OUOTE OF THE MONTH: Nothing could persuade me to read every line of this monstrous mish-mash of claptrap interspersed with puddles of pious platitudes, but I have perused it carefully enough to get the drift of its wild science-fiction themes. -Martin Gardner

The above quote is taken from

the winter 1990 issue of the Skeptical Inquirer, CSICOPs voice to the public. He is writing about The Urantia Book, a spiritual volume whose teachings are followed by many thousands of followers. The article is a

perfect example of the Donald Michael Kraig the minds of the readers. "Gardnerian School of Skepticism"-don't present any evidence or proof, just criticize, mock and ridicule.

Gardner has two major claims to fame. The first is that for many years he edited the delightful puzzles that appear in Scientific American. The second is that he is a debunker.



But note that in many cases his debunking is based on not one iota of scientific evidence. Gardner gives some very brief accounts of what he perused (he admits that he didn't even bother to read what he is trying to debunk). Because the ideas in the book are not accepted by most people, and because they are taken completely out of context,

he is able to hold them up to ridicule. He implies that because it sounds silly it must be silly.

But this isn't skepticism. It's not even debunking. It's just an attempt to manipulate

Look at the emotion-laden words he uses: "monstrous mishmash of claptrap"; "puddles of pious platitudes"; "wild sciencefiction themes." These are not the expressions of a scientist refuting the works of another thinker. There is no logical argument showing that the previous writer was wrong. This is not science at



all. In fact, he sounds more like someone trying to preach his own gospel rather than a scientific thinker.

By the way, it strikes me that the quote at the beginning of this column could have been written by Gardner about Einstein's theory of relativity.

SO WHAT?

But Martin Gardner is just one person. So what if his polemics are based more on emotion than fact, opinion rather than research? The answer is two-fold.

First, his style of debunking has led others to the same antiscientific path. In the same issue of *Skeptical Inquirer*, Philip J. Klass criticizes a document because the signature on it is "suspiciously" like that of a known version of the signature. In other words, it's suspicious because the signatures are alike. Of course, it would also be suspicious if they weren't alike. The document may be a fake, but you cannot win against ilogical thought.

Second, his association with Scientific American gives him an appearance of more authority than he warrants. This may result in young people, who want to be scientists, following his type of reasoning. Then, merely because something sounds unusual, such as the theory of relativity, it could be ignored. The results could set

us back scientifically. We do not need another Dark Age.

DON'T IGNORE US, CSICOP!

In that same issue of Skeptical Inquirer there is a long article by Robert E. Bartholomew on "The Airship Hysteria of 1896-97." Bartholomew cites numerous sources and finally comes to the conclusion that the "Airships were seen as a positive influence in reaction to the negative strains brought about by rapid technological advancements in a variety of fields." It is a shame that with all of Bartholomew's expertise and research that he didn't do any original work or bother to check Jerome Clark's UFO Reporter column in the February 1990 issue of FATE. There he would have learned that the whole thing was a practical joke created by a newspaper editor and a liar's club in the days when newspapers didn't have to be as truthful as they are today.

Did FATE merely "scoop" the Skeptical Inquirer? Or is the Skeptical Inquirer, as the printed representation of the point of view of CSICOP, merely presenting dogma to its readers rather than honest research and truth? We will certainly find out when and if—the Skeptical Inquirer ever bothers to tell its readers the truth about the Airships of 1896-1897.

ASTROLOGY AND THE STOCK MARKET

According to Newsweek, astrology is making a strong comeback today. Part of this is due to Nancy Reagan's interest, but part is due to a simple fact: astrology (or at least some aspects of astrology) works.

Arch Crawford is an astrologer who gives advice on Wall Street investments. Back in 1987 he warned about a "horrendous crash" that would occur after the market reached a high point. The 2000-member organization monitors the media to make sure that false statements about astrology are not claimed as fact. They also watch out for bad astrologers who make promises (such as instant wealth) that cannot be fulfilled.

NEWS ITEMS

 Swiss genetic engineers have created a protein that is technically known as a monoclonal antibody. It is named IN-1. This new discovery has allowed severed spinal-cord nerves in rats to grow 11 millimeters. In rats with untreated spinal injuries, nerve growth is only one millimeter.

Although actual use for humans is years away, this is one of the first discoveries that gives hope to people who have nerve damage from accidents and strokes, as well as from diseases such as Alzheimer's, Parkinson's and Lou Gehrig's disease.

rain, wind, and salt crystals that have seeped up through the limestone of the Sphinx from the increasingly salty water table level of the Nile valley.

