FAITH FORMATION

Dear Parishioners,

I am happy to share the good news that last Saturday, May 19, Bishop Perez ordained three new priests for service within the Diocese of Cleveland! The Ordination Mass at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist in Cleveland was filled with priest concelebrants, deacons, family members, and enthusiastic guests as the new Fathers Matthew Cortnik, Michael Feldtz, and Richard Samide affirmed their commitment to the Bishop and the people of our Diocese. The Bishop then laid his hands on their heads, in that ancient symbol of consecration, followed by all of the priests in attendance. The newly ordained were then anointed with chrism Oil on the palms of their hands, after being vested for the first time in a stole and chasuble. The bishop then presented them the Paten and Chalice while saying the following words: "Accept from the holy people of God the gifts to be offered to him. Know what you are doing, and imitate the mystery you celebrate: model your life on the mystery of the Lord's cross."



These new priests will be serving at the following parishes: Fr. Cortnik at Communion of Saints in Cleveland Heights; Fr. Feldtz at St. Mary in Berea; and Fr. Samide at St. Mary in Wooster. We pray that these new priests will be blessed in abundance as they begin their ministries in our Diocese.

Please remember also to keep in your prayers our two seminarians: Michael Garvin and James Parisi, as they continue on their formation journey. This summer, Michael will again be working at the Tolle Lege retreat program at Borromeo Seminary. James is undertaking a unique pilgrimage! He will be leaving for Spain soon, and will be walking the entire length of the El Camino de Santiago pilgrimage route from eastern Spain to the Basilica of the Apostle Saint James in Compostela, Spain. The walk takes over a month to complete! Let us keep James in our prayers, as we also request that he remember St. Hilary Parishioners and our intentions in his pilgrimage prayers.

And finally, let us all continue to pray for an increase in vocations to the Priesthood, especially among the young men of our parish community.

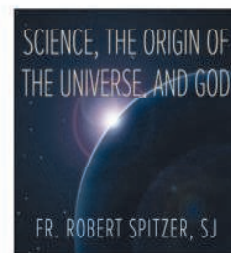

Today we are reminded, once again, how amazing God's love and care for us truly are! The St. Hilary Homeless Ministry

Hearts and Hands Providing Hope for the Homeless | Special Collection on June 2-3!

About ten years ago, the Lord put a desire in the hearts of a handful of like-minded people to help the homeless. With this simple goal in mind, and without really knowing where to begin, we formed a small committee to create the St. Hilary Homeless Ministry.

We began by inviting speakers from the community, and learned a great deal about much of our population's struggles to prevent becoming homeless. We then connected with the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority (AMHA). AMHA began screening individuals in need of rent and utility assistance to prevent them from becoming homeless. Their stories are heart-wrenching. Many are the victims of robbery, illness, and job-loss. Our \$300-400 one-time assistance to these individuals helps them maintain their housing and their dignity.

In order to fund this ministry, we have sold raffle tickets annually to generate the money needed to assist these individuals. Each year, we help over 50 individuals with rent or utilities so they are able to stay in their homes. We have had a 98% success rate in accomplishing this mission.

After ten years, the need to assist individuals in the community has grown. We have determined that we should explore other methods of raising funds to sustain the Homeless Ministry. We have been provided an opportunity to have a special collection to raise funds in lieu of our annual raffle. The special collection for the St. Hilary Homeless Ministry will be the weekend of June 2 & 3. If you contribute through online giving, there is the ability to donate to this collection through Faith Direct. We ask for your generosity in supporting the St. Hilary Homeless Ministry through this special collection so that we can continue to serve those in need.
