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## The 19<sup>th</sup> Century

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The industrial development led to great changes in our world and the invention of the automobile, steamboats and railways were significant on the way to new mobility/agility.

- Dimitri Mendeleev, Russian chemist and inventor credited as the creator of the periodic table of elements, formulated new state standards for the production of vodka, 1894 new standards were introduced into Russian law.
- Jerry Thomas wrote the first bar book in 1862.
- In 1886 Coca Cola was invented by a pharmacist named John Pemberton.
- On the world fair 1888 in Paris an American bar was set in the US Pavilion that aroused great interest.
- Absinthe became very popular after the 1860s. It was often linked with violent crimes committed under its influence and was banned first in Switzerland 1900 and in whole Europe and the US latest in 1915.

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**Sazerac** ..... 12,00

Rye Whiskey, sugar syrup, Peychaud's Bitter, Pernod, Angostura Bitter<sup>1</sup>, Orange Twist

During the 19<sup>th</sup> century Antoine Peychaud, pharmacist, created the Angostura bitter and used it as ingredient for a cocktail called "Sazerac" which is the name of his favourite cognac. The cognac was replaced by rye whiskey from a bartender of the Grunewald Hotel in New Orleans.

	<b>Manhattan</b> .....	13,00
	Rye Whiskey, Antica Formula Vermouth <sup>5</sup> , Angostura Bitter <sup>1</sup>	
	Was created by an unknown bartender in a New Yorker Club called "Manhattan" on behalf of Jenny Churchill.	
	<b>Martinez</b> .....	11,00
	Old Tom Gin, Maraschino Liqueur, Antica Formula Vermouth <sup>5</sup> , Angostura Bitter <sup>1</sup>	
	The outrider of the Martini cocktail. This is the revised version by Jerry Thomas from 1862.	
	<b>Martini Cocktail</b> .....	11,50
	Tanqueray Gin, Noilly Prat Vermouth <sup>5</sup> , olive or lemon zest	
	In 1904 this cocktail appeared as a dry version of the Martini.	
	<b>Eggnog</b> .....	11,00
	Pampero Aniversario <sup>1</sup> , Vecchia Romagna Brandy, sugar powder, fresh egg yolk, milk	
	Was first mentioned in 1796. The recipe for this drink exists since 1839.	

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## The 19<sup>th</sup> Century

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 **Planter's Punch** ..... 11,00

Smith & Cross Jamaica Rum, lemon juice, Grenadine<sup>1,2,11</sup>, orange juice, pine-apple juice, nutmeg

 **Rum Toddy (hot served)** ..... 11,00

Smith & Cross Jamaica Rum, lemon juice, honey syrup, butter, hot water  
Its name goes back to the water source Tod's Well in Edinburgh.

 **Ramos Fizz** ..... 12,50

Old Tom Gin, sugar syrup, fresh egg white, lime juice, cream, Orange Flower Water, soda

The story began in 1888 when Henry C. Ramos had the opening of his first restaurant that was the time the "Ramos Fizz" was born and became more popular when Ramos got a second restaurant in 1907. There were only a hand full bartender who knew the recipe before it was released after the prohibition.

 **Tom Collins** ..... 12,00

Old Tom Gin, lemon juice, sugar syrup, soda

In 1874, a notorious hoax was played across America. It involved an individual being told that Tom Collins was in the bar down the road making slanderous comment about him. When the victim rushed to the bar, he was told that Tom Collins had already left but was heading To .... Wherever. What started as a small joke played on friends developed into a nationwide hoax.

 **Daiquiri** ..... 11,00

Havana Club 3 Años Rum, lime juice, sugar syrup

The original recipe is from 1898. "Daiquiri" is Cuban and is the name of a city near Santiago de Cuba. The frozen Daiquiri was first mixed at the "La Floridita" bar in Havana which was Hemmingway's favourite bar.

 **Old Fashioned** ..... 12,00

Rye Whiskey, sugar syrup, Angostura Bitter<sup>1</sup>, orange zest

Created by "Colonel Peppar" in Kentucky. It is the classical whiskey cocktail and even a glass got its name from it.

**Pimm's Cup** ..... 11,00

Pimm's No.1<sup>1</sup>, Ginger Ale, fresh cucumber

It was created in London by James Pimm, 1840. It is the "must have" drink at Wimbledon.

**Gin Fizz** ..... 11,00

Tanqueray Gin, lemon juice, sugar syrup, soda, fresh egg white

Its first appearance was on 1884 in by O. H. Byron's "The Modern Bartenders' Guide". You can find up to 27 different Fizzes in the Savoy-Cocktail book from 1930.

**Marlene's Mint Julep** ..... 11,50

Maker's Mark Bourbon, sugar syrup, fresh mint, lime juice

Its origin was in the beginning of the 19<sup>th</sup> century in the southern states and it is the first official drink of the Kentucky Derby. More than 80000 Juleps were served at the opening event in 1874.



