- 1. Army chief Bipin Rawat will be appointed as New chairman of Chiefs of Staff Committee (COSC).
- 2. Bulgarian Economist Christina Georgieva has been appointed as new Chief of Washington, D.C. (US) based financing agency International Monetary Fund (IMF).
- 3. Government reconstituted Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister (EAC-PM) for 2 years. Bibek Debroy and Ratan P. Watal will continue to be Chairman and Member Secretary respectively of reconstituted EAC-PM. EAC-PM will have two Part-Time Members. While Ashima Goel continues to be one, Sajjid Chinoy has been made another Part-time Member.
- 4. Govt. appointed C.K. Abdul Rehim as acting Chief Justice of Kerala High Court and Vineet Kothari has been appointed as acting CJ of Madras High Court (HC).
- 5. Harjit Singh Arora appointed as new Indian Air Force (IAF) Vice Chief, succeeding Rakesh Kumar Singh Bhadauria who will take over as New Chief of Indian Air Force.
- 6. Madhukar Kamath (chairman emeritus of advertising firm DDB Mudra group) is elected as chairman of Audit Bureau of Circulations (ABC) for 2019-2020.

 - 12. Alison Rose has been appointed as First Female Chief of Royal Bank of Scotland, One of Britain's biggest banks.

- 8. Nilesh Shah (MD of Kotak Mahindra Asset Management) has been appointed as Chairman of Association of Mutual Funds in India (AMFI).
- 9. RBI superseded Board of Punjab and Maharashtra Cooperative Bank and appointed Jai Bhagwan Bhoria as Administrator of bank. It is done by RBI after defaults surging in PMC Bank and some lumpy loans to real estate companies that made it difficult for bank to meet its commitments.
 - 1. RBI has also put restriction on amount of withdrawal allowed to depositors to 10000 (up from 1000 put earlier).
 - 2. Directives of RBI shall remain in force for a 6 months.

- 11. Supreme Court bench headed by Chief Justice Ranjan Gogoi recommended former Delhi HC Chief Justice Rajendra Menon as next chairman of Armed Forces Tribunal (AFT).

 - 2. Award comprises a Swarna Kamal (Golden Lotus), a shawl and a cash prize of Rs.10 Lakh.

- 10. Indian IT Firm Infosys won United Nations (UN) Global Climate Action Award 2019 in the 'Climate Neutral Now' category for its efforts to combat climate change. It will be given this award during the UN Climate Change Conference (COP25) in Santiago, Chile in December 2019.
 - 1. Through its carbon offset drive, Infosys implemented energy efficiency proceedings and transitioned to renewable energy for all its electricity needs. Since 2008, It has decreased its per capita energy consumption by over 51 %.
- 11. Indian journalist Kallie Puri honoured with "India's Most Powerful Women in Media" award, at Confluence Excellence Awards at the British Parliament.

- 1. Sep 21 is observed as UN International Day of Peace. 2019 theme is Climate Action for Peace. It was first observed in 1981.
 - 1. Sep 21 is observed as World Alzheimer's Day, first observed in 2012.
 - 2. Sep 21 is also observed as International Coastal Cleanup Day, observed annually on third Saturday of September.
- 2. Sep 22 is observed as World Rhino Day, as an international ecological observance to raise awareness on protection of 5 existing species of rhinoceros white rhino, black rhino, Indian rhino, Javan rhino, and Sumatran rhino.