This explanation is simple enough. But an American named Larry Hunter produced a videotape of Ahmed el-Shaer, a Sphinx guard, who claimed that he saw antiquities officials hammering at the Sphinx in the area where the stones fell just before the incident. HAUNTED BRITAIN

Great Britain has traditionally been the home of many ghosts and poltergeists, as well as some of the greatest ghost hunters. I feel safe in saying that there isn't a section of England, Scotland, Wales or Ireland that doesn't have more than its fair share of indigenous spirits—some play-

ful, öthers malevolent. The following are some accounts of British poltergeists, ghosts and related entities; several are quite recent and others are ancient in origin, but continue to manifest themselves in unexpected ways.

PUB POLTERGEIST?

Many British pubs have histories of hauntings, and even the ultimate rationalist cannot deny the existence of spirits in pubs! I have had the good fortune to be able to visit a number of these haunted pubs, and in the future I hope to launch investigations in several of them. In a most interesting pollergeist case that occurred this past October, Gloria Flemings, a barmaid from the British West Midlands, is trying to get compensation from the brewery that owns the Old Priory Pub in Dudley where she works. The reason: she says that she was hit in the face by a glass

thrown by one of the ghostly entities inhaliting the pub. Mrs. Flemings, 40, was working behind the bar when she was cut on the cheek and nose when a whiskey glass flew off a shelf in the pub.

"I was talking to a cus-

tomer when this glass suddenly came off the shelf above the bar and struck me," Mrs. Flemings told the (Bristol) *Courier-Mail* (10/7/89). "I don't know if I believe in ghosts, but I can't explain it."

The pub has a history of hauntings, and many strange things have happened within its

walls. Music and lights have been turned on during the night, and lampshades have shattered without apparent explanation. In addition to Mrs. Flemings' close encounter with a ghost-tossed flying glass, three other barmaids have narrowly escaped injury from flying glasses.

According to the Daily Post, (10/6/89), pub licensee Bob Darby insisted that Gloria Flemings submit a compensation claim to brewery Holt, Plant, and Deakin. The managing director of the brewery, Graham Page, told the Daily Post: "I would imagine Mrs. Flemings would be covered by insurance. There certainly have been some strange goingson. It is very worrying."

Rev. Michael Goss (Vicar of St. Thomas's Church, Dudley) was called in to investigate the haunting. Goss was quoted as saying: "I have spoken to all concerned. They are all very down-to-earth, rational people. I am totally puzzled. If there are ghostly goingson, it would seem there might be a poltergeist." We expect to hear more on this case in the near future.

HAUNTED BRITISH COMPUTERS


Another case that I hope to check out is that of the so-called "Haunted Computer." This case broke when I was in London in the summer of 1988, and it was hardly publicized in the United States.

In Stockport, Cheshire, England, an Amstrad PC 1512 computer was allegedly doing very strange things, and the staff of the architectural firm that owned it was getting spooked. I met with veteran British psychic investigator Manfred Cassirer who was looking into the case and he described some of the "haunted computer's" strange ways. The computer supposedly made unusual sounds-including groans and cackles-and the screen would light up and display strange letters even when unplugged.

lanet Bord, in her "Strange News From Britain" column, in Strange Magazine #3 (1988, p. 25) reported on further developments in this bizarre case. She writes that experts from Personal Computer magazine were brought in to examine the computer and that they monitored it 24 hours a day for three months. Personal Computer editor Ken Hughes was quoted as saying, "One night there was a loud cracking noise. the power light came on and the screen lit up. Another night, random letters started flashing on the screen. I would not have believed it if I had not seen it myself. I am baffled."

I have been told that the computer has been completely dis-





mantled and inspected, but that there was no clue as to the cause of the strange phenomena surrounding it. One consideration is that Amstrad received a great deal of publicity from the case in the UK, and a large computer conference was being held at the same time that this story appeared in the press. I believe that Manfred Cassirer also noted this at the time

I am indebted to Janet Bord for a second report of a haunted British computer (also in Cheshire). In this strange case, teacher Ken Webster and his girlfriend claim to have received communications via computer from one Tomas Harden, "Harden" claimed to have lived in the 16th century in the cottage that Webster and his friend were occupying. Webster says that they were able to converse with Harden using the computer. Janet Bord has written that this case is unlikely to be a hoax for various reasons and that due to the many questions it poses, this case-if genuine-may be "one of the most important paranormal events of recent years." A book by Webster on the case may be forthcoming in the UK. If this case turns out to be as significant as Janet Bord thinks it may be, a number of readers may want to put their ouija boards in the attic and fire up their personal computers! Perhaps the publication of

THE SPOOKY SKULLS OF BRITAIN

There are at least ten "haunted" skulls being preserved in houses and various buildings in England. It is thought that if one of these skulls is removed, screaming or rattling noises will commence and will continue until the skull is brought back to the building and placed in its usual spot. There is much folklore surrounding the "screaming skulls" and, as usual, sifting the fact from fiction is tricky at best.

