Thesis Statement

- WHAT IS IT?
- In an essay, it declares what you believe and what you intend to prove.

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- Fact: Tuck Everlasting is a novel about life, death and living forever.
- Thesis: In the novel, *Tuck Everlasting*, Natalie Babbitt uses the element of water to demonstrate its necessity in the life cycle by incorporating water throughout the novel.



The thesis is the main idea, not the title. It must be a complete sentence or two that explain in detail what you expect to discuss.



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A TITLE: LIVING FOREVER

Thesis: The idea of living forever is an important theme in *Tuck Everlasting* because the author uses her characters, the Tucks, to stress the different perspectives of this dilemma.



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Broad: The Man in the Yellow suit is important to the novel *Tuck Everlasting*.

Thesis: The Man in the Yellow suit is important to the novel because his evil presence and plans for the water stress the difference between the Tucks protection of the water.

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Multiple points: The themes of change and love are both important themes in the novel, Tuck Everlasting. WHY WOULD THIS BE DIFFICULT TO WRITE ABOUT FROM AN ORGANIZATIONAL PERSPECTIVE?

Can you think how to correct it?

Did you answer the prompt?

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- Does your essay support the thesis specifically? If your body paragraphs and evidence don't support the thesis, you need to change something, either the evidence or your thesis.

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- Many clear and engaging thesis statements contain words like "because", "since", "so", "although", "unless", and "however".
- Be sure you can underline or find something in your thesis that CAN be proved. This will be your evidence/ examples for the body paragraphs.

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- The two reasons/examples/details should also be included in the thesis.
