

HAZYVIEW

Experience the thrill of Mpumalanga's longest Aerial Cable Trail!

Enjoy the freedom of gliding over one of the last remaining natural forested valleys along the Sabie River. The aerial cable trail takes you down into the valley basin, stopping along the way on a number of elevated platforms to admire the natural vegetation, bird life and the views of the forest floor below.

Each section of the trail varies in length from 70 to 230 meters linking a total of 10 platforms, making the total length of the trail 1.2km. The trail has been designed and built to South African civil engineering standards and all the equipment has been designed specifically for this activity and tried and tested worldwide. All groups are escorted by qualified guides.

This is a non-strenuous adventure activity, suitable for the whole family and people of all ages. Children under the age of 10 may need to be assisted.

Pilgrim's Rest is a living museum - the entire town was declared a national Monument - taking the visitors to the day of the old Transvaal Gold Rush.

Pilgrim's Rest was declared a gold field in 1873, soon after digger Alec "Wheelbarrow" Patterson had found gold deposits in Pilgrim's Creek. The Valley proved to be rich in gold and by the end of the year, there where about 1,500 diggers working in the area.

GRASKOP

Enchant your family with an unforgettable journey into the heart of a pristine indigenous forest. The Graskop Gorge Lift is the latest and most innovative tourism development in South Africa and the only one of it's kind in the Southern Hemisphere.

Your journey begins as you drop off the grassy cliff top in a custom-designed 26-passenger viewing elevator. It travels 51m down the cliff face into the cool mountain forest below. An extensive network of elevated walkways, suspension bridges and interactive exhibits lead you along the 500m forest trails and across the streams. The site's towering cliffs have been cut back over time by the Motitsi River, with the Panorama Gorge waterfall which plummets 70m into the gorge below.

HOEDSPRUIT

A trip with a view !

Experience the magic of lighter-than-air flight near the foot of the Drakensberg Escarpment during a one-hour long flight over the scenic, Lowveld section of the Blyde River, 15 km West of Hoedspruit.

The terrain is a mixture of farmland, private nature reserves and wildlife estates. The mountains to the South and West provide shelter from the prevailing winds, thereby affording good flying weather on most days.

As the sun rises, the landscape, the vegetation and, if you're lucky, some wildlife will provide photo opportunities. Game spotting cannot be guaranteed, but on most flights we see plains game like giraffe and wildebeest.

It is a fun, healthy and technical exercise involving strategy, stealth and quick thinking. The Paint Ball Course has natural obstacles like trees, a river, and also man made obstacle like a fort, trenches and a barbed wire border gate. It also has a spectator area that is fenced off with see-through netlon so spectators can be part of the action.

Protective clothing (overalls), masks, guns, and bullets supplied. A marshal will facilitate the game and also what type of game will be played. Minimum of four people per game.

For small children there is a paint ball target shooting range.

Facts about Paint-ball

The game of paint-ball was first played in 1981. The idea for the game was conceived, after 3 Americans saw an advertisement for a paint gun, used to blast paint pellets at cattle for marking purposes.

The paint, used for the paint balls, is soluble in water, so that it washes easily out of players' clothes. It is non-toxic as well, in case a player is hit in the mouth and accidentally swallows the paint. The basic materials for the paint are mineral oils, food colouring, calcium, ethylene glycol, and iodine.

The paint is encapsulated in a bubble sphere made from gelatin.
