

### **CFR** at the Runoffs

### **Super Touring Under (STU)**

**Cameron Maugeri** made the trip to Mid Ohio for the 2016 SCCA Runoffs and had a pretty nice week. Competing in the #72 Krugspeed/Hoosier Lotus Exige, Maugeri earned the **Tire Rack Pole** for the Super Touring Under (STU) field.

Upon the drop of the Green Flag, Maugeri, despite a nagging misfire, held his own for the first three laps, but after a full course caution, gave up the lead to race winner, Joe Moser, at the end of the back straight on the lap-four restart.

Moser opened up to a more than six-second lead in the middle part of the race only to see Maugeri narrow the gap in the closing laps.

"I saw Cameron, he was just ticking off lap after lap, doing a fantastic job, and his car was flying," said Moser. "Had I screwed up, he would have got me, I am not sure I would have had much going for him, but I managed to bring this one home in first this time."

"Overall my car was pretty good," Maugeri said. "It was misfiring a little bit, it was something with the heat maybe, I am not sure, but besides that it was good. The first two laps were good but on the restart it just went south. I got nudged and dropped back a couple of spots, but then I just charged back as hard as Lould."

Maugeri clocked the fastest lap of the race and brings home a second-place National Championship finish by a 1.965 second margin.

### **B-Spec**

From the get-go, Tire Rack pole sitter Daughtery jumped to the lead with **Chi Ho**, of Orlando, Florida, tucked right behind in the No. o7 BFGoodrich/Orecagear.com/Ktuner Honda Fit. The two put some space immediately on the rest of the field as a few other competitors tangled at the second turn from the start.

Before the halfway point in the race, Daughtery had pulled away to what would become a 10-second lead

at times. He was never pressured and never gave up the top spot, claiming his ninth Runoffs win and first in B-Spec.

After Daughtery pulled away, Ho found himself falling back into the clutches of the chase pack consisting of John Phillips from Sealy, Texas, in the No. 43 PRP/Hoosier/Jacks Paint Place Honda Fit; John Heinricy, from Clarkston, Michigan, in the No. 35 Hoosier/Mobil/Hawk/Matick Chevy Chevrolet Sonic; and Ryan Hall, of New Haven, Connecticut, in the No. 03 IndianSummerRacing/AdvancedMonogram Mini Cooper. For several laps, those four had an exciting battle for the second podium position. Heinricy crossed the finish line in second place, but was relegated to third by the stewards for avoidable contact during the race.

"It's an honor to run against these multiple Runoffs champions," Ho said. "I just tried to be as consistent as possible, hit my marks every time, and hopefully give them a good fight at the end. Third place is good. It's not the top of the podium, but I'm happy with it."

Ho, crossed the line in third place, but inherited second when Heinricy was demoted. It is his first podium finish in only a second appearance at the national championship.

Phillips crossed the line in fourth, but was moved to the last finishing position for contact during the race. **Darren Seltzer**, of Oviedo, Florida, inherited fourth in the No. 64 ORECA/BFGoodrich/KTuner Honda Fit.

Taking the Sunoco Hard Charger award was **Jason Huepenbecker**, of Winter Park, Florida, in the No. 23 Dynasty Automotive Honda Fit, finishing 7th from his 10th-place grid position.

#### SRF<sub>3</sub>

**Brian Schofield**, of Lakeland, Florida, finished fifth in the No. 61 CFR PM Racing machine out of a field of 39 competitors.



### From BOG Chair



### Sunstroke Grand Prix

Rolled into Daytona International Speedway and couldn't help but flashback one year ago to the Runoffs... So much has changed. The speedway was undergoing the renovation into the "World Center of Racing" and the superstretch still had some of the grandstands standing... until of course the middle of the afternoon on Saturday that week when the pressbox/tower section came down mid-race. Despite the rumors, the FTM had absolutely NOTHING to do with it, right Snap?

Now we're a year later and ready to race. A lighter field than normal for this venue/event. Probably a fair number of competitors in Mid-Ohio for this year's Runoffs. Nevertheless, we race. It's Daytona Baby!

The usual Test Day was bumped for this event due to a scheduling conflict with the track. So Saturday morning we started off right out of the box with qualifying sessions, gridding from the "Runoffs Grid" next to the Turn 4 tunnel as the Tire Rack Street Survival School was also here, and they were using the truck pad area where we normally grid the field.

Daytona has graciously provided a building to store equipment on premise which is outside the track behind the superstretch... the change in location created some challenge initially in getting equipment/staff/radios where they needed to be, which delayed our start Saturday a bit, because you can't start qualifying sessions if Timing & Scoring isn't setup and prepared. We quickly managed to get equipment where it was needed and the six group qualifying sessions were run along with the qualifying session for the TES/ECR Enduro all before Saturday's lunch.

After lunch, Groups I and 2 ran their 20 minute Sprint Races. Group I saw I8 drivers in seven classes take the green flag with Daytona Beach's own Darryl Pritchett in the #92 Angry Sheep Motorsports BMW Z3 take a dominating overall and EP win with a 46.7 second margin over Nicole Hecker in the EP class #96 Mazda RX7. Phillip Ellis drove the HP class #86 VW Golf to third overall and the HP win. Wayne Butler took the



The front row of Group 1 Sprint Race. Darryl Pritchett in the #92 BMW Z3 would go on to win overall. Wayne Butler in the #22 Chevy Pro Challenge would take the SPU win and fourth overall.

SPU win and fourth overall in the #22 Chevy Pro Challenge followed by FP winner, Sid Collins in the #60 Porsche 356B. Patsy Zymowski was seventh overall winning the T4 class in "Marvin" the #122 Mazda MX5 followed by ITB winner, David Boles in the #79 VW Golf III. Miki Moerwald took the ITC win and 11th overall in her #47 VW Rabbit.

Group 2 brought a field of nine competitors in six classes. Linda Stewart drove the #97 DI Stewartracing RFR F2 to the overall win by 8.7 seconds over the FF winner, Roelof Blok in the #141 Van Dieman FR-83, followed by F500 winner, Charles Thomson in the #21 Sidewinder A-12. Mike Schiffer, District 8 Governor, took fifth overall and the FV win in the #29 Mysterian M2, followed by P1 winner, Sherry Dowling, in the #47 Beasley Lola T540, followed by John Schimenti in the #69 Swift DB6 who took the FF-W win.

The largest field of this weekend was easily the Enduro group which brought 47 cars in 11 classes to the stripe for a 90 minutes of endurance racing to cap off our Saturday schedule. Ormond Beach's Todd Vanacore completed 36 laps and took the overall win in the #19 Southeast Spec Racer SRF3 by a 24.5 second margin over ITR winner, Michael Flynn in the #26 BMW E46. Sid Collins in the #168 Porsche 911 won the ITS class taking seventh overall. The team of Wesley Saunders and A. Leister drove the #18 Mazada Miata to the Spec Miata win and ninth overall.

Wilbur Pickett drove the #127 Miata to the ITA class win, Timothy Nash notched the ISE30 win in the #1 BMW 325i, and the father/son team of Dana and


