THE NATIONAL PANHELLENIC CONFERENCE

The National Panhellenic Conference was founded in 1902. This organization consists of 26 national and international sororities. Each group is a self-governed social greek-lettered society that includes college and alumnae women. Members are represented in 620+ college campuses in the United States and Canada! In addition, there are 4,600+ alumnae associations, making up over 3.6 million sorority women! The National Panhellenic Conference's mission is to advocate for the betterment of its sorority members through the collaboration of the members, campuses, and communities. Fun fact: The NPC is one of the largest organizations advocating for women!

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY'S PANHELLENIC COUNCIL

The SEMO Panhellenic Council is the governing body over the seven NPC sororities on our campus. The Council is composed of eight members of the Executive Board and a Panhellenic chapter delegate from each chapter. The Council's obligations are to advocate Greek Unity, enforce NPC guidelines, and oversee and regulate the recruitment process.

RECRUITMENT

Our Panhellenic sorority recruitment is a mutual selection process between Potential New Members (PNM's) and the active sorority women. Formal Recruitment is a sequence of events, organized by Panhellenic, that is intended to pair Potential New Members with active sorority members. The goal is to unite women and chapters that share similar values and standards. This is the time for PNMs to engage, ask questions, and learn more about our seven wonderful chapters on SEMO's campus. This is also the chance to discuss financial obligations, commitments, and membership requirements upon joining a sorority. Recruitment is a unique way to meet new faces while becoming acquainted to Greek Life at SEMO.

THE PANHELLENIC EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Panhellenic Executive Board is the governing body that connects the seven chapters to SEMO's greek community. All eight members work year-round with the university and chapter leaders to advance the experience for all Panhellenic women. The board also oversees and regulates Formal Recruitment Week. THE PI CHI PROGRAM

Recruitment Counselors, or Pi Chis, are sorority women (and the Panhellenic Executive Board) who have disaffiliated from their own chapters. You're placed in a Pi Chi group with other women who have also decided to go through recruitment. Your Pi Chi is here to answer any questions you may have!