- 1. Sep 22 is also observed as World rose day, for welfare of cancer patients.
- 2. Sep 22, 2019 is also observed as Daughters' Day observed on 4th Sunday of September every year.
- 3. Sep 23 is observed as International Day of Sign Languages (IDSL), observed first in 2018. It aims to raise awareness of importance of sign language in the full realization of the human rights of people who are deaf. 2019 theme is Sign Language Rights for All.
 - 1. Sep 23 is also observed as Saudi National Day, to commemorate name changing of what was previously known as Kingdom of Nejd and Hejaz to Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
- 4. Sep 25 World Pharmacist Day, marked by FIP Council in 2009. 2019 theme is Safe and effective medicines for all.
 - 1. Sep 25 is also declared by Indian Govt as Antyodaya Diwas, announced in 2014. It marks Birth anniversary of noted philosopher Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay.
- 5. Sep 26 is observed as Foundation day of CSIR (Council of Scientific and Industrial Research), created in 1942. On this occasion, President Ram Nath Kovind unveiled first Indigenous High Temperature Fuel Cell System developed by CSIR under flagship program "New Millennium Indian Technology Leadership Initiative (NMITLI)".
 - 1. 5.0 kW fuel cell system generates power in a green manner using methanol / bio-methane, with heat and water as bi-products for further use; amounting to greater than 70% efficiency, which is not possible by other energy sources.
 - 2. Fuel Cells are based on High Temperature Proton Exchange Membrane (HTPEM) Technology. It is most suitable for distributed stationary power applications like small offices, commercial units, data centers etc.; where highly reliable power is essential with simultaneous requirement for air-conditioning.
- 6. Sep 26 is observed as International Day for the total elimination of nuclear weapons.
 - 1. Sep 26, 2019 is also observed as world maritime day, observed on Last Thursday of September. 2019 theme is "Empowering Women in the Maritime Community".
 - 2. Sep 26 is also observed as World Environmental Health Day (WEHD). 2019 theme is *Climate change challenges, time for global Environmental Health to act in unison*. It was declared by International Federation of Environmental Health (IFEH) in 2011.
- 7. Sep 27 World Tourism Day, marked in 1970. 2019 Theme is *Tourism and jobs: a better future for all*. India is host nation for Tourism Day 2019. On this Occasion, Govt. presented National Tourism Awards 2018 -
 - 1. Total 76 awards were given under various categories.
 - 2. Andhra Pradesh state won the first prize for Best State for Comprehensive Development of Tourism.
 - 3. Goa and Madhya Pradesh were announced as joint winners in Adventure Tourism category.
 - 4. Uttarakhand won best film promotion friendly state.
 - 5. Telangana won best state in innovative use of IT category.
- 8. Sep 28 International Day for the Universal Access to Information (commonly called Access to Information Day), being held since 2016.
 - 1. Sep 28 is also observed as World Rabies Day (Diesease caused by Dog Bites).
- 9. Sep 29 is observed as World Heart Day.
- 10. Sep 30 is observed as World Translation Day, marked by UN in 2017 to pay tribute to language professionals.

Defence

- 1. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh commissioned Indian Coast Guard Ship (ICGS) 'Varaha' into service.
- 2. > 23rd edition of trilateral Navy exercise of India, Japan and US named Malabar 2019 began at Sasebo (Japan).
- 3. BRAHMOS supersonic cruise missile featuring several major indigenous components has been successfully test fired for its full range of 290-km. Jointly developed by India and Russia, BRAHMOS has been operationalised in all 3 services of Indian Armed Forces.
- 4. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh commissioned India's second Scorpene-class attack submarine INS Khanderi, India's first P-17 Shivalik-class frigate INS Nilgiri and the largest aircraft carrier drydock into Indian Navy.
 - INS Khanderi is 2nd attack submarine under Project 75, first being INS Kalvari. It is built by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders in Mumbai. India aims to build 6 Scorpene-class submarines under P-75 in collaboration with France. Other 4 ships - INS Karanj, INS Vagir, INS Vagsheer and INS Vela.
 - 2. INS 'Nilgiri' is 1st of Indian Navy's 7 new stealth frigates under Project -17A, a design derivative of the Shivalik class stealth frigates with much more advanced stealth features and indigenous weapons and sensors. Its cost is over 45000 crores. 5

ships of Nilgiri-class (P-17A frigates) are named after famous hill ranges - Himgiri, Udaygiri, Dunagiri, Taragiri and Vindhyagiri. Last frigate (7th) will be named *Mahendragiri*.