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## The Years 1900 – 1940

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Marlene Dietrich was born. 1930 she got world famous through her star role in "the blue angel". ■ Two wars unsettled the world. ■ The prohibition in America led to a bad Blow/setback for the bar culture. Cocktails were still mixed but with bad quality products. The traditional Whisky was replaced by Gin because it was easier to produce Gin illegally and it doesn't need to be stored as long as Whisky. ■ For the European Bar culture this prohibition was everything else but bad because Harry Craddock absconded to London and released the Savoy Cocktail book 1930 that is still very popular. ■ Harry McElhone took over the New York Bar in Paris (1923) and renamed it into "Harry's New York Bar".

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 <b>White Lady</b> .....	11,50
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Tanqueray Gin, Cointreau, lemon juice

This drink was created 1919 by Harry McElhone who mixed it with Crème de menthe at the beginning and exchanged it through Gin at the "Harry's New York Bar" in 1929. In 1930 the recipe was released in Harry Craddocks Cocktail book who said that the "White Lady" is his creation.

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 <b>Marlene's Gin Sling</b> .....	12,00
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Berlin Adler Dry Gin, Cherry P. Heering, DOM Bénédictine, cherry jam, lemon juice, pineapple juice

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 <b>Gimlet</b> .....	11,00
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Tanqueray Gin, Lime Juice<sup>2</sup>, lime juice

Was the favourite drink of private detective Philip Marlow's client Terry Lennox in Raymond Chandlers "The long good-bye": "A real Gimlet is half Gin, half Lime juice, nothing else" – Marlow's Gimlet –.

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 <b>Margarita</b> .....	11,50
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Corralejo blanco, Cointreau, lime juice, sugar syrup

There are many stories about how the Margarita got its name. One example is that the Mexican bartender Carlos Herrera created this drink for a girl named Marjorie King.

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 <b>Pisco Sour</b> .....	11,00
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Ocuaje Pisco, sugar syrup, lime juice, fresh egg white, Angostura Bitter<sup>1</sup>

The first mentioned in an Advertisement of the "Morris Bar" in Lima (1928).

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 <b>Mojito</b> .....	12,00
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Havana Club 3 Años Rum, fresh mint, lime juice, cane sugar syrup, soda

Originally this drink was created by a sailor in the 16th century for Sir Francis Drake who called this drink "draque". It was mixed with strong rum (Aguardiente). In the middle of the 19<sup>th</sup> century the original recipe was changed and the drink got the name "Mojito".

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## The Years 1900 – 1940

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 **Side Car** ..... 11,50

Hennessy Fine de Cognac, Cointreau, lemon juice, sugar ryrup

It is said that the guest who drank this drink was so drunk every time that he had to be moved/carried in to the side car of his motorcycle to relay from his intoxication.

 **Brandy Alexander** ..... 11,00

Vecchia Romagna Brandy, Crème de Cacao braun<sup>1</sup>, cream, nutmeg

It is an After Dinner cocktail that was mixed with gin first. Later gin was replaced through brandy. This version got more famous than the original "Alexander Cocktail".

 **Bloody Mary (in a copper kettle for 2 persons available)** ..... 11,00

Ketel One Vodka, lime juice, home-made spice composition with dark beer, tomato juice

It was first mixed by Fernard Petoit in the 1920s at "Harry's New York Bar" and refined in New York with different spices because it was not flavored enough.

 **Prince of Wales** ..... 15,00

Hennessy Fine de Cognac, Cointreau, DOM Bénédictine<sup>1</sup>, Angostura Bitter<sup>1</sup>, champagne, sugar syrup

This drink was created by Jack Van in 1939 but he did not use Benedictine. We mix this drink with DOM Benedictine like Charles Schumann.

 **Grasshopper** ..... 11,00

Crème de Menthe green<sup>1</sup>, Crème de Cacao white<sup>1</sup>, cream

 **French 75** ..... 15,00

Tanqueray Gin, Cointreau, lemon juice, champagne

The French 75 has already been mentioned in the Savoy Cocktail book (1930) as a classical champagne cocktail.

 **Whiskey Sour** ..... 11,00

Maker's Mark Bourbon, lemon juice, sugar syrup

Classic cocktail originated around 1900 from the "Old Fashioned".

 **Blood & Sand** ..... 12,00

Ardbeg 10 yrs., Lillet rouge, Cherry P. Heering, fresh orange juice

The first recipe for a Blood & Sand cocktail appeared in 1930 in Harry Craddock's Savoy Cocktail Book's legendary and demanded equal parts of four ingredients.

 **Brandy Crusta** ..... 11,50

Vecchia Romagna, Cointreau, Maraschino Liqueur, lemon juice, white cane sugar syrup, orange bitter

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## The Years 1900 – 1940

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	<b>Marlene's Bellini</b>	9,50
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Peach purée, Peachtree Liqueur, Geldermann sparkling wine

This drink was created for a regular guest by Giuseppe Cipriani who opened "Harry's Bar" in Venice, 1931. The original Bellini is filled with Prosecco and can be found in any Bar menu you will ever see.



