

Since the space was constructed over 12 years ago, this beautiful multipurpose room has struggled with providing the appropriate level of acoustics and lacks modern AV infrastructure. The goal of adding acoustic panels and modern AV equipment will provide a huge improvement to the sound within the space as well as reduce the high level of reverberation that occurs. 

UPDATE ON IHM'S HONDURAS MISSION

We last traveled to Honduras in February 2020 but IHM's generosity has made a huge impact throughout the course of the pandemic. Father Bob has allowed us to send down IHM Outreach dollars to help Sister Maria Rosa's organization with the following:

- —COVID testing, vaccines for workers and all children over 12, PPE, cleaning/disinfectant supplies
- -support for the out-of-work Honduran cooks, cleaners, guards and drivers for the mission groups

In addition, Susan Weber's IHM Christmas group sent holiday gifts for all the Honduran children via a shipping container from Miami to Tegucigalpa.

We are eager to return to our in-person partnership with Sociedad Amigos de los Niños in 2022. Some U.S. mission groups have recently traveled to Honduras and have reported back to us that their trips went very smoothly.

Knowing that COVID travel restrictions are unpredictable and that the rug could be pulled out from under us as late as the eve of our mission trips, we are cautiously and prayerfully making plans to return to Honduras.