- 5. Government hiked family pension for govt. employee who dies within 7 years of service, now to be 50% of last pay drawn from previous 30% for a period of 10 years.
- 6. Indian Army and Indian Air Force conducted exercise 'Chang Thang' in Eastern Ladakh bordering China, as first such exercise in the region.
- 7. Joint Military Exercise MAITREE-2019 between India and Thailand Armies conducted at Foreign Training Node, Umroi (Meghalaya). It is being held since 2006.

1. ▶ 37th GST Council Meeting Held in Panaji (Goa) under Chairmanship of F inance & Corporate Affairs Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. Key Recommendations Include -

1. Goods -

- 1. GST Council recommends lower 12% cess on 1,500 cc diesel, 1,200 cc petrol vehicles with capacity to carry up to 13 people..
- 2. Rate levied on cut and polished semi precious stones has been dropped from 3% to 0.25%. Jewellery exports to now attract zero GST.
- 3. Reduction in GST rates -

3. Competition Commission of India approved acquisition of 70 % stake in Saudi Basic Industries Corporation by Saudi Arabian Oil Company for \$69.1 billion. In India, SABIC is engaged in supply of petrochemical and agro-nutrients while Saudi Aramco supplies

crude oil, liquefied petroleum gas, base oil and petrochemical products.

- 1. In August 2019, Saudi Aramco has announced acquisition of 20% stake in oil to chemicals (OTC) business of Reliance Industries, for around \$15 billion.
- 4. Digital infrastructure provider Tata Communications partnered with Cisco for a secure, fully-managed, multi-channel, cloud-based Cisco Webex Contact Center solution. - 5. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman stated that to overcome slowdown and increase business activities, government has asked banks not to declare stressed loans of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) as Non Performing Assets (NPAs) until March 31, 2020.
 - 1. Public Sector Banks will organise 'loan melas' or "Shamiana meetings" in 400 districts, to provide loans to NBFCs and retail borrowers, including homebuyers and farmers.