One place in England where several haunted skulls are available for viewing by the public is Turton Tower in Turton (near Bolton, Lancashire). The skulls are displayed on a Bible in the Tower's Chetham room. The skulls were originally kept at Timberbottom Earth Farm, in nearby Bolton. One of the Turton Tower skulls is nearly complete, the other is just a fragment. The skulls are said to have belonged to two robbers who broke into Timberbottom Farm.

According to Peter G.E. Laws' A Guide to Turton Tower (1983), in 1939 the skulls were taken away from their haunt so that they could be mounted in silver. As soon as the skulls were removed continued on page 26

Steve Jones, in his excellent listing entitled "Haunted Skulls of Eng-land," (Earth #14, June, 1989) states that one of the skulls is in fact female. and that both skulls are probably prehistoric. Jones also notes that Turton Tower has at least five different ghosts lurking about the place, including a haunted cradle and a phantom coach and horses. FATE readers visiting the Lancashire area may well want to tour this seemingly spook-ridden spot, which is open to the public.

The haunted skull residing in Burton Agnes Hall, in Humberside, is that of the ill-fated Anne Griffith. Her father. Sir Henry Griffith, who began building the Hall in the 1600s, died before the work was finished. His three daughters, spearheaded by Anne, continued the project that their father held so dear. Soon after the construction was completed, Anne was attacked by robbers and critically injured. She was brought to Burton Agnes Hall, where she succumbed to her injuries several days later. Before dying, Anne Griffith requested that her skull be kept at Burton Agnes Hall for posterity to preserve the house.

Anne's wish was not carried out, however, and soon strange things began to happen in the

ON THE PSYCHIC FRONTIER

SPONTANEOUS CONTACT

The existence of spontaneous "post-mortem contact" experiences is conspicuous in the study of bereavement. People suffering significant personal losses often experience the "return" of the deceased spouse or relative. The conventional explanation for this phenomenon is that they are psy-

chological episodes in which the grieving person tries to reunite with the deceased.

Some bereavement counselors don't share that explanation with their colleagues, and think that these experiences could represent

genuine contacts with the dead. Carol Staudacher writes in her excellent book *Beyond Grief—a* guida for recovering from the death of a loved one (Oakland, CA: New Harbinger, 1987) that "some researchers think the presence is the product of sensory recall; others consider the vision to be the actual visit of the person's spirit.

The explanation of *why* these experiences occur is less important than the fact that they are very real to the people who experience them."

Ms. Staudacher—a grief counselor in Santa Cruz, California cites a case where a client saw the ghost of her deceased husband. Her mother simultaneously saw

the figure. The mother's description of the ghost's apparel matched the description given by the daughter!

J. William Worden agrees. In Grief Counseling and Grief Therapy (New York, Springer 1986), Dr. Worden places

bereavement hallucinations under the cognitive side effects of grief—which include disbelief, preoccupation with the deceased, psychological confusion and so forth. But he does say that "with all the recent interest in mysticism and spirituality, it is interesting to speculate on whether these are really hallucinations or possibly some other kind of metaphysical phenomenon."

WIDOWS SEE GHOSTS

In Omega—the journal of dath and dying, Sherry Simon-Buller, Dr. Victor A. Christopherson and Dr. Randall A. Jones report on a project at the University of Arizona, Tucson. The title of the paper is "Correlates of sensing the presence of a deceased spouse."

The researchers wanted to determine if widows who received post-mortem "visitations" from their late husbands differed psychologically from other bereaved women. In order to implement their study, they contacted 294 widows by mail. Each participant was asked simply, "Do you ever sense the presence of your deceased spouse?" Each respondent then filled out a form which covered her health status, financial situation, support network, mental health, drinking behavior and several other possible variables. It is difficult to determine the specific percentage of widows who reported post-mortem contact, but it seems to be over 50 per cent. The focus of the paper is on the differences between the "experiencers" and the other widows. These differences break down into five categories:

1. Widows of more liberal reli-

gious orientations were more prone to experience their spouses' postmortem returns.

2. Those who received visitations from their late partners reported being more "worried" than the non-experiencers.

3. The "experiencers" reported more support and contact with neighbors.

4. The more financially secure widows were more prone to the contacts.

5. Those receiving spousal returns claimed having more problems dealing with their bereavements than the non-experiencers.

