ENDING THE HOMESTAND: The O's wrap up their season-long 11-game homestand tonight, having gone 3-7 in the first 10 games...Four of the 10 games during the homestand, including last night, have been one-run games, with the O's going 1-3.

- ⚾ The O's are 7-11 against New York-AL this season, including 3-6 at Oriole Park...The last time the O's defeated the Yankees more than seven times in a season was in 2016 when they went 10-9.
- ⚾ Of the O's 17 remaining games, including today, 10 will come against the AL East...The O's have gone 17-49 against the division this season, and 7-27 at Oriole Park...The O's have not won a series at home against the AL East this season (0-9-2), while going 2-8-0 in series' on the road.

SEPTEMBER HAYS: **OF Austin Hays** recorded his second multi-homer game in his last five games last night (also: September 11 vs. TOR G1); his third multi-home run game this season and the fourth of his career...His six home runs in September are tied for the second-most in the majors and American League, while his 10 extra-base hits (3-2B, 3B, 6 HR) this month are tied for the third-most in baseball.

- ⚾ He's hit safely in 19 of his last 21 games, since August 24, raising his OPS +.081 during this stretch, from .686 to his current .767...He's slashing .302/.351/.736 (16-for-53) with six home runs in 13 September games...His six homers are the most he's hit in any month this season.
- ⚾ For his career, Hays has slashed .304/.347/.557 (70-for-230) with 14 home runs in 67 September games...Has 15 total homers in all other months combined (121 G).
- ⚾ This season, he is batting .298/.333/.545 (53-for-178) with 10 home runs against left-handed pitching, while hitting .223/.278/.409 (55-for-247) with 10 homers against right-handed pitching.

NOTES ON THE LONG BALL: The Orioles have homered 56 times at home since the All-Star Break (30 G), the most in the majors...Their 113 home runs at home on the season are the second-most in the AL and the third-most in the majors.

- ⚾ Orioles players have recorded 17 individual multi-home run games this season, the second-most by a team in the majors, trailing only Toronto's 21 such games...The 17 individual multi-homer games are the fifth-most in Orioles history.
- ⚾ The Orioles have four players with at least 20 home runs this season (**Mullins**, **Mountcastle**, **Mancini**, **Hays**)...They are one of seven teams in the majors to have at least four players with 20+ homer seasons: Houston (4) and Atlanta, Boston, Cincinnati, Los Angeles-NL, Toronto (5).
- ⚾ The O's have hit five home runs this season in the eighth-inning-or-later that gave them the lead after trailing or being tied prior (**Hays** - 2, **Mullins** - 2, **Stewart** - 1).

WALK THIS WAY: **INF Trey Mancini** has drawn a walk in a career-high eight-straight games...It's the longest active streak in the majors and tied for the fourth-longest streak in baseball this season...It's the longest streak by an Oriole since **Brian Roberts** also walked in eight-straight games from September 9-17, 2009; the last Oriole with a walk in at least nine-straight games was **Ken Singleton** in 1978 when he walked in a club-record-tying 10-straight games...**Boog Powell** owns four of the top five walk streaks, other than Singleton's streak, in club history (nine-straight two times and 10-straight two times).

- ⚾ Mancini has reached base safely in 12 of his last 16 plate appearances against the Yankees (four games - since September 3)...On the season, Mancini is slashing .288/.431/.481 (15-for-52) in 16 games against the Yankees.

162 COMPLETED: **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** played in his 162nd career game last night; across these 162 games, he posted a slash line of .276/.328/.492 (165-for-597) with 28 doubles, 33 home runs, 80 runs, and 103 RBI...He is the only Oriole in club history to record at least 100 RBI in their first 162 games and his 33 home runs are the second-most by an Oriole in their first 162 games (**Jay Gibbons** - 34).

- ⚾ His 28 home runs this season are tied with **Cal Ripken, Jr.** in 1982 for the most in a single-season by a rookie in Orioles history...His 28 home runs are the second-most by a rookie in the majors (**Garcia**, TEX - 30)...There have been five 30+ home runs seasons by a rookie in the American League since 2000 (**Judge**, NYY - 52 in 2017, **Abreu**, CWS - 36 in 2014, **Jiménez**, CWS - 31 in 2019, **Trout**, LAA - 30 in 2012, and **Garcia**, TEX - 30 this year).
- ⚾ His 14 home runs since the All-Star Break (43 G) lead the O's, while his 32 RBI are tied for the team lead (**Hays**); he's slashing .272/.324/.574 (46-for-169) in the second half...His .574 second half slugging percentage is the fourth-highest in the AL among qualifiers (min. 184 PA).
- ⚾ His 80 RBI are the fifth-most in a single-season by an O's rookie; trailing only **Jim Gentile** (98 - 1960), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (93 - 1982), **Eddie Murray** (88 - 1977), and **Ron Hansen** (86 - 1960).

THE MAN AT THE TOP: **OF Cedric Mullins** sits at 29 HR and 28 SB on the season...He is looking to become the sixth player (10th time) in Major League history 5'8"-or-shorter to record 30 home runs in a single season: **José Altuve** (31 - 2019), **Jimmy Rollins** (30 - 2017), **Kirby Puckett** (31 - 1986), **Yogi Berra** (30 - 1956 and 30 - 1952), **Hack Wilson** (56 - 1930, 39 - 1929, 31 - 1928, 30 - 1927).

