Transformation Update April 19, 2018

General Information:

New Developments:

Shared Health officially launched operations on April 3, 2018, welcoming former employees of Diagnostic Services Manitoba (DSM) to the new organization and revealing a new logo and website.

Provincial clinical and preventive services planning is underway, with clinical working groups being finalized and Wave One co-leads announced. Wave One membership is listed in the appendix and work will focus on the following specialty areas:

- emergency, critical care and acute medicine co-led by Dr. Alecs Chochinov, Dr. Bojan Paunovic, Dr. Eberhard Renner and Dr. Edward Tan
- primary health and community services co-led by Dr. Jose Francois and Dr. Harsahil Singh; and
- women's health co-led by Dr. Mary-Jean Seager and Dr. Chantal Frechette.

Teams will also be established that cut across the clinical working groups to ensure an integrated and comprehensive approach in areas such as Indigenous health and community health.

Wave One will also support and inform decision-making related to the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority's Phase II Clinical Consolidation.

Project advisory groups are being established as "steering committees" for the following projects within health system transformation:

- Clinical and Preventive Services Planning
- Human Resources Shared Services Planning and Transition
- Supply Chain Management Shared Services Planning and Transition

Membership will include both geographic and professional representation and will be announced in the coming days.

Project streams to kick off in the coming weeks include:

 Provincial Quality and Patient Safety Review – to assess quality, patient safety and accreditation and make recommendations that will lead to greater provincial integration and consistency across all clinical working groups.

Over the coming months, transition work will continue as Shared Health collaborates with other organizations to plan and deliver a more patient-centred and integrated health system. 
Shared Health Organizational Structure and Executive:

The Transformation Management Board has been created to oversee the entire health system transformation process. The board includes: Health Seniors and Active Living Minister Kelvin Goertzen, Health Seniors and Active Living Deputy Minister Karen Herd, Clerk of the Executive Council Fred Meier, Secretary of the Priorities and Planning Committee of Cabinet Jonathan Scarth and Secretary to Treasury Board Paul Beauregard.

This board has now approved the organizational structure and executive for Shared Health. The executive brings together leaders with extensive experience in planning and providing care, as well as in business areas that support the health system, like human resources and facility management. Members have strong links to rural, northern and urban health organizations and share a commitment to – and a passion for – improving how we support the health needs of all Manitobans.
