

The North Carolina Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA)

- The CAA is a statewide agreement governing the transfer of credits between NC community colleges and NC public universities and has as its objective the smooth transfer of students. The CAA provides certain assurances to the transferring student; for example:
 - Assures admission to one of the 16 UNC institutions (Transfer Assured Admissions Policy)
 - Enables NC community college graduates of two-year Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degree programs who are admitted to constituent institutions of the university of NC to transfer with junior status.

UGETC

- UGETC is an acronym for "Universal General Education Transfer Component."
- These courses transfer to any of the public universities in NC as general education credits. Students must earn a "C" or higher in order to receive the credit.

College Transfer Programs at Mitchell

- The college transfer programs are part of an agreement between North Carolina Community Colleges and the University of North Carolina System.
- These programs provide students with an opportunity to take the first two years of a four-year program at Mitchell Community College before transferring to one of the 17 UNC schools such as Appalachian State University, UNC Charlotte or UNC Chapel Hill.



Associate in Arts and Associate in Science

- The Associate in Arts (A10100) (AA) degree is designed for students who want to pursue a four-year degree in one of the liberal arts disciplines or training at a professional school that requires a strong liberal arts background.
- The Associate in Science (A10400) (AS) degree is designed for students who want to pursue a four-year degree in areas of study such as computer science, engineering, mathematics, the sciences or professional programs that require strong mathematics and science backgrounds.



Associate in Engineering

- The Uniform Articulation Agreement promotes educational advancement opportunities for Associate in Engineering (A10500) completers and the constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina in order to complete Bachelor of Science in Engineering degrees.
- This Associate in Engineering to Bachelor of Science in Engineering (AE to BSE) Articulation Agreement is between the State Board of North Carolina Community Colleges and The University of North Carolina Board of Governors. It applies to all NC community colleges that operate the AE program and to UNC constituent institutions (ECU, NC A&T, NCSU, UNC-Charlotte and Western Carolina). The AE to BSE was approved in February 2015.

- The Uniform Articulation Agreement focuses on seamless transfer for students who begin music studies at a community college and then transfer to one of the University of North Carolina Bachelor of Music programs.
- Our Associate in Fine Arts in Music degree will prepare you to transfer to a four-year institution in order to complete your Bachelor's degree in your specialized music field. Career opportunities in music include music education, sacred music, music therapy, music industry/business, musicology, theory/composition, and performance.

Career opportunities in art include fine artist, art educator, graphic/digital designer, commercial photographer, cinematographer, set designer, animator, and videographer.