- ⚾ His eight leadoff home runs are tied for the most in the majors (**Schwarber**, WSH/BOS) and are the second-most in a single season in Orioles history (since 1954), trailing only **Brady Anderson's** 12 in 1996...28 of his 29 homers have come batting leadoff (July 4 at LAA, entered the game as a pinch-hitter); Anderson (35, 1996) holds the franchise record for the most home runs while batting first, and is also the only player in O's history with more than 30 homers in a season out of the leadoff spot.
- ⚾ He is batting .362/.400/.661 (46-for-127) in the first inning this season...Mullins' 46 first-inning hits are the most in the majors and also the most in any single inning in the majors...Mullins' 20 first-inning extra-base hits (10-2B, 2-3B, 8 HR) also lead all of baseball.
- ⚾ Mullins is the first player in Orioles history (since 1954) to have recorded at least 28 HR/28 SB in a single season...Since 2000, he is one of 12 center fielders in the majors to have reached these numbers; he's the first in the AL to do so since **Mike Trout**, LAA in 2016 (29 HR/30 SB).
- ⚾ Mullins' 292 total bases are the fourth-most in the majors, trailing only: **Guerrero, Jr.**, TOR (333), **Semien**, TOR (316), and **Pérez**, KC (305).
- ⚾ He's made 135 starts for the O's this season (142 games), with 133 coming in center field and two as the DH; all have come while batting lead off...His 133 starts in CF are tied for the most in the majors (**Straw**, CLE).

THIS AND THAT:

- ⚾ **C Austin Wynns** has hit safely in six of his last eight games and is batting .304/.360/.435 (7-for-23) during this stretch...Has scored a run in three-straight games.
- ⚾ **INF Ramón Urias** has recorded exactly one hit in nine of his last 10 games (Since August 31); has reached base safely in all 10 games during this stretch...His .358 OBP leads American League rookies (min. 280 PA) and is the third-highest among all Major League rookies.
- ⚾ Double-A Bowie have won 10-straight games and currently sit in second place in the Northeast League, 0.5 games behind first place Akron and 0.5 games ahead of third place Somerset, with the top two teams advancing to the playoffs.

QUICK HITS: Claimed off waivers from Tampa Bay on 8/20...Originally selected by Los Angeles-AL in the third round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Mississippi...As a junior, helped the Rebels reach the College World Series for the first time in 42 years...Selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 50th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Spain Park (Ala.) High School, but did not sign.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on 9/10 vs. TOR, throwing 5.0 innings and allowing one run on five hits and a career-high five walks, while striking out four... Has allowed one run-or-less in each of his last three starts after allowing three runs in the first start of his career on 8/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL...Has thrown 5.0 innings in consecutive starts.

VS. NEW YORK-AL: Threw 5.0 scoreless innings in the no decision on 9/4 at New York-AL; his first career-appearance against the Yankees... Exited the contest with 5.0 no-hit innings before an eventual scoring change reversed a fielding error; ended up allowing one hit and a career-high three walks with two strikeouts.

HOME VS. ROAD: Is making his third start at Oriole Park this year, having gone 0-0 and pitching to a 4.50 ERA (4 ER/8.0 IP) and a .313 (10-for-32) opponents batting average...Compared to making two starts on the road in which he has not factored in a decision and pitching to a 0.93 ERA (1 ER/ 9.2 IP), while holding opposing batters to a .094 (3-for-32) batting average.

ELLIS LOVES THE O'S: Made his Orioles debut and the first start of his career on 8/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL; did not factor in the decision of the O's 10-6 victory that snapped a 19-game losing streak...Allowed three runs on five hits (one home run) and one hit batter with three strikeouts through 3.0 innings...Became the 14th pitcher to make a start for the O's this season...Earned the first win of his career on 8/17 vs. Baltimore while with Tampa Bay through 4.0 scoreless innings of relief with a career-high seven strikeouts...Punched out Ramón Urías swinging in the sixth inning for his first-career strikeout.

MLB DEBUT: Tossed a scoreless ninth inning in Kansas City's loss on 3/31/19 vs. Chicago-AL, allowing one hit and issuing one walk...Made the Opening Day roster for the first time in his career with the Royals in 2019.

ON THE FARM: Has appeared in 179 Minor League games (119 starts) since 2014, going 46-45 with a 4.92 ERA (384 ER/702.1 IP) and 664 strikeouts...Spent time in the Angels, Braves, Cardinals, Royals, and Rays organizations...Went 1-5 with a 6.32 ERA (40 ER/57.0 IP) in 15 games (13 starts) with Triple-A Durham this season.

2021 SPRING TRAINING: Was a non-roster invitee to Tampa Bay Rays Spring Training this year...His first appearance was his only start, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning on 2/28 vs. Atlanta with two walks and two strikeouts...Went 0-1 through four relief appearances, posting a 13.50 ERA (9 ER/6.0 IP) with four walks and four strikeouts.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Went 1-0 and pitched to a 2.35 ERA (6 ER/23.0 IP) with 24 strikeouts in five games (four starts) for the Gigantes del Cibao of the Dominican Winter League.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP KEEGAN AKIN (2-9, 6.83 ERA)

Akin will be making his 22nd-career start (31 appearances), and his 16th start (23 appearances) of the season tomorrow at Fenway Park...In his last outing on 9/11 vs. TOR (G2) Akin suffered the loss, throwing 6.0+ innings, allowing three runs, one after he exited, on three hits and two walks, while striking out three...Did not allow a hit through his first 6.0 innings before allowing three-straight hits with no outs in the seventh before exiting in favor of LHP Tanner Scott; retired 15-straight batters after a lead off walk to start the game... Tomorrow will mark his third-career start against the Red Sox, in which he is 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (7 ER/8.0 IP); is 0-1 in one start vs. BOS this year suffering the loss on 8/15 at Fenway (4.0 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 3 BB, 2 K)...Including tomorrow's start, each of his three-career outings vs. BOS will have come at Fenway Park; is 1-5 in nine starts (13 appearances) on the road this year, pitching to a 7.60 ERA (38 ER/45.0 IP) and a .378 (57-for-185) opponents' average.
