<p>-He was her first crush</p> <p>-Her neighbor, Kat, liked him</p> <p>-He became her boyfriend</p> <p>-Hannah dreamed repeatedly about having her first kiss with Justin</p> <p>-Justin started a rumour that Hannah let him feel her up, which ruined the memory of her first kiss for Hannah</p>	<p>-Justin's rumour affected Hannah's reputation</p> <p>-Hannah became known as a "slut"</p>	<p>-Rumours can be dangerous/devastating to their victims</p> <p>-Is this the start of the "snowball" effect Hannah mentions?</p> <p>-Justin probably feels humiliated, and/or guilty</p> <p>-How was Hannah treated after this?</p>

How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-He wrote the list of who is hot and who is not</p> <p>-He included Hannah as having the hottest ass (Jessica Davis had the worst ass)</p> <p>-Hannah knew the list was a joke, but she noticed that everyone was whispering and laughing about her</p>	<p>-Jessica was extremely angry (red face, tapping her pen)</p> <p>-A guy came into the candy shop (Blue Spot) and grabbed Hannah's bum</p> <p>-She slapped his hand away, but he grabbed her wrist and held her shoulder: he said, "Relax. I'm just playing."</p> <p>-Wally got upset</p>	<p>-Alex maybe isn't to blame, but his actions seemed to influence this guy</p> <p>-Who IS this guy????!!!</p> <p>-If Clay knows him and knows his "move," why hasn't Clay said anything?</p> <p>-Why didn't Wally say something?</p>

<p>-Jessica, Alex, and Hannah were all new students at the school and they made friends</p> <p>-They met at Monet's often to talk about their days</p> <p>-Alex wrote the Who's Hot/Who's Not list</p> <p>-Jessica thinks that Hannah broke Jessica and Alex up by having a relationship with him</p> <p>-Jessica hits Hannah and gave her a scar above her eyebrow</p> <p>-Hannah lost her friend(s)</p>	<p>-Most people believed that Hannah broke Jessica and Alex up</p> <p>-The boys in the locker room tease Alex about sleeping with Hannah, but Alex doesn't say anything except to Clay</p>	<p>-How could Hannah have stopped the rumours? Could she have?</p> <p>-Would people rather believe nasty gossip than the truth?</p> <p>-Hannah has lost her friends and must be very lonely</p>

Character Name: Tyler Down		
How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-Hannah discovers that Tyler is sneaking around under her bedroom window and is taking pictures of her</p> <p>-Hannah's parents are away, and she doesn't tell them or call the police</p> <p>-Hannah tells a popular girl at school that she has a Peeping Tom and doesn't know who it is</p> <p>-The two girls decide to try and catch the Peeping Tom on their own</p> <p>-The girls set a trap by pretending to have a sexual relationship (back rub, lotion, mysterious items in Hannah's drawer</p> <p>-Hannah looks out the window, but doesn't know who it is until the next day at school</p> <p>-Hannah feels unsafe in her own house</p>	<p>-The mystery girl felt excited to think of Peeping Tom</p> <p>-She pretends to have a sexual relationship with Hannah to try and catch the guy</p>	<p>-Why didn't Hannah call the police?</p> <p>-Why didn't she tell her parents?</p> <p>-Who is the mystery girl???!!!</p> <p>-Why didn't Hannah admit to Tyler that she knows what he was doing? Would it have helped?</p>

Character Name: Courtney Crimsen

How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-She uses Hannah to make it look like she's a better person</p> <p>-She ditches Hannah as soon as they get to the party</p> <p>-She also tells a guy at the party that Hannah has a special surprise in her dresser drawer</p> <p>-Hannah eventually has Tyler Down take a photo of herself and Courtney to show Courtney that she knows what Courtney is really like (Tyler then puts the photo at Monet's Coffeehouse)</p> <p>-Courtney feels uncomfortable</p>	<p>-Courtney makes a guy believe that Hannah is easy</p> <p>-When Hannah leaves, she takes Tyler home (what will people think if they see Hannah leaving the party with Tyler?)</p>	<p>-Hannah handled the situation with Courtney well</p> <p>-Snowball seems to be getting bigger</p> <p>-Courtney is mean</p> <p>-Courtney is covering up her own ugly personality</p>

