

#### **TRAVEL TIPS**

Traveling is meant to be a sit-back-and-relax, exhilarating, majestic experience. But airports can be nerve-racking, especially when it comes to checking luggage. Here are a few tips to alleviate the apprehension that can come as a result of checking bags at the airport:

- 1. Tag your bag with your name, cell phone number, and home address. Use a strong luggage tag to prevent it from easily falling off.
- 2. Keep a copy of your travel itinerary inside of your suitcase, along with any other important contact information.
- Arrive early for your flight. Some airlines have a cutoff time for checked luggage in order to give airline employees enough time to load each suitcase onto the airplane. If you arrive too late, you could miss the opportunity to check your bags.
- 4. When the luggage tag is printed, double check your name and the airport code to ensure your bag is checked to the correct person and the correct destination. Airline employees are supposed to ID every passenger in order to guarantee each bag travels with its rightful owner. Notify airline personnel immediately if any of the information on your bag tag is incorrect.
- 5. Attach an easily identifiable item on your luggage,
