Recipe of the Month By Khrissy



Baked Spaghetti Casserole



Cook 45 Ready in 45 m

Ingredients

- Cooking spray
- 12 ounces spaghetti
- 4 eggs, beaten
- 2/3 cup Parmesan cheese
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 cup cottage cheese, or more to taste
- 1 (28 ounce) jar spaghetti sauce
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella cheese, or to taste

Directions

- . Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Prepare a 9x13-inch baking dish with cooking spray.
- . Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Cook spaghetti in the boiling water, stirring occasionally until cooked through but firm to the bite, about 12 minutes; drain and transfer to a large bowl.
- . Mix eggs, Parmesan cheese, and butter with the spaghetti to coat pasta completely; spread into the prepared baking dish. Spread cottage cheese over the spaghetti to cover completely. Spread spaghetti sauce over the cottage cheese; top with a layer of mozzarella cheese.
- . Bake until hot in the center, about 30 minutes.

ISIS: By Suzanne D GODDESS OF WOMEN, MOTHERHOOD, MARRIAGE, FERTILITY, AND HEALING

Isis is the primordial mother of all creation. Known for her devotion to her husband, Osiris and later her son, Horus, she was important is nearly every aspect of daily life. She tutored women in the domestic arts and was sought out in times of suffering.

Since Isis personified the throne, she also served as regent when her husband was away. When Osiris was killed by Set, she received the former's head and ultimately resolved to find every piece of him. She found twelve of his thirteen pieces and, with the help of Thoth, put him back together while replacing his missing organ with gold. Flying over Osiris in the form of a kite (hawk), Isis became pregnant with Horus. Shortly thereafter, Isis was imprisoned by Set but later escaped with Thoth's assistance.

With the infant Horus and seven scorpions, Tefen, Befen, Mestet, Mestetef, Petet, Thetet, and Maatet, in tow, Isis traveled to a village in search of shelter. They first came to the residence of a noblewoman, but were turned away. Luckily a peasant lady had seen what had happened and offered to shelter the goddess and her entourage. However, the scorpions were furious at the aristocratic woman's rudeness and decided to combine their venom in order to lethally wound her son. The distraught woman knocked on every door seeking help but was turned away. Isis, however, intended to save the lad and was horrified at what the scorpions had done. She successfully saved the boy by saying the scorpions' names. In gratitude, the noble lady offered the goddess all her material possessions as well as her servants in tribute, yet Isis, forgiving and caring, requested she share her wealth with her hostess. Afterward, the scorpions saw the error of their ways and behaved themselves.

She also learned Ra's secret name by getting a serpent to bite him and healing him in exchange for it.

When the time came for Horus to challenge Set for control of Egypt, she assisted him dutifully. Upon her son's victory, Isis finally went to join her beloved husband in the underworld.

She is often depicted as a woman enthroned or with long wings in a headdress with a throne, vulture or Uraeus usually carrying a scepter and ankh. Some depictions also show her kneeling before a coffin.