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## The Years 1940 – 1970

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Marlene Dietrich starts her career as a singer and got very famous with her one-woman-show. ■ The Federal Republic of Germany becomes an economic miracle in the 50s. ■ Elvis Presley becomes an icon with Rock n Roll and his very own style of dancing. ■ In August 1961, the construction of the Berlin wall started. ■ In the US the attempts of the Hippies against war in Vietnam reached its maximum. ■ The Tiki culture comes to the US when Hawaii became the 50<sup>th</sup> state. Tikibars and Tikidrinks got popular. Classical Tiki-drinks are "Mai Tai" and "Zombie". Trader Vic released a cocktail book that was the first to include the recipe of the "Mai Tai".

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### Mai Tai-Roa Ae . . . . . 13,00

Old Pascas overproofed Rum<sup>1</sup>, Cointreau, Dry Orange, almond syrup<sup>1,2,11</sup>, lime juice, cane sugar syrup, Peychaud's Bitter

Created by Victor Bergeron in 1944 who is the owner of "trader vic". „Out of this world – The best“ is the translation to for the name that is supposed to be said by a Tahitian woman after she drank it.



### Moscow Mule . . . . . 12,50

Ketel One Vodka, Ginger Beer, fresh lime, cucumber

This drink was first mixed by John G. Martin in 1941 and is said to be responsible for the popularity oh Vodka in the United States.



### The Vesper Martini . . . . . 12,00

Tanqueray Gin, Ketel One Vodka, Lillet Blanc<sup>5</sup>, lemon zest

„Bond insisted on ordering Leither's Haig-and-Haig ,on the rocks' [a quality Scotch whiskey - Lisa] and then he looked carefully at the barman. ,A dry martini,' he said. ,One. In a deep champagne goblet.' ,Oui, monsieur.' ,Just a moment. Three measures of Gordon's [an English gin - Lisa], one of vodka, half a measure of Kina Lillet. [this is NOT vermouth - see below!] Shake it very well until it's ice-cold, then add a large thin slice of lemon peel. Got it?' ,Certainly, monsieur.' The barman seemed pleasant with the idea. ,Gosh that's certainly a drink,' said Leither's. Bond laughed. ,When I'm ... er ... concentrating.' he explained, ,I never have more than one drink before dinner. But I do like that one to be large and very strong and very cold and very well-made. I hate small portions of anything, particularly when they taste bad. This drink's my own invention. I'm going to patent it when I can think of a good name.' He watched carefully as the deep glass became frosted with the pale golden drink, slightly aerated by the bruising of the shaker. He reached for it and took a long sip. ,Excellent,' he said to the barman, ,but if you can get a vodka made with grain instead of potatoes, you will find it still better.'

Johnnie Walker Red Label<sup>1</sup>, Drambuie, espresso dark beer syrup

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 **White Russian** ..... 11,00

Ketel One Vodka, Kahlúa, cream

The main character in the movie "The Big Lebowski" drinks eight "white Russian" during the whole movie.

 **London Buck** ..... 12,50

Tanqueray Gin, lime juice, Ginger Beer, cucumber

 **Golden Cadillac** ..... 11,00

Galliano<sup>1</sup>, Crème de Cacao white, orange juice, cream

The drink has been created in the middle of the sixties, in the centre of West America. A cardealer wanted to increase his business with a party and made the drink free of charge.

 **El Presidente** ..... 12,00

Havana Club 3 Años Rum, Noilly Prat Vermouth, Punt e Mes Vermouth, Cointreau, Grenadine<sup>1,2,11</sup>, lemon juice

 **Daiquiri Papa Hemingway** ..... 11,50

Havana Club 3 Años Rum, Marasquin Liqueur, lime juice, grapefruit juice, sugar syrup

Is one of Hemmingway's favourite drinks.

 **Horse's Neck** ..... 11,50

Maker's Mark Bourbon, Angostura Bitter<sup>1</sup>, Ginger Ale

It has been introduced at the Royal Navy as a officers drink from 1960.

 **Piña Colada** ..... 11,50

Bacardi 8 Años, pineapple, coconut syrup<sup>1,2,11</sup>

This drink is first mentioned in the New York Times in 1950. It is the most popular Colada and stands for Caribbean islands.

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**A**s best Documentary 1984 the movie „Marlene“ got the Oscar ■ 1989 Marlene Dietrich dies in Paris ■ 1970 Willy Brandt falls on his knees and leads the country to a new political era and eastern Germany ■ The Watergate scandal forces Richard Nixon in 1974 to withdrawal. ■ The nuclear disaster in Chernobyl 1986 leads to critical voices against nuclear power worldwide. ■ 1989 the fall of the Berlin wall ■ Charles Schumann opens the "Schumann's American Bar" 1982 in Munich. ■ The media put great effort in the popularity of cocktail. What would James Bond be without: "shaken, not stirred". ■ In 1988 the movie "Cocktail" comes to theatres and enables a big boom for "Flair tending". ■ Carrie Bradshaw made the "Cosmopolitan" famous with the show "Sex and the City"