- 6. IDBI Bank and Life Insurance Corporation of India Credit Cards Services (LIC CSL) will launch co-branded credit card.
- 7. Life insurance provider Aegon Life Insurance signed Corporate Agency Agreement with Paytm, to offer life insurance products.
- 8. Indian Army and Bank of Baroda signed to lay down basis of banking services to be provided by Bank of Baroda to personnel of Indian Army.
- 9. Paisalo Digital (Formerly *S.E Investments*) signed its second co-origination of loan agreement with Bank of Maharashtra (BoM), to necessitate joint contribution of credit flow by BoM and Paisalo. 1dst such agreement was signed by PAISALO with SBI, to pay out 200,000 loan applications in 2019.
- 10. Telecom frim Bharti Airtel has tied up with Bharti AXA Life Insurance, to offer prepaid plan for its users along with insurance protection plan. Airtel has launched a special prepaid plan of Rs 599, in which customers will get 2GB data per day, unlimited calling and life insurance cover of Rs 4 lakh from Bharti AXA Life Insurance with validity of 84 days.
- 12. ▶ NSDL Payments Bank (subsidiary of National Securities Depository Ltd) will soon start operations, as 6th Active Payments Bank in India.
 - 1. Others are Airtel Payments Bank, India Post Payments Bank, Fino Payments Bank, Jio Payments Bank and Paytm Payments Bank.
 - 2. NSDL was one of 11 applicants that received in-principle approval from RBI in August 2015 to set up payments banks.
- 13. Punjab National Bank launched a Preventive Vigilance (PV) portal to facilitate its staff members to check procedural lapses as well as promote good practices, to promote vigilance awareness in banking system.
- 14. ▶ RBI barred Punjab and Maharashtra Co-operative (PMC) Bank from doing any business for six months and capped depositor withdrawals at Rs 1000 per day.
 - 1. Defaults appear to have surged in the past six months amid tight economic conditions and some lumpy loans to real estate companies that turned sour, making it difficult for bank to meet its commitments.
- 15. RBI has put Prompt Corrective Action (PCA) Framework against Lakshmi Vilas Bank (LVB), limiting business activities of LVB.
 - 1. RBI has put LVB in PCA due to high NPA, insufficient capital to risk-weighted assets ratio (CRR) and Common Equity Tier 1 (CET1) negative RoA (Return on assets) for two consecutive years. Bank's net NPA is 7.49%, capital adequacy ratio was at 7.72% and its RoA was -2.32% as on March 2019.
- 16. ▶ SEBI eased norms for buyback (repurchase) of shares by listed companies, especially those having subsidiaries in housing finance and Non-Banking Financial Company (NBFC) segments .
 - 1. Ministry of Corporate Affairs earlier permitted government companies carrying out non-banking finance and housing finance activities to launch buybacks resulting in up to 6:1 debt to equity ratio post share repurchase.
 - 2. Buyback offer cannot exceed 25% of aggregate paid-up capital and free reserves of company and an approval from the shareholders is required through a special resolution in case the size exceeds 10%.
 - 3. At present, post-buyback debt-to-equity ratio is up to 2:1, except for companies for which a higher ratio has been notified. If debt to equity ratio exceeds 2:1 threshold, buybacks would be allowed after excluding subsidiaries that are NBFCs and HFCs.
 - 4. Standalone debt to equity ratio of all such excluded subsidiaries should not exceed 6:1. Earlier, Sebi had proposed to keep this threshold at 5:1.
- 17. > SEBI imposed a penalty of over Rs 22 crore on Aurobindo Pharma and its promoters, for violating insider trading norms.
- 18. SEBI) eased its norms to allow smart cities to raise funds through 'Muni Bonds'. Entities in areas of city planning and urban development work, including municipalities, special purpose vehicles (SPVs) under 'Smart Cities Mission' can also raise funds through debt securities.
 - SEBI had issued its Issue and Listing of Debt Securities by Municipalities (ILDM) Regulations 5 years ago and since then 7
 municipalities have raised nearly Rs 1,400 crore by issuing their debt securities, which are commonly known as 'Muni
 Bonds'.
 - 2. Several Requirements have been withdrawn and Rules pertaining to creation of escrow accounts were eased.
 - 3. SEBI allowed this route for other structures where a group of municipalities pools their resources together to jointly raise funds through the issuance of bonds, generally known as Pooled Finance Development Funds (PFDF).

- 4. In case of private placements, minimum subscription amount per investor currently at Rs 25 lakh has been reduced to Rs 10 lakh, to align it with regulations for corporate bonds.
- 19. ▶ To contain price rise of onions, Government imposed stock limits on traders and banned exports. It asked State Governments to take strict measures to prevent hoarding by traders including organising raids.
 - 1. Stock limit of 100 quintal on retail traders and 500 quintals on wholesale traders has been imposed across country.
 - 2. Earlier, Minimum Export Price of US\$ 850 F.O.B. per metric ton was imposed on export of onions.
- 20. To improve risk management & ensure sufficient liquidity, SEBI tightened rules for mutual funds, in which it make it mandatory forliquid schemes to hold at least 20 % in liquid assets such as cash and cash equivalents like treasury bills and repo on government securities.

New guideline will come into force from April 1, 2020.

21. Wipro Consumer Care and Lighting has launched "Wipro Consumer Care—Ventures" startup venture fund to invest in startups in the consumer brands space.

