

Millennium Carillon in Moser Tower and Visitor Center

On the Naperville Riverwalk Near Rotary Hill

At the base of the Riverwalk's Rotary Hill stands the majestic Millennium Carillon in Moser Tower, a unique, 16-story structure with a 72-bell instrument. This gift, given to the Naperville community to commemorate the dawn of the New Millennium, was built through community support and donations and is now maintained through a partnership between the Park District, Millennium Carillon Foundation and the City of Naperville.

The Carillon and adjacent Visitor Center is open for tours from May-November. Admission is \$3 for ages 5 and older; children 4 and under are free. Visitors under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
