PRECAUTIONS



Use only the adaptor included with the MAGICSING. There are many adaptors that are plug compatible with the jack of the MAGICSING., but have different electrical specifications. These adaptors would work only for a short period of time but would very soon damage the MAGICSING.

MAGICSING ALL-IN-ONE KARAOKE



- LED Display
 Display power ON / OFF
- 2 Up/Down Button
- Scroll up&down from the current song to key, tempo, microphone volume, music volume, echo, etc.
- 4 Power Button
 The power button ON & OFF
- 5 MIC Button
 To display functions: Main MIC Vol > Echo > Sub MIC Vol

adjust the levels (-7 ~ 8) by using ▲/▼ buttons.


- To display functions: Main MIC Vol > Echo > Sub MIC Vol adjust the levels ($0 \sim 15$) by using \triangle/∇ buttons.



HOW TO CONNECT TO A TV



Connect AV cable to RCA jack terminals in your TV as shown above. If there are only two RCA jack terminals in your TV (Mono TV), then please connect the Yellow jack (Male) into the Yellow RCA jack terminal and connect the White jack (Male) into the other RCA jack terminal of your TV.

Additional Function - Recording

Record into Internal Memory (up to 1Min and 30Sec)

To Recording

- · Select a song
- · Press MODE + 7
- · To stop recording at anytime press (■/ ▶) play button
- · To replay recorded song press MODE and (▼) down at anytime

2 Record into Recording Pack (up to 40Min ~ 50Min)

To Recording

- · Insert the recording pack (* Refer to : Chapter.04-02)
- · Select a song
- · Press MODE + 7
- · To stop recording at anytime press (■/ ▶) play button

To replay the recorded songs

Press mode and (∇) down to list up the recorded songs on the screen and select a recorded songs by (∇/\triangle) up/down button and press ($\blacksquare/\triangleright$) play button to playback or stop at anytime.

To delete the recorded songs

Press MODE and (\blacktriangledown) down to list up the recorded songs on the screen and select a recorded song by ($\blacktriangledown/\blacktriangle$) up/down button and press MIC button to delete (You may not be able to delete recorded songs from sub microphone)

(if there is no recording pack in a slot, recording function work with only trial recording stage in internal memory)

Additional Function - Random Song Selection

Press MODE and (A) up key on initial stage

Additional Function - Games

Song contest

Divide into 2 teams (A team VS B team), sing 3 songs randomly in turns, figure out total score and decide a winning team.

To display the functions of MENU & Configuration

MODE + 1 MIC Vo

(You can adjust the mic volume with 15 levels by using the ▲/▼ Buttons)

MODE + 2 Ke

(You can adjust the MIC key with 15 levels by using the ▲/▼ Buttons)

MODE + 3 Sub-MIC Vol

(Allows you to adjust the sub-MIC volume with 15 levels by using the ▲/▼ Buttons)

MODE + 4 Music Vol

(Allows you to set the volume of the music, using the ▲/▼ Buttons)

MODE + 5 Echo

(Allows you to adjust the mic echo volume with 15 levels by using the ▲/▼ Buttons)

MODE + 6 Tempo

(Allows you to set the tempo, using the ▲/▼ Buttons)

MODE + 7 Recording (* Refer to Chapter.03-02)

(Record your own singing, into internal memory or recording pack)

MODE + 8 Melody

(Allows you to set the volume of the guide melody, using the ▲/▼ Buttons)

MODE + 9 RES

(it is used to pre-select (Reserve) songs. Select a song number, then press the these buttons (max.20songs but displays only 7 songs). If you select the next song using these buttons, it will start when the current song ends.)

MODE + 0 Games

(Enjoy your game, 1. Song Contest / 2. Tuning Meter / 3. Othello / Mode: EXIT)

MODE + Random Song Selection

(Allow you to select a song randomly)

MODE + ▼ Replay

(Allow you to replay the recorded songs at any time)

MODE + MIC Sub ON/OFF

MODE + KEY Continuous Play

(Songs will be played automatically one after the other until you stop the play.)



Optional Items - Chapter.04



- Open the back cover of Main Microphone, then plug the receiving pack as in the picture shown above.
- When pressing the MODE+MIC button of the Main Microphone, the monitor will display the Sub Microphone ON, and it will begin to function the channel.
- 3 Open the back cover of the Sub-Microphone, insert two AA batteries and press the power button. The Green LED light will be on and, it will start to function.
- 4 ▲/▼ Button (up/down)

Scroll up & down from the current song to adjust key, tempo, microphone volume, music volume, echo, etc.

