FROM THE DESK OF REV. CARNEL RICHARDSON

Today is the second Sunday of Advent. It is the Sunday of PEACE.

In the First Advent, Christ came to inaugurate peace on earth and goodwill to all. However, the kind of peace that Christ offers is not the same kind of peace that this world offers (John 14:27). Christ provides peace that surpasses understanding. The world as we know it is in turmoil just as the world was in turmoil at the time in which Jesus was born. In our current world (just as in Jesus's day) there is much political chaos, socio-economic disparities, and civil unrest.

Even as some of us celebrate personal prosperity and individual liberties in this season, we must realize that some of our brothers and sisters in parts of Africa are still grossly enslaved. Many of our brothers and sisters in various parts of the world have never experienced a moment of peace because of oppression and tyranny. What can we do about all of this? There are some who possess the mindset that war, slander, political posturing, monetary gain, social media bashing, and revenge are some of the ways to finally arrive at peace. Those actions provide a false sense of peace.

At the end of the day, our real need is to be at peace with God again. The way to become at peace with God is to repent of our sins, iniquities, and transgressions while turning our hearts towards Christ.

"Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful" (Colossians 3:15). Amen.
