Keith Morgan is the Information Technology Director for the WV lottery, this position manages the design and operation of three distinct systems within Lottery Data Centers, including internal systems (licensing, security and accounting functions), Traditional Lottery (think Powerball) with IGT as the vendor and Video Lottery (think one armed bandits) with Scientific Games as the Vendor. The Lottery has two data centers separated by approximately 120 miles, each of which can and does assume responsibility as the primary data center. These data centers provide connectivity for approximately 1,100 locations (primarily gas stations) using Satellite technology and another 1,000+ Video Lottery locations (primarily 5 terminal mom and pa bars) using Cellular technology.

Keith was born and raised in the Ohio Valley and was one of the early members of the Wheeling Chapter of DPMA, a predecessor to AITP, with fond memories of meetings at Oglebay a long

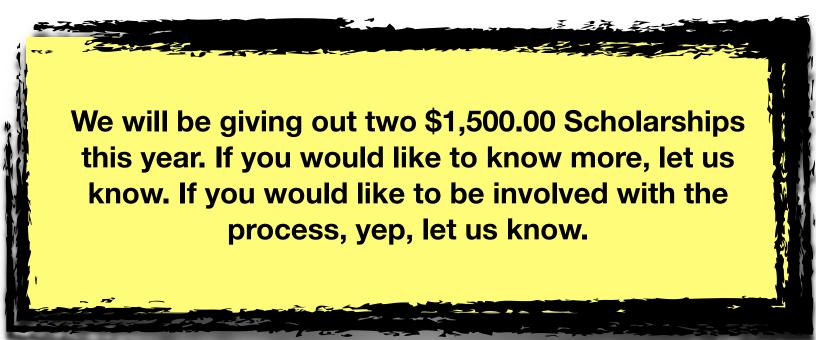
We have speakers on a la variety of different topics - wellness, hobbies related to IT, as well as interesting subjects that will help you with your goals in your career.