- 1. As per IIFL (India Infoline Finance Limited) Wealth Hurun India Rich List 2019, Mukesh Ambani (Reliance chairman) named richest person in India with a wealth of Rs 3.8 lakh crores, staying at top for 8th straight year. He is followed by London based SP Hinduja and family (Rs 1.86 lakh crore), Wipro founder Azim Premji (Rs 1.17 lakh crore), ArcelorMittal CEO L N Mittal (Rs 1.07 lakh crore).
- 2. Australian capital Canberra became first Australian city to legalise, possessing and growing marijuana for personal use. People aged 18 or above will be allowed to possess 50 grams of marijuana and grow two plants.
- 3. Bank of International Settlements (BIS) launched a dollar green bond fund enabling central banks around the world to invest in "green bonds". Aim is to let central banks incorporate environmental sustainability into reserve management without destroying assets & reserves.
 - 1. Bonds which have eligible for inclusion in fund should have a minimum rating of A- and adhere to the International Capital Market Association's (ICMA) Green Bond Principles or the Climate Bond Standard published by the Climate Bonds Initiative (CBI).
 - 2. Green Bond is a bond whose proceeds are used to fund environment-friendly projects. First entity to issue green bonds was the World Bank, which began the practice in 2008.
- 4. China and Kiribati formally re-established their diplomatic relations, a few days after Kiribati called off its ties with Taiwan.
 - 1. China and Kiribati were allies till 2003 but after that Kiribati established relations with Taiwan and recognised its country status, leading China to break off its diplomatic ties with Pacific island nation.
 - 2. China considers Taiwan its territory and opposes Taiwan building diplomatic relations with other nations.
- 5. China based Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) will invest in six projects with 1.09 billion U.S. dollars in countries of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).
- 6. China launched its first amphibious assault ship, which would enable ground forces to carry out attacks on enemy territory from sea. It is first in Type 075 class of amphibious assault ship, which is also defined as a type of landing helicopter dock.
- 7. European Union's top court ruled that Google does not have to apply "Right to be forgotten law" globally. This means that Google has to remove data links to personal information only in its European version of search results and not elsewhere in world.
 - 1. Court said there was no obligation for a search engine to carry out de referencing on all versions of its search results.
 - 2. Case was filed against google by a French watch dog CNIL demanding fine of 100,000 Euros for Google refusing to de list sensitive information globally. Demand was to remove satirical photo montage of a female politician and couple of articles referring to public relations officers of Church of Scientology.
 - 3. Right to be forgotten was laid down by the European Court in 2014. Court ruled that people can ask search engines like Google to remove irrelevant information appearing under searches for their names.
- 8. Facebook announced that it will acquire CTRL Labs, a tech company that makes wrist bands capable of reading minds. The band can transmit electrical signals from brain into computers as digital input. Deal is worth 500 million to 1 billion USD.
- 9. Infosys topped among 17 Indian Companies listed in Forbes World's best 'regarded' companies list 2019, ranked 3rd globally.

- 11. Japan's unmanned H-2B rocket lifted off with cargo vessel Kounotori8 also known as HTV 8 towards International Space Station (ISS), considered as the world's biggest transport spaceship. It intends to deliver about 5.3 tonnes of supplies to astronauts at ISS.
- 12. National Library of Israel unveiled an 80 year old handwritten letter by M K Gandhi on day World War II broke out (September 1, 1939). He had wished the Jewish people an *era of peace* in his letter. He addressed this letter to Bombay Zionist Association that was struggling to turn support of Indian leaders in favor of movement to establish a home for Jews.
- 13. ▶ Nepal's Central Bank (Nepal Rastra Bank) released 3 coins (100, 1000 and 2500 Nepali rupees) bearing Sikh symbol to commemorate 550th Birth Anniversary of Guru Nanak Dev. Book titled "Sikh Heritage of Nepal" was also launched.
- 14. ▶ Russia formally accepted 2015 Paris agreement on Climate Change. Russia will now allocate financial resources towards developing countries for prevention of and adaptation to climate change.
 - 1. Paris Agreement is an agreement within UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCC) that was signed in 2016.
 - 2. It deals with greenhouse-gas-emissions (GHG) mitigation, adaptation, and finance.
- 15. ▶ Russia held its annual TSENTR 2019 International Command Exercise involving six other nations. Forces from China, India, Pakistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, and Uzbekistan joined Russia's annual exercise.
- 16. ▶ Saudi Arabia will offer tourist visas for the first time, opening up conservative kingdom to holidayers as part of a push to diversify its economy away from oil.
- 17. Taiwan has cut off its ties with Kiribati (Oceanic Nation), amid Taiwan's tensions with China. China claims Taiwan to be its territory and says that it has no right to having formal ties with any country.
- 18. Tripartite mechanism to monitor and assess repatriation process of displaced Rohingya people to Myanmar has been agreed between Bangladesh, Myanmar and China. 7 lakh 50 thousand refugees entered Bangladesh from Myanmar after process of ethnic cleansing was initiated in Myanmar in 2016 & 2017.
- 19. UAE astronaut Hazzaa al-Mansoori became first Arab to reach International Space Station (ISS), lifting off from Kazakhstan in a Russian spacecraft. He was accompanied by Russia's Oleg Skripochka and NASA astronaut Jessica Meir.
- 20. World's oldest travel company Thomas Cook announced bankruptcy, after failing to secure a bailout package from investors. Collapse of this 178 year old British travel giant also left thousands of travelers stranded across Europe.

