How different was the thinking of that widow in the temple who put her last two copper coins in the offering (Mark 12:41-44). Those two coins were all she had to ward off starvation. That's all she had to pay her creditors and meet her obligations. There was no secret stash that she had squirreled away for the future. There was no government safety net. Yet she gave her last two coins to God. She trusted that God could and would take care of her.


God's Word and promises work to build our trust. God promised that he will never leave us nor forsake us (Hebrews 13:5). Jesus said, "Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?" (Matthew 6:26). So, why worry? "He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" (Romans 8:32).

Life isn't without setbacks and difficulties. The money doesn't always last until payday. But at times like those, God uses our disappointments to show us the futility of trusting in ourselves or in our wealth. Money isn't everything. **Just a reminder** of the option you have of using "electronic giving" for making your regular church offerings or special fund offerings. Contributions can be debited automatically from your checking or savings account or processed using your <u>debit or credit card (Peace is charged a larger percentage (up to 3.5%) of your donation for card usage)</u>. The electronic giving program offers convenience for you and much needed donation consistency for our congregation.

If you are currently giving on a weekly basis, you will no longer need to write out 52 checks a year or prepare 52 envelopes. And, when travel, illness or other circumstances prevent you from attending services, this program will allow your weekly offerings to continue in an uninterrupted basis.

# Preschool News



*Jesus' Lambs at Peace Preschool* welcomes our 2020-2021 preschool families for our fall semester that begins Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup>. So far, we have 49 students! Our Bible theme this year is "Indeed, it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God -- not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8-9

Our Back-To-School Picnic will be Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, 6-8 p.m. All families are invited to come for supper that evening. Please bring all paperwork, supplies and first month's tuition. (If you are able to settle the tuition before this evening, it will help us to do more social distancing.) The picnic will be outdoors and we will be able to have plenty of spacing and fun! This is a wonderful opportunity for your child to become better acquainted with our facility and we thank Thrivent Financial for also sponsoring our Back-to-School Picnic.

Our new teacher, Dani Merritt, will be a great help in the classroom. So that you can be more acquainted with her, she writes:

I am a mother of four, married for 31 years (in August) to Chris Merritt. I am originally from Northwest Arkansas, where my parents, only sibling and extended family still live. My college degree is a Bachelor of Science in Housing and Interior Design. I worked for an architect until we started our family, and then became a stay-at-home mom. In 2000, after being involved as an activities and newsletter coordinator with a mother-and-child playgroup for several years, and finding a preschool for my 2<sup>nd</sup> child, I became a teaching assistant there for a 3- and 4- year-old half day program, Get-Set! Preschool, at a local Christian church. The following year was asked to take over the responsibilities of the Director. I stayed in that position for one year as we added to our family again with the birth of a third child. I could see the Lord's guiding hand in being placed there. Our WELS church was in the process of beginning a Christian Day School. About a year and a half later, the Education Committee asked if I could assist them in beginning a preschool program just ahead of the K-8 school opening. Having had the experience of navigating a Department of Human Services-licensed preschool in Arkansas only a couple of years prior, I set about organizing and furnishing a new 3- and 4-year-old full day program, hiring teachers from within our congregation and developing a curriculum. The following year, I returned to teaching a half-day version of the program in the adjacent room. It then expanded to two full day classrooms of 40-50 students, with a teaching staff of 4, to complement the K-8 program, running across the hallway, with three WELS elementary school teachers. I then again stepped down from teaching and directing with the birth of our fourth child. We were again led by our Lord to choose Peace Lutheran Church after moving to Mankato in November 2010. I have enjoyed the opportunity to substitute when needed for *Jesus'* Lambs at Peace since that following spring, in 2011. I love playing with young children. I love seeing the thrill in their eyes, as they learn new things. Being able to provide that in a Christian environment became vital to me after the birth of my own children. I value each child as an individual, loved and redeemed by Christ. I want to see them grow and succeed in the sure confidence of their Christ-won salvation.

We welcome Mrs. Dani Merritt into our midst at Jesus' Lambs at Peace and we pray that God would bless our 2020-21 school year.
