
The Odyssey: Books 1 and 5

Activity: Newsfeed, Newsroom

Books 1 and 5 of *The Odyssey* begin in media res (in the middle of things), introducing the reader to a harried Odysseus on the verge of homecoming. In book one, the story alludes (refers) to an incident in which Odysseys lost all his men. In Book 5, we see Odysseus finally freed from Calypso's island after seven years.

1) Why would a writer want to start telling their story in the middle of the action? Does the choice to do so make the reader feel suspense, curiosity, or surprise? Discuss in your group.

2) Now, imagine you and your group belong to a media organization that has been following the story of Odysseus since the end of the Trojan War. Each group will be given a page, cover, feed, etc. representing a different type of news or media format. The group must then identify the type of publication, its audience, and the tone used in order to brainstorm and create several new posts covering the characters and events in *The Odyssey* Books 1 and 5.


