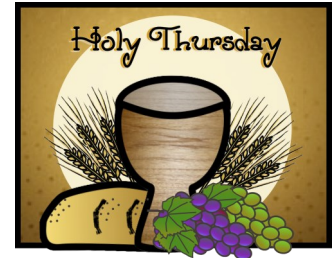

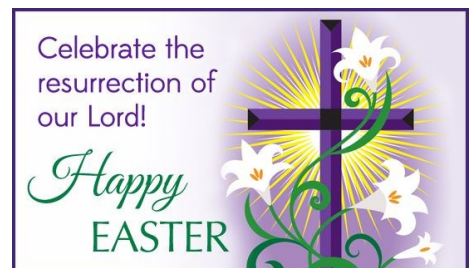

*Feast of Faith - The Liturgies of Holy Week*

Holy Week is the culmination of the liturgical year. During these holy days, the liturgy will lead us, with Jesus, to the depths and to the heights. It begins with a harsh juxtaposition, as we carry palms in remembrance of Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem and then listen to the Passion according to Matthew, as the King is handed over for crucifixion. Then, on Holy Thursday, we remember the night Jesus was handed over—the night he gave himself for us and to us, to live in our midst forever in the sacrament of his Body and Blood. On Good Friday, we touch with our hands the mystery of the Lord's cross, the instrument of torture that has become the tree of life. Then, at the great Easter Vigil, the lighting of the paschal candle speaks to us of the triumph of light over darkness, of life over death. The resurrection of the Lord becomes a living reality in our midst as the catechumens for whom the Church has prayed throughout Lent are plunged into the mystery of Christ's death and share in the glory of his resurrection. These are indeed holy days, the culmination of the Church's liturgy, and an invitation to participate in the very life of Christ. Come, let us worship. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. S. ### *Special Days this Week*

The Liturgies of Holy Week take precedence over the Saints not observed at Mass.

**March 29 – Saint Rupert** was bishop of Salzburg in the eighth century. He encouraged his faithful to develop several salt mines.

**April 1 – Holy Thursday of the Lord’s Supper**

**April 2 – Good Friday Passion of the Lord**, “God so loved the world that He gave His only Son”.

**April 3 – Holy Saturday**, recalling the silence of Jesus in the tomb.

**April 2 – Saint Francis of Paola** was a holy hermit who helped to prepare King Louis XI of France for death. He is one of the Saints who advised to live as God desires - for death may come tomorrow.

### *Faith Sharing for Palm Sunday*

Jesus was greeted by the crowd of people who “spread leafy branches” on the road. Tradition proposes that **palm branches** be blessed and distributed in memory of Jesus’ entry to Jerusalem. Raise your palm branches and say “Hosanna”, which translated from the Greek means, “Please save us!” surely a timely prayer!

## Planned Parenthood Officials Admit Under Oath That They Sold Aborted Baby Parts



A new video featuring sworn testimony from Planned Parenthood leaders presents evidence that the abortion chain lied to Congress and the media about its aborted baby body parts trade in Texas.

The Center for Medical Progress released a video, highlighting conflicting statements that the abortion chain made about its Planned Parenthood Gulf Coast affiliate in Texas.

"When the undercover videos were first released, Planned Parenthood delivered a carefully-constructed script to the public and to the press minimizing their involvement in fetal experimentation—but under oath, their story changes," CMP founder David Daleiden said.

Initially, Planned Parenthood claimed that its Gulf Coast affiliate does not have a fetal tissue program, only an agreement with the University of Texas to donate placentas to its medical researchers, according to the video.

However, according to 2019 court testimony featured in the CMP video, that is false. The video shows Melissa Farrell, the vice president of research at Planned Parenthood Gulf Coast, admitting under oath that her affiliate provides the "products of conception in its entirety" – which includes the aborted baby's body, placenta, umbilical cord and amniotic sac — to the university.

CMP also uncovered contracts showing that Planned Parenthood Gulf Coast charged \$150 per specimen to the University of Texas.

## THEY NEVER FORGOT

Police officers from Meriden, CT, gathered at Cedar Grove Cemetery to pay tribute to "David Paul" — a newborn baby boy who was abandoned and froze to death in a parking lot 30 years ago. "We adopted him, he is part of our police family, and we are so proud of that," said former Meriden police chief Robert Kosinski.



The boy's death led to Connecticut's SAFE Havens Act, which allows mothers to safely drop off a baby to a doctor, hospital, fire department, or police department.

## Operation Rescue 2020 Survey Results

A total of 45 abortion facilities closed or halted abortions nationwide in 2020, leaving one state without an active abortion facility, according to a survey conducted by Operation Rescue, a national pro-life organization based in Wichita, Kansas.



Missouri has become the first Abortion-Free State – at least in practice for now. The embattled Reproductive Health Services Planned Parenthood in St. Louis, Missouri, was the last abortion facility in Missouri. It remains open, but Operation Rescue has confirmed that all abortion appointments are now being referred to the Fairview Heights Planned Parenthood facility across the Mississippi River in Illinois.

There are currently 706 active abortion facilities in the U.S.

Since Operation Rescue began tracking the number of abortion facilities in 2009, surgical abortion facilities have decreased in number by 255. In contrast, abortion pill facility numbers have been steadily on the rise over the past decade, increasing 47.2 percent in the past eleven years. Today, there are 248 facilities that abort only using chemical means.
