have their transportation privilege revoked.

FOOTBALL GAME REGULATIONS:

1. Uniforms MUST BE COMPLETELY BUTTONED AND WORN AT ALL TIMES!

2. If the weather is warm, you will be given instructions regarding your uniform by the instructor. Listen and follow directions!

3. The band sits as a unit in sections- perc., band front, trumpets, etc. NO OUTSIDE VISITORS ARE PERMITTED TO SIT WITHIN THE BAND.

4. All band members play all stand music.

- 5. The band only plays as a unit, not as individuals.
- 6. The directors and the drum majors are responsible for choosing the stand tunes. Please stay alert as to which song is being called up.
 - 7. There is no food or drink permitted in the stands at any time.
 - 8. 3rd Quarter Privileges/Break
 - Uniforms must be properly worn.

- <u>You</u> are responsible for your instrument during this time. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR INSTRUMENT IN THE STANDS!

-Stay in groups of at least 3 people.

-Use the restrooms.

-Get a snack.



-<u>Be back in the stands and ready to play by 2:00 left in the 3rd quarter</u>. All food and drink is to be consumed prior to this time. DO NOT BRING FOOD OR DRINK BACK INTO THE STANDS.

9. At the conclusion of each game, we will <u>ALWAYS</u> march to the busses (away games) or to the IMR (home games). When asked to fall in, do so as quickly and quietly as possible.

10. Problem students who do not follow these guidelines will not be tolerated and will be removed from the program.

SPRING TRIP ELIGIBILITY:

1. Students who have earned 3 or more days of out-of-school suspension (OSS) will forfeit their privilege to travel and will not be permitted to participate in the trip.

2. Trip payment dates will be strictly enforced. Payments received after the due date will be returned and the student will not participate in the trip. (*HINT*- Be sure to get involved in the many planned fund raising activities as they are designed to pay for/defray the cost of the trip!)

3. Students who are disruptive/uncooperative and/or not participating in class will have their trip privileges revoked by the instructor. Students who receive 3 or more detentions for the behaviors listed above will lose their privilege to travel.

4. Students must be passing all classes to participate and not have any NCA/attendance problems. Students that are not passing all classes by 1 month prior to the trip will be removed from the trip list