Character Name: Marcus Cooley

<p>-He was her Valentine match and he asked her out to Rosie</p> <p>-Hannah decided to give him a chance</p> <p>-He made her laugh</p> <p>-He began to grope Hannah's leg</p> <p>-She told him to stop, but had to push him out of the booth</p> <p>-He called her a tease</p>	<p>-The others failed to help Hannah (maybe they didn't want to interfere)</p> <p>-Hannah now gets a reputation of being a tease</p>	<p>-Would I have said something?</p> <p>-Why would Marcus be angry?</p> <p>-Why didn't Hannah tell someone?</p>

Character Name: Zach Dempsey

How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-Zach approached Hannah at Rosie's right after Marcus left</p> <p>-Hannah did not respond to Zach, so Zach left</p> <p>-However, Hannah heard Zach's friends teasing him about asking her out (Hannah figured it was all a bet)</p> <p>-Hannah thinks that Zach began stealing her notes out of her bag in Peer Communications</p> <p>-She left a fake note and it disappeared (she saw Zach looking in her bag the next day)</p> <p>-Hannah put a note for Zach in her own paper bag (explaining how down she was) and Zach took it, but said nothing</p> <p>-Hannah leaves a note for Mrs. Bradley requesting that they discuss suicide, but the class feels the person just wanted attention</p>	<p>-Zach's actions did not affect anyone other than Hannah because no one else knew what he did</p>	<p>-Maybe Hannah would have contributed more in class if Zach had not stolen her notes</p> <p>-Why would Zach steal her notes???</p> <p>-Why didn't Mrs. Bradley interrupt the discussion or offer her help???</p>

Character Name: Ryan Shaver		
How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-Hannah and Ryan went to the same poetry group</p> <p>-They made fun of the other people's poems for being so sad</p> <p>-Showed each other their own poems and Ryan really liked one of Hannah's poems</p> <p>-He told her that she doesn't know how to love or accept herself (she thinks he was right)</p> <p>-Ryan stole Hannah's poem and published it in his magazine (everybody in school read it, and even the teachers taught it); Hannah was embarrassed & betrayed</p>	<p>-All the other students in the school began talking about Hannah's poem, or making fun of it</p> <p>-The other girls in Hannah's class would make their own versions of her poem and read them out loud in class</p> <p>-Clay remembers hearing this poem and looking at Hannah, but he turned away</p> <p>-Clay is prevented from talking to or helping Hannah because he is afraid of her reputation</p>	<p>-Why didn't anyone help Hannah or even bother getting to know her?</p> <p>-Is Clay at all to blame?</p> <p>-Why didn't Hannah see a counsellor?</p> <p>-Clay only sees now that Hannah is gone, how much she meant to him, and how he could have helped her</p>

Character Name: Clay Jensen

How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-Clay is on these tapes because Hannah had a crush on him, and was curious about him since no one ever had anything bad to say about him</p> <p>-Hannah snuck out of her bedroom window to go to a party that Clay would be at (passed an old man who would play a vital part in Hannah's life)</p> <p>-Hannah and Clay talked and laughed at the party, and ended up in a bedroom kissing</p> <p>-Hannah remembers her first kiss (Justin) and feels embarrassed to be kissing "perfect" Clay when she has such a bad reputation</p> <p>-After Clay leaves, Hannah cries</p>	<p>-Clay's presence in the bedroom with Hannah may have added to her reputation, but he NEVER told anyone</p>	<p>-Why didn't Hannah and Clay just be honest with each other?</p> <p>-If they had been honest with each other, would Hannah have killed herself?</p> <p>-What would Clay have been thinking as he left?</p>

