Then a bigger dog comes to help. Simon runs up the steps and then backs down, showing Daisy how easy it is. Daisy is still not convinced. Simon tries again. This time more slowly. Then he watches Daisy try again. Daisy is still too scared. Once again Simon goes to the top and demonstrates the technique. Finally Daisy dares to let her back legs follow the front ones. Simons stays beside her. She makes it and everyone celebrates!

What an incredible picture of discipleship. We spend much of our time trying to teach others to climb up, but the more important, and more difficult, thing to learn is how "to go down."

Throughout Scripture we read that God expects humility of us. On numerous occasions, God demonstrated humility by coming down. Finally God sent His Son, Jesus, who spent His life teaching the technique we are to follow.