 - 1. Two-thirds of children below 5 years deaths in 2017 are still attributable to malnutrition

 - 1. Election Commission appointed Madhu Mahajan and B Murali Kumar as Special Expenditure Observers for forthcoming Elections to Legislative Assembly of Maharashtra. Actress Madhuri Dixit has been appointed as a goodwill ambassador for Maharashtra Assembly polls.

- 14. Google announced to open an artificial intelligence (AI) based research lab "Google Research India", in Bengaluru, to be led by Manish Gupta.
- 15. ▶ Gujarat Government launched India's 1st trading program called "Emissions Trading Scheme (ETS)" in Surat, to combat particulate air pollution.
 - 1. ETS is a market-based system where government sets a cap on emissions and allows industries to buy and sell permits (in kilograms) to stay below the cap.
 - Surat is chosen for implementaion of ETS as it is densely populated industrial center where textile and dye mills emit large amounts of air pollution & it is equipped with Continuous Emission Monitoring Systems which can track mass of Particulate Matter being released.
- 16. ▶ Home Affairs Minister Amit Shah launched 3 citizen centric services of Chandigarh Police, including Emergency Response Support System (ERSS Dial 112), 'E-Beat Book' System and the 'E-Saathi App'.
 - 1. ERSS project under Nirbhaya Fund, providing a single emergency number (112), preventing escalation of crime, especially against women and children. 'Dial 112' emergency response service is an initiative to strengthen proactive community policing that would end confusion amongst distress callers.