Character Name: Justin Foley		
How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-Justin and Jessica were making out at a party, beside Clay and Hannah</p> <p>-Eventually, Justin brings Jessica to the same bedroom that Hannah was sitting in, but he leaves Jessica when she is unresponsive</p> <p>-Justin stands outside the door, but lets Bryce Walker in to have "a few minutes" with Jessica before he leaves for the night-shift</p> <p>-Bryce rapes Jessica while Hannah hides in the closet, and Justin stays outside the door</p>	<p>-If Justin had not let Bryce into Jessica's bedroom, she would not have been raped</p> <p>-Hannah feels that she and Justin are both to blame (guilty) of the rape, even though they didn't do it</p>	<p>-If Hannah and Justin had not been drinking, would they have saved Jessica</p> <p>-Justin should have gone into the bedroom, or have not let Bryce in the bedroom at all</p> <p>-Was Jessica conscious?</p> <p>-Jessica must be feeling awful listening to these tapes</p> <p>-Justin must feel very guilty</p> <p>-Hannah protected Jessica's anonymity by not saying her name</p>

Character Name: Jenny Kurtz		
How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-Jenny offered Hannah a ride home because Hannah didn't look well</p> <p>-Hannah felt peaceful and secure in Jenny's car</p> <p>-Jenny hit a stop sign and knocked it down</p> <p>-Hannah wanted to report the accident, but Jenny would not let her do that because Jenny would have been in trouble for careless driving, reckless endangerment, and/or drunk driving</p> <p>-Jenny kicked Hannah out of the car, and wouldn't even let Hannah use her phone</p> <p>-Jenny drove herself home</p>	<p>-A senior student from the high school was delivering pizzas that night, and he ended up being hit by the old man who lived in Hannah's old house</p> <p>-The old man didn't stop at the intersection because the stop sign was gone</p> <p>-The senior died and the old man felt terrible guilt (he and his wife will likely be affected for the rest of their lives)</p> <p>-When Hannah leaves Jenny, she does go to the gas station and calls to report the sign. She is told the police are en route</p> <p>-Hannah finds out about the accident the next day and feels awful</p>	<p>-Jenny is 100% responsible for this accident!</p> <p>-Did Jenny's parents know what Jenny did, and are they covering it up?</p> <p>-Why does Hannah feel so guilty? She did her best to stop Jenny – she even called the police herself</p> <p>-If the other events had never happened, would Hannah have felt the same way?</p> <p>-Clay realizes that all of the characters should have / could have stopped something and no one did</p> <p>-THE STOP SIGN IS A SYMBOL!!!!</p>

Character Name: Bryce Walker (tape likely given to Courtney)		
How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-Hannah meets up with Bryce and Courtney after a party at Courtney's house</p> <p>-They all get into the hot-tub together in their underwear</p> <p>-Bryce and Hannah end up alone when Courtney leaves, and then Bryce and Hannah have sex</p> <p>-Hannah seems to have let herself be in this situation to make herself feel even worse so she can carry out her plans for suicide</p>	<p>-Courtney left the hot tub (maybe she was uncomfortable, maybe she wanted to give them privacy?)</p>	<p>-Is this a rape?</p> <p>-Hannah clearly does not want to have a relationship with Bryce, but lets things happen</p> <p>-Bryce took advantage of Hannah, but Hannah also took advantage of Bryce</p> <p>-Hannah knew what would happen, but she let it happen so her "reputation" would become true</p> <p>-How must Bryce feel now listening to the tapes???</p>

Character Name: Mr. Porter		
How Did This Character's Actions Influence Hannah?	How Did This Character's Actions Influence Others?	Personal Thoughts:
<p>-Hannah goes to Mr. Porter, her guidance counsellor, for help</p> <p>-She is very vague with him, but does tell him she wants her life to be done and that something happened at a recent party</p> <p>-Mr. Porter guesses that the something has to do with a boy, and tells Hannah she has two options if she can't confirm a rape – confront the boy, or “move on”</p> <p>-Hannah leaves the appointment hoping Mr. Porter will follow her, but he doesn't</p> <p>-Hannah decides to end her own life and “move on”</p>	<p>-No one was directly affected by Mr. Porter's actions because no one else knew about the tapes</p>	<p>-Now that the tapes are out, the other people on the tapes will know that Mr. Porter drove the last nail into Hannah's coffin</p> <p>-Mr. Porter will probably feel terrible when he hears these tapes</p> <p>-When Mr. Porter thinks back to his appointment with Hannah, he probably feels guilty (he had to take a week off work when he heard about Hannah)</p>
