At the Dogs NSW Annual General Meeting on 1/11/2017, regulations with respect to the Library and Archives Committee were modified to enable it to utilize the funds that it has accumulated over many years for the construction of a building to house its extensive collection and provide reading and research facilities. The Library and Archives Building will be prefabricated, enabling it to be re-located if Dogs NSW is obliged to vacate its leased Orchard Hills site in due course. While final design is pending and planning permission from Penrith Council has yet to be secured, the new building will replicate the roofs, colours etc of the existing complex.

Planning for the 2018 Dachshund National Specialty Championship Show next Easter at the magnificent St Ives Showgrounds is well advanced. This was one of the major venues for dog shows in Sydney prior to the establishment of the Bill Spilstead Complex for Canine Affairs at Orchard Hills. It has expansive grassed areas for dog showing and exercising. Parking and camping are accommodated beneath the tree canopy which extends from the adjoining Ku-Ring-Gai National Park. An indoor area is available in the event of bad weather and catering and bath room facilities are excellent. Best of all, we will have the venue to ourselves. As many of you are aware, the Bill Spilstead Complex at Orchard Hills was already booked out by numerous other clubs and the Dachshund Club of NSW Inc was very fortunate to secure the St Ives venue which has superior facilities to the Castle Hill Showground, also unavailable.

From all indications, the trophy table will also be magnificent. As well as cash prizes and practical items for dog showing and breeding, it will also include Kathy Anderson's amazing collection of rare and prized Dachshund-inspired items which she has kindly donated. It includes unique, individual Limited Edition plates, original paintings, statuettes etc. This is a wonderful start and all members are invited to make cash donations of \$10 or more, all of which will be acknowledged in the show catalogue. Further details will be available in the soon-to-be-released National 2018 booklet, but in the meantime, please contact Treasurer, Pat Thomas, for further information. We hope to see you all at the next General Meeting scheduled for Wednesday evening, 13/12/2017 at 8 pm at the Dundas Sport and Recreation Club for an end-of-year celebration. If you can, join Committee members for a meal in the dining room beforehand.

SHOULD GOVERNMENTS ENCOURAGE MORE PET OWNERSHIP?

Pet owners save the public healthcare system an estimated \$2 billion annually according to new data released on 30/7/2017. The findings have prompted a call for state and federal governments to offer tax credits for pet ownership in a bid to encourage further benefits.

Celebrity vet Dr Chris Brown, star of the popular *Bondi Vet* TV series, is one of the leading protagonists encouraging policymakers to consider tax rebates or offsets that encourage pet ownership to stimulate further healthcare savings.

The Healthcare Economics of Pets report found that on average, every pet owner saves the health system \$700 per year. Those saving figures are based on previous studies by academics at the University of Melbourne that found pet owners visit the doctor 11 per cent less than non-pet owners on average.

Pets encourage better physical health through walk and play, and promote mental health by providing companionship and facilitating community connections.

“This research is a wakeup call for policy makers to acknowledge the broader benefits for pet ownership, which even extends the public purse,” Dr Brown said.

“If our governments can recognize pet owners for making smart choices for their health through incentives like a tax rebate or offset, the return on investment could be huge.”

Economic projections in the report suggest that if the pet population in Australia increased by 10 per cent a year, the public health system could save over \$200 million annually.

“The report shows that keeping Australia pet friendly is an issue of national importance. I hope the government can see the value in spending a little, to save a lot,” said Dr Brown.

John Bishop, co-founder and joint CEO of national animal welfare charity PetRescue, also voiced his support for the pet ownership tax offset proposal.

“We really need policies like this to encourage more Australians to discover the benefits, and the joy, of pet adoption,” Mr Bishop said.

“The fact that pet ownership also has such a large positive impact on our economy, it makes me wonder why this hasn’t been implemented sooner. It’s a win-win for both humans and many thousands of pets looking for a new home.”

The report was commissioned by Mars Petcare as part of the *Keep Australia Pet Friendly* campaign.

What do you think? Should pet ownership be subsidised? Should the offer only be available to rescue pets to help promote further cost savings?

Throughout the year, all dogs in the bushland coastal areas of Sydney need to be checked daily for paralysis ticks and to have tick control treatment regularly administered. The St Ives Showground, Sydney, venue of the 12th Dachshund National Specialty, Easter 2018, abuts Ku-Ring-Gai National Park on 3 sides and exhibitors will need to take appropriate precautions. Bravecto is generally now recommended by local vets in these areas. An alternative method using daily doses of sulphur was outlined in the Jan/Feb 2015 Low Down (E News No13).