The fact that the recipients of the post-mortem contacts reported significant problems dealing with their grief could indicate that these experiences were simply hallucinations. Perhaps these bereaved widows "created" such visitations to rescue them from their despair.

I'm sure that most psychologists and psychiatrists will favor this explanation, but I don't think that it is the only interpretation of these findings. If survival is a fact, isn't it possible that a bereaved person's distress could "call back" a person from death's infinite boundary? (Spiritualists believe that the recently deceased are particularly sensitive to the thoughts of the living. Some spirits, communicating through a medium, speak of being prevented from evolving in the spirit world by the grief of their surviving relatives.)

There are other problems in this report. The reader gets no insight into the phenomenology of post-mortem contacts. No case studies or examples are given. Did most of the reporters simply "feel" the invisible presence of the deceased, or did they see, talk to or otherwise interact with the presences? The University of Arizona researchers failed to discriminate between those people who could be suffering easily explainable hallucinations from respondents possibly reporting genuine psychic experiences. This is a possibility the researchers never considered at all.

ONE HUNDRED CASES

A better study was published in the subsequent edition of Omega. Written by Dr. Erlendur Haraldsson of Iceland, "Survey of claimed encounters with the dead" is the result of a countrywide study of psychic experiences. Dr. Haraldsson and two senior psychology students at the University of Iceland interviewed 127 people (originally contacted by mail), yielding 100 usable cases.

The largest number (46 per cent) of cases in the study were visual sightings of the dead.

Perceiving the voice of the deceased ranked second (24 per cent), followed by people who reported olfactory perceptions linked to the deceased person, tactile sensations or merely feeling the "presence" of a dead friend or relative.

The study's most interesting finding is that these perceptions/ experiences did not seem linked to grief. Dr Haraldsson reports that only a relatively few participants in his study were working through bereavement when their encounters took place.

Also conspicuous in the report was the mode of the deceased person's death. Nearly one fourth of them died violently through suicide, murder or physical mishap. These findings conform to a fairly consistent pattern: that the planning of the encounter was orchestrated by the *deceased* person and not by the living witness.

This becomes more apparent the closer we look into the cases. Dr. Haraldsson reports that in 43 of the cases a second person was present when the encounter took place In a third of these cases, the second person shared in the experience. In some reports, the living person saw or interacted with a friend or relative who had only recently died—a fact which was unknown to the witness when the visitation took place.

ON THE PSYCHIC FRONTIER

Dr. Haraldsson closed his paper by briefly discussing the relationship of his findings to the study of bereavement hallucinations. "Recent research has indicated that grief, ethnicity and sex can be contributing factors in the occurrence of these experiences.. Our survey shows that grief explains personal encounters with the deceased only to a small extent in the normal population. These experiences can apparently occur to a considerable portion of the normal population and under a variety of conditions...these findings, weak as they are, may permit us to ask if some, or any, of these experiences may possibly be something more than 'just hallucinations'."

GHIROR-THE TENTH PLANET By Michael R. Watson

A new planet was discovered in 1977 and is little known to this day.

Considered at the time of its discovery to be a minor planet or asteroid, and reported in the nonscientific press as a new planet, Chiron, which is usually orbiting between Uranus and Saturn, has been puzzling astronomers lately.

Since early in 1988 Chiron has been getting brighter. It is now at least two and a half times brighter than expected, even allowing for the fact that its orbit is bringing it nearer to the Earth.

Some astronomers are now suggesting that Chiron is not an asteroid at all, but a comet, and that its brightening is like that of a comet approaching the Sun. Unfortunately for this explanation, no cloud of gas and dust, known as the *coma*, can be seen around Chiron. Such a cloud is expected of most comets, particularly those undergoing marked brightenine, as Chiron has. Spectroscopes have been trained on Chiron, but they have revealed none of the gases that comets normally release.

A rare opportunity to judge Chiron's size-which is not accurately known, and is given as anywhere from 120 to several hundred miles in diamater-occurred in February 1989 when Chiron passed in front of a dim star in the constellation of Orion. By measuring the length of time the star was obscured by Chrion, and calculating for its velocity through space and its distance from Earth, a meaningful diameter can be determined, within a certain range of miles. Astronomers are now awaiting the announcement of the results of these measurements.

Whatever Chiron finally proves to be, perhaps even something strange and new, it seems clear that it can no longer be thought of as a dead and dull rock.

A small, single-engine plane flies into a tiny cloud above an airport and, in front of many witnesses, never reappears.

One celebrated report of this type tells how 800 soldiers in World War I marched into a lowhanging cloud on a battlefield. They all vanished forever!

WHERE IS EVERYBODY GOING?

