



FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

September can be an exciting time! Especially here in Western New York, people try to cram in a year's worth of warm weather fun. Hopefully after all that summer fun, many of us find ourselves rejuvenated and ready to "get back to work." We are excited for things to start up again, whether it be school or work or volunteering or other activities. We are often ready to dive in a get going.

So it is hard for me to give you this month's book of the Bible because it is not an easy or uplifting read. I would hope that I could inspire you with this month's book of the Bible, but instead I worry that it might depress you. Then I remembered that I had read this quote by Mark Twain: "What is joy without sorrow? What is success without failure? What is a win without a loss? What is health without illness? You have to experience each if you are to appreciate the other. There is always going to be suffering. It's how you look at your suffering, how you deal with it, that will define you." Mark Twain may not have been an overly religious man, but there deep spiritual truth in his quote. This deep truth you can find in our book of the Bible this month, Lamentations.

This book is a lament, a lament over horrible things that have happened. It can help us appreciate the good things happening in our lives now by comparing our joys to the struggles listed in this book. It can also help us put our own pain in perspective. When we find ourselves thinking that our life is horrible, it's a good time to realize that others have pain too. We all have struggles, we all have pain, we all have moments where we feel like we want to give up. Yet God is there, even when we don't see him, even when we are at the bottom of the barrel. That truth is found in this book. It's a lament for God to take away the bad things, but found it in are some glimmers of hope and trust in God.

So maybe as you read this book, think about the blessings in your life. Contrast them to the challenges in life you have faced. And remember, God is not just there in the good times, but God is there in the bad, to help us get through, to bring us again to a place of joy and excitement.