5 RES Button RES

Allows you to reserve songs (Maximum 20 but displays only 5). If you select the next song using this button, it will start when the current song ends.

- POWER Button The power button ON & OFF
- 7 Play / Stop Press once to play, again to stop.
- When the red LED light is on, the batteries need to be replaced.
- If you want to stop using the sub microphone, press the MODE+MIC.

 The monitor will show the Sub-Microphone OFF again, and it will stop

Exercises your vocal pitch with this function

- · Select male or female.
- · Press button 1 ~ 7 (Do~Si)
- · Press (▼/▲) up & down button to Change the octave
- And press (▼/▲) up & down button to select a scale and press
 (■/▶) play & stop button to replay the pitch.
- Press MIC button to change the instrument (Initial instrument : piano)
 (An electronic organ- guitar- violin- trumpet- half- piano)
- · Press MODE button to close

3 Othello

Introduction

This is the famous reversi / Othello game. Reverse is a two player game (black and white) is normally played on an 8x8 grid. The object of the game is to full the board with your own color of pieces. You win if at the end of the game there are more pieces of your own color on the board than your opponent's. The initial setup of the board is two pieces each player, placed diagonally to each other in the centre of the board.

Each player in turn places a piece on the board, starting with the player using the black pieces (human player). A valid is one where you can turn at least one of your opponent's pieces into a piece of your color. You can do this if when you place on the board, it terminates a continuous line. All of the pieces in the line are then flipped to your color then lines can be in any of the eight lateral and diagonal directions from the position you have chosen. If there is more than one such line of pieces, all of them are flipped to your color.

Basic rules of the game are

- 1. The player with the black pieces goes first, and then play alternates
- To make a move, you must be able to flip at least one of your opponent's pieces to your color, by completing a line of pieces as described above.
- 3. If you can make a valid move, you must.
- If you can't go, you must pass your turn and your opponent plays again.

CAUTION

Please do not use the MAGICSING if you think it is having difficulties.





If you smell something weird, the MAGICSING begins to smoke or makes a strange noise, please pull out the USB cable, turn off your PC immediately and unplug the MAGICSING from the power outlet.



Do not place the MAGICSING in locations that are - Very humid (moisture), dusty or dirty, extremely hot or cold.



Do not plug in if the MAGICSING is wet. Immediately contact the service center. If any solid object or liquid gets inside of MAGICSING, unplug it and have it checked by a service center.



Do not disassemble or repair or modify the MAGICSING by vourself.



Do not place heavy objects on MAGICSING, do not drop the MAGICSING, do not throw the MAGICSING.

Additional Song Packs

You do not have to stick with the built in songs only, you can add additional song packs to your collection.

How to Setup the Additional Song Pack

Turn OFF the power. It is very important to power off first before removing or adding any additional Song Pack.



- Please turn off the power of the MAGICSING.
- Press down the back cover of MAGICSING as an arrow then remove the back cover.



- Please make sure that the arrow direction of Song Pack is pointing upward when you insert the Song Pack.
- (Additional 4 Song Packs can be inserted.)



- After Song Pack is inserted then close the back cover as normal.
- · Please turn on the power of the MAGICSING.

How to Add the Song List



- Press the top and bottom metal tab of the binder to open the binder rings.
- · Insert the new song list between the binder rings.
- · Close the binder rings.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

In case of problems please check the following recommendations

If MAGICSING doesn't power up

A. When you are using the adaptor

Please make sure the adaptor is plugged into the power outlet correctly. Check that the male plug if it is properly inserted into the female jack.

B. When you are using the battery

Please check if the battery type is AA, and If battery life is low, MAGICSING may not power up or work properly.

If the user's voice could not be heard

Press MIC button and check the volume of the main microphone.

If the TV does not show pictures or sound

Make sure all the AV connections are properly connected according to the correct colors. Check if the TV is already in the video mode.

When the TV screen stays still and the MAGICSING won't turn off

Press the power button for 3 seconds or longer to turn off the MAGICSING.

When the video does not show properly

To convert to PAL mode, press and hold button 8, Do not release this button yet. Using another finger press and release power button. Do not release button 8 until the word PAL appears on the TV screen. To convert to NTSC mode, press and hold button 9, Do not release this button yet. Using another finger press and release power button.

Do not release button 9 until the word NTSC appears on the TV screen.

If there is any doubt about the product's performance

Press and hold the 0 button, Do not release this button yet. Using another finger press and release the power button. Do not release the 0 button until the words "USER RESET" appears on the TV screen.

When the External Video Input function does not work

Make sure the External Video Pack is properly placed in its slot adjacent to the duet receiver Slot. (\times This function is optional)
