Pastor's Corner

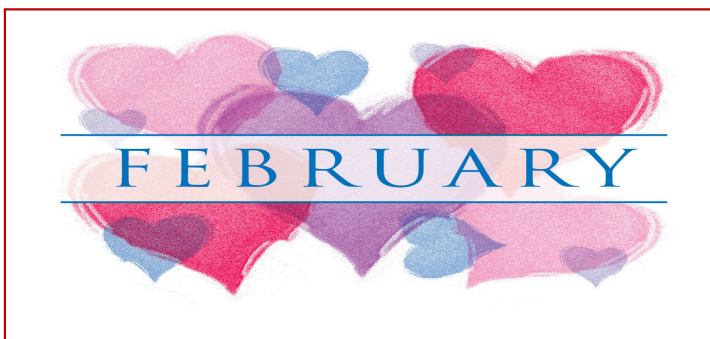

Lent is a season of forty days, excepting Sundays, beginning with Ash Wednesday and ending on Holy Saturday. Lent comes from the Anglo-Saxon word *lencten*, meaning "spring". It began as a period of fasting and preparation for baptism by converts and then became a time for penance by all Christians.

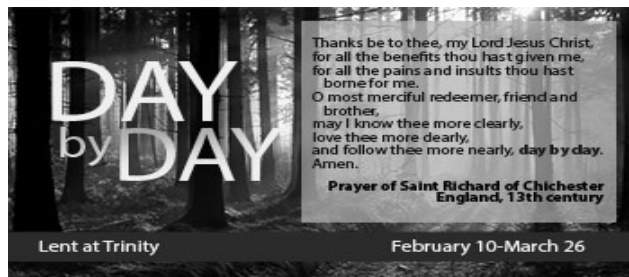

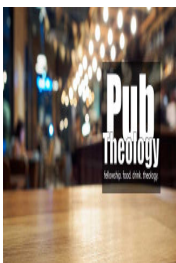

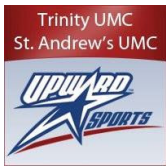