- 2. 'E-Beat Book' is a web and mobile based application which will ease collection, updation and analysis of the information related to crime and criminals in a real time.
- 3. 'E-Saathi' App would help the general public, including senior citizens, to remain in touch with the police and also give suggestions to facilitate participative community policing.
- 17. Home Minister Amit Shah laid foundation stone of new building of Registrar General of India (Janganana Bhawan/Census Building) in New Delhi He also announced to conduct first-ever "digital census" in 2021 (16th census of India and 8th since Indian independence).
 - 1. INR 12000 crores will be spent on preparation of National Population Register (NPR) and census 2021. It will be a transformation from paper census to digital census as mobile app will be used to collect data.
 - Home Minister also proposed single multipurpose identity card for citizens, with all utilities such as Aadhaar, driving license, passport and bank accounts merged into one.
 - 3. He also stated that National Intelligence Grid (NATGRID) being set up to track any terror suspect and prevent terrorist attacks with real time data, will start functioning by January 2020. NATGRID is a 3400 Crores project, as a robust intelligence gathering mechanism related to banking, immigration, individual tax payers and travels. It was conceptualised following 26/11 Mumbai terror attacks.
 - 4. He also launched 'Private Security Agency Licensing Portal', to help private security agencies get licenses, amid need to increase number of licensed private security.
- 18. ▶ Jammu and Kashmir become first state to distribute highest number of golden cards under Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY), showing positive intent of People of Jammu and Kashmir towards government schemes.
 - 1. Sep 23 also observed as 1st edition of Ayushman Bharat Diwas. Ayushman Bharat Yojana or Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) was launched from Ranchi on Sep 23, 2018.
- 19. ▶ Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) and IIT Delhi signed MoU for cooperation in research, education and technology developments in science and other disciplines. This collaboration will also facilitate access to each other's libraries and central research facilities. It will intensify joint research projects and other related academic activities.
- 20. Madhya Pradesh CM Kamal Nath announced that name of Bhopal metro will be 'Bhoj Metro', after late king Raja Bhoj. It will be built at a cost of about Rs 6,941.4 crore rupees. First phase of the metro project will be completed by 2023 with 2 corridors.
- 21. ▶ Minister of Health and Family Welfare Harsh Vardhan launched two initiatives to tackle the menace of genetic diseases in newborns Unique Methods of Management and treatment of Inherited Disorders (UMMID) initiative National Inherited Diseases Administration (NIDAN), Both supported by Department of Biotechnology (DBT).
 - Objective of UMMID is to make treatment of expensive genetic diseases in newborns within reach of all people. NIDAN kendras are to be established under UMMID initiative. These will provide counselling and management in government hospitals.
 - 2. Another objective is to produce skilled technicians in Human genetics to screen pregnant women and newborn babies for inherited genetic diseases.
- 22. Ministry for Civil Aviation directed setting up a mechanism to regularly monitor airfares in country, to enable monitoring of airfares by Ministry of Civil Aviation and Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA).
- 23. NASSCOM's Data Security Council of India (DSCI) collaborated with Ministry of Electronics and IT (MeitY) and Google India to launch nationwide awareness campaign 'Digital Payment Abhiyan', launched by Communications and Electronics & IT Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad at 'Google for India' event in New Delhi.
- 24. ▶ NITI Aayog released SEQI (School Education Quality Index), evaluating performance of States / UTs in school education (For 2016-17).
 - 1. 18 of 20 large states improved in overall performance, with highest performance recorded in Kerala, followed by Rajasthan and Karnataka. Uttar Pradesh ranked last in list of 20 large states.
 - 2. Among small states Manipur (1), Tripura (2) and Goa (3).
 - 3. UTs Chandigarh (1), Dadra and Nagar Haveli (2), Delhi (3).
- 25. NTPC will set up a 5-gigawatt solar park in Gujarat, as Biggest solar park in India. It will cost approx \$3.5 billion and wll begin operations by 2024.
- 26. Narendra Singh Tomar, Minister for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare launched 2 mobile Apps 'CHC Farm Machinery and Krishi Kisan App for Geo Tagging'.
 - 1. Through CHC Farm Machinery App, farmers can select and order the required machinery at the rates feasible for them from the Custom Hiring Centers located in the radius of 50 Kms.

- 2. Krishi Kisan App will provide farmers the information of best demonstration of high-yielding crops and seeds in their nearby area. Any farmer with high quality of crops can utilise this to demonstrate best practices of cultivation to other farmers.
- 27. National eGovernance Division (Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology) and National Law Institute University (NLIU) Bhopal signed MoU to implement an 'Online Capacity Building Programme on Cyber Law, Crime Investigation and Digital Forensics through NeGD Learning Management System (LMS)'.
- 28. Ponung Doming became first lady officer from Arunachal Pradesh in Indian army to be elevated to rank of Lieutenant colonel.
- 29. Railways Subsidary Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) launched its Initial Public Offer (IPO), with 645 crores value, as largest IPO issued by all subsidiaries of Indian Railways.
 - 1. Investments can be made by 3 October. IRCTC will be listed on NSE and BSE on October 14.
 - 2. Price band is between 315 to 320. Bid size is minimum 40 shares.
 - 3. Government is going to launch 2,01,60,000 shares priced at Rs 10 under offer in the market. After this, Govt stake in IRCTC will come down from 100 % to 87.4 %.
- 30. Railways and Department of Science & Technology partnered with IIT Kanpur for taking up a unique project on 'Industry 4.0' by launching a Pilot Project for implementation at Modern Coach Factory, Raebareli.
 - 1. 'Industry 4.0' commonly referred to as the fourth industrial revolution, is a name given to the current trend of automation, interconnectivity and data exchange in manufacturing technologies to increase productivity.
 - 2. Industry 4.0 is a complex Cyber-Physical Systems which synergizes production with digital technologies, the Internet of Things, Artificial Intelligence, Big Data & Analytics, Machine Learning and Cloud Computing.
- 31. UIDAI announced that Non-resident Indians (NRIs) with valid Indian passport could apply for Aadhaar on arrival, without the need to wait for 182-day period by scheduling a prior appointment.
- 32. Uttar Pradesh Govt. announced annual support of INR 6,000 to the victims of triple talaq till their rehabilitation and they will get free legal aid.
- 33. Vice President M. Venkaiah Naidu suggested several reforms in Supreme court including bifurcation of Supreme Court and setting up of four Regional Benches, Expressing serious concern over delays in justice delivery. He Also suggested evolving Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) that limit number of adjournments and timeframe for disposal of cases by courts.

