Upstate community continues to illuminate lives of area children.







The success of the Roper Mountain Holiday Lights comes from an integrated partnership between the Upstate community, sponsoring organizations, the Rotary Club of Greenville and the Roper Mountain Science Center Association.

It takes about 600 volunteers 4,000 hours to plan and execute the month-long event. Rotary and RMSCA board volunteers are responsible for coordinating and setting up the displays; Roper

Mountain Science Center grounds crew assist with wiring and setup. Profits from the event are evenly divided between the Rotary Club, which designates local charities to receive contributions, and Roper Mountain Science Center Association, which uses to make improvements to the Science Center.

Roper Mountain Holiday Lights is the Rotary Club of Greenville's largest community service project. The club has more than 340 members representing professionals from Greenville's business, not-for-profit, and corporate sectors. Founded in 1916, Rotary Charities of Greenville is the state's oldest club and has been instrumental in advancing the city.

Over the years, the Rotary Club of Greenville helped build the area's first YMCA, raise funds for local hospital construction and assist needy families through scholarships and donations. The biggest recent project is the construction and operation of the Rotary Literacy Center at the YWCA.

About The Roper Mountain Holiday Lights

The Roper Mountain Holiday Lights traces its bright past to 1992 when the Buck Mickel star was placed atop Roper Mountain. Since then, the event has grown into the Upstate's premiere holiday lights display and includes more than 110 displays including Candy Cane Lane, Frosty and the Tunnel of Lights.

In 2007, the event invited guests to get out of the cars and explore a Winter Wonderland, which includes visits with Santa, holiday treats and other family activities.
