There are many animals in the world, many that we have never seen before. They are all classified in two groups, invertebrates, and vertebrates. Vertebrates have a backbone and invertebrates don't. I will be telling you about invertebrates.

There are many types of invertebrates, they are also sorted in groups. Such as mollusks, cnidarians, sponges, echinoderms, flatworms, roundworms, segment worms, and arthropods. Mollusks are animals with shells like snails, clams and, oysters. Cnidarians have tentacles like an octopus or jellyfish. Sponges don't move around except when they were larvae. She visited veterans to comfort them about the war.





Comics have 7365 while movies have 23.






