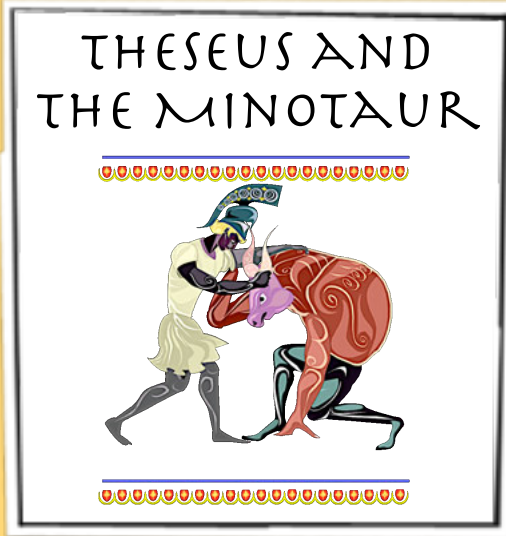

Theseus makes his way through the labyrinth, trailing the string behind him so he can find his way out.

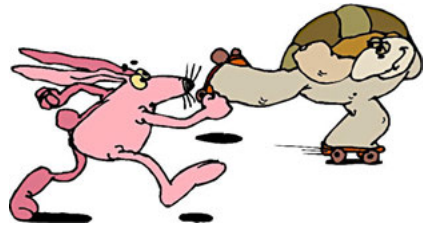
Theseus finds the Minotaur and kills him.

Cain gave some extra crops he had since he had grown plenty and wouldn't miss it. God was displeased with his sacrifice.

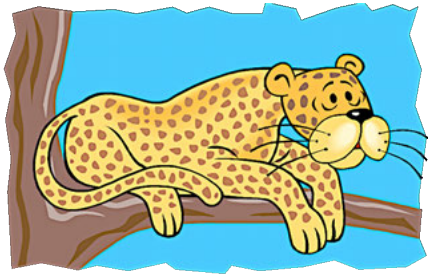
Cain was jealous of Abel as he thought God loved him more so he led him out to a field where he killed him.

This was good for the leopard as he could leap out at the giraffe, the zebra, the eland and other animals. Leopard would hunt with the Ethiopian.

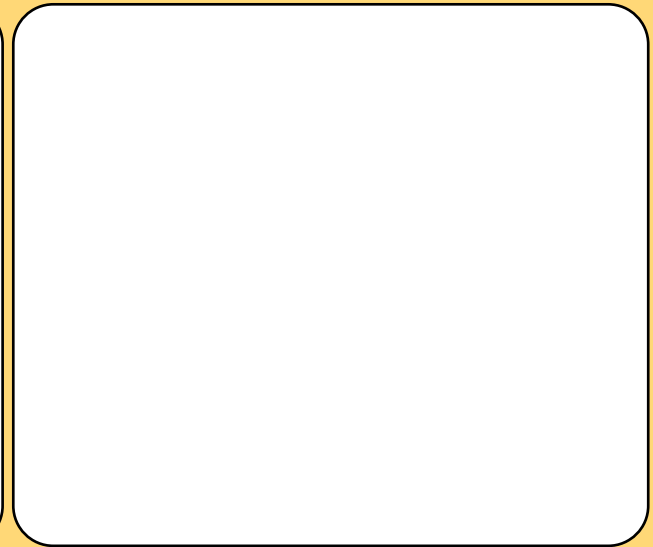
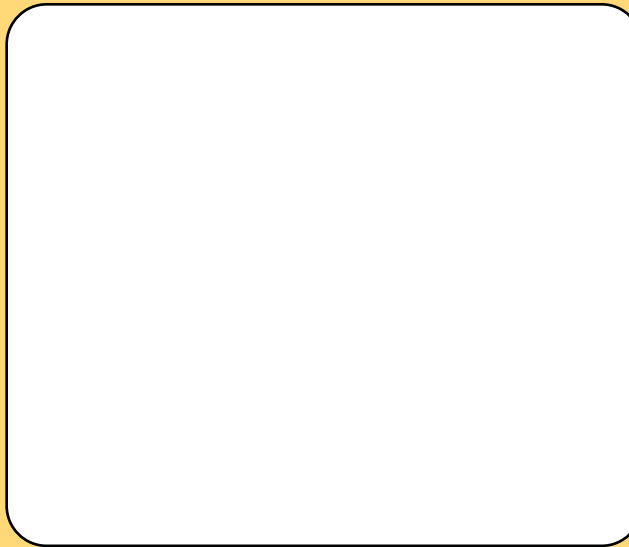
All the other animals eventually went to live in the forest that was full of spotty, stripy shadows. The leopard and the Ethiopian wondered where they had gone.