Science

- 1. According to UN report titled *United in Science for 2019*, average global temperature between 2015-2019 will be the hottest of any five-year period on record. It is estimated to be 1.1 degrees Celsius above pre-industrial (1850-1900) times and 0.2 degrees Celsius warmer than 2011-2015.
 - 1. CO2 grew 2% in 2018 and reached a record high of 37 billion tonnes. Extent of Arctic summer sea ice declined at rate of 12% per decade over past 40 years.
- 2. An unusual object originated outside our solar system has been spotted as 2nd Interstellar visitor to our solar system, named 2I/Borisov by International Astronomical Union's Minor Planet Center. It's anywhere between 1.2 and 10 miles in diameter.
- 3. Geologists from Utrecht University Netherlands discovered a new continent named "Greater Adria" in the mediterranean region under Europe, after successful analysation of mountain ranges from Spain to Iran in detail for 10 years. The discovery is published in 'Gondwana Research'.
 - 1. Greater Adria island is a piece of continental crust in the size of Greenland. It once separated from North Africa and plunged into the Earth's mantle under Southern Europe. Only remaining part of this continent is a strip that runs from Turin, Italy via the Adriatic Sea in the Italian peninsula, hence the name "Greater Adria".
 - 2. Millions of years ago, Earth consisted just one massive chunk of land called Pangea, which fragmented into smaller portions, giving rise to continents as they are now. During this, lost eighth continent Greater Adria slipped underneath what now forms Southern Europe. It took Greater Adria 120 million years to be found by mankind.
- 4. ISRO initiated 'Project NETRA' (NETRA-Network for space object Tracking and Analysis), in-order to detect debris in space and other hazards in Indian satellites which would act as a step for Space Situational Awareness(SSA).
 - 1. NETRA is a network of observational tools which can track objects/debris in range 10cm 3400km. NETRA's goal is to capture geosynchronous equatorial orbit(GEO) at 36,000 km where communication satellites operate.
- 5. NASA launched a miniature satellite (4 cm x 4 cm) called "RamanSat 2" made by a 17-year old New Delhi-based Indian student Aabhaas Sikka. Satellite will measure radiation from sun and space to make space exploration safer for humans and satellites.
- 6. New species of snake called Thackeray's Cat Snake (scientific name Boiga thackeray) named after Tejas Thackeray, younger son of Shiv Sena chief Uddhav Thackeray, has been found in Sahyadri tiger reserve in Koyna area of Satara district in Maharashtra after 125 years.
- 7. Researchers discovered a new mineral named 'Goldschmidt' inside a diamond from a mine- Koffiefontein pipe in South Africa run by De Beers. It is named goldschmidt in honor of Victor Moritz Goldschmidt, the founder of modern geochemistry.
 - 1. It has high concentrations of niobium, potassium and rare earth elements lanthanum and cerium. Mineral was formed about 170 kilometers beneath Earth's surface, at temperatures reaching 1200 C.
