On November 9, the Church celebrates the **Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome**, the oldest and highest ranking of the four major basilicas in Rome. The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the cathedral of the diocese of Rome, the official ecclesiastical seat of the Holy Father, the Bishop of Rome, not Saint Peter's Basilica as so many mistakenly believe. The Basilica is also called the Church of Holy Savior or the Church of Saint John Baptist. In ancient Rome this was the church where everyone was baptized. It the oldest church in the West, built in the time of Constantine and was consecrated by Pope Sylvester in 324. This feast became a universal celebration in honor of the archbasilica, the ecclesiastical mother church, called "the mother and mistress of all churches of Rome and the world" (*omnium urbis et orbis ecclesiarum mater et caput*), as a sign of love for and union with the See of Peter.

Memorial of Saint Leo the Great, Pope and Doctor of the Church November 10

Pope St. Leo the Great lived in the 5th century. Little is known of his early life prior to his serving as a deacon in the Roman Church. As Pope, he enhanced the prestige and power of the papacy and increased its influence beyond Italy. Politically, he dissuaded Attila the Hun from invading Italy as well as helped victims when the Vandals looted Rome in 455. Theologically, he is remembered for issuing the Tome to Flavian. It was very influential at the Council of Chalcedon, the fourth ecumenical council, which addressed the dual nature of Christ. He was a proficient writer, composing 143 letters and over 96 sermons which add insight into the ecclesiastical practices of the time as well as speak in clear theological language. He was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1754 by Benedict XIV.

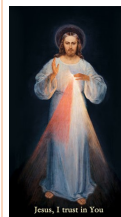
They assist the celebrant in the distribution of the Blessed Sacrament at Mass. They are a very large portion of our ministry needs for Masses. They must be Confirmed, a member of Saint Peter, and in "Good Standing" with the church. We need approximately **30 ministers each weekend**. Ministers are also sharing the Eucharist with those in the hospital, the homebound and those in nursing homes. Training required.



The Mass, or Eucharistic Liturgy, is the center of worship in the Catholic faith. During the Liturgy of the Word at Mass, lay persons act as Lectors who read the First or Second Readings of the day. They are responsible for practicing to enhance their understanding of each scriptural reading and the quality of their presentation. The Lector may also be asked to read the intentions during the Prayer of the Faithful. Training is provided, and a lector workbook is available for you to prepare the weekend's readings. Two Lectors are needed for every weekend Mass.



Assist arriving parishioners, pass the collection baskets during Mass, and help distribute bulletins They also alert the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to those parishioners unable to approach the altar for Communion.

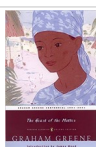