Human beings, animals and all kinds of objects have been traveling through time and space involuntarily since the beginning of time. The extensive records of religion, occultism and psychic phenomena are filled with such accounts. You don't have to visit the Bermuda Triangle in the Atlantic or the notorious Devil's Sea off the coast of Japan to be caught up in one of these "vile vortices," as the late Ivan Sanderson dubbed them.

Drivers have reported seeing other cars vanish on busy highways. Other drivers have claimed that they traveled impossible distances in a very short time. The UFO lore is loaded with tales of people and automobiles finding some shortcut in our threedimensional world. As Charles Fort pointed out in the 1920s, teleportation is an actual fact of nature.

> It is not a rare occurrence. It happens all the time.

There was once a private museum in California that displayed nothing but objects that had supposedly been teleported.

The key issue stemming from these events is simple enough: What makes these things happen?

HOT ROCKS FROM COLD SKIES

Every year somewhere on this planet stones begin to drop from the sky. They usually pelt some random house, pounding down on the roof continuously for several days. Local police and newspaper reporters invariably gather to witness this curiosity and create ridiculous theories to explain it. The people who live in the troubled house often move away.

The stones, usually pebbles and small rocks, come out of a clear sky, often seeming to move in slow motion. They are frequently warm, even hot to the touch. Police officials try to blame "teenagers," and they search the area for mischievous youngsters who, they think, are hiding in the bushes, heating stones over some kind of fire, and shooting them at the house with slingshots. Instead of tiring quickly of the game, as teenagers are wont to do, the police theorize that the kids keep up the silly barrage all day and all night for several days-in some cases, several weeks.

Collectors of "Forteana" know that cases of these rainstorms of rocks have taken place on every continent. This year it could happen in a village in Africa or a town in South America. There are even documented cases in which the stones have chosen to pound away at tents on the Sahara Desert. The police reaction is always the same—it must be those damed teenagers.

al once visited a house in Calcutta, India, where the stones were dropping from the ceiling inside the house. The owner had to take a shovel and shovel out his living room every morning! The stones seemed to materialize suddenly an inch or two below the ceiling and then drop slowly. If you placed a plate under the dropping stone, the rock would somehow curve and miss the plate. Some parapsychologists view this as a form of poltergeist phenomena and it is often discussed in books about poltergeists.

We don't know where the disappearing people go, and we certainly don't know where the appearing rocks come from. Is there a gravel pit in some hypothetical alternate dimension where all the gravel is slowly filtering through some aberrant black hole and raining down on us?

IT'S NOT LIKE "THE FLY"

There are very few clues in these teleportation cases which might lead us to a solution. We do know that teleported objects are transferred instantly, probably outside our own time frame. Science fiction stories like "The Fly" try to explain teleportation as a kind of radio process. They speculate that the person or object is broken down atomically into energy. This energy is then radioed to a distant point where it is reconstructed into physical matter.

But the innumerable cases that occur in nature every year make such theories unlikely. The whole object or being is transferred instantly. There seems to be a warp of time and space involved.

It may be connected with the earth's magnetic field. The mysterious fog that accompanies so many of these manifestations is clearly a by-product of the force or forces involved. The fog may indicate that there is a sudden drop of temperature in the area of the teleportation. This temperature drop may be the natural effect of a mass of magnetic or electrical energy that is creating a "hole" in our reality or dimension. The warming of the stones is a reversal of this effect.

Another clue is the fact that teleportation incidents seem to

increase during periods of high sun spot activity. We know that sun spots interfere with the earth's magnetic field and stimulate unusual events such as UFO sightings, so it is possible that teleportation is also a part of the same matrix.

When you realize how widespread the teleportation phenomenon is, it is remarkable that so few people are really involved in investigating it. Certainly the number of people chasing sea serpents and other intangibles far outweighs the handful who are studying teleportation. But there are a few, including the Temporal Anomaly Research Association, P.O. Box 20173R, Keizer, Oregon 97307-0173.

We should all take a greater interest. After all, you never know when a mysterious fog might gather on your front lawn and you will feel a strange, tingling sensation...

Kip S. Thorne and Ulvi Yurtsever of Cal Tech and Michael S. Morris of the University of Wisconsin believe that time travel is possible according to two of Einstein's theories. They wrote in *Physical Review Letters*, "if the laws of physics permit an advanced civilization to create and maintain a 'wormhole' in space for interstellar travel, then that wormhole can be converted into a time machine."

The first of Einstein's principles incorporated into the time travel theory is that time is relative. This was verified when scientists took two accurate clocks, synchronized them, and put one on a jet and flew it at high speed for several hours. When compared, the clock that had been on the jet was slower than the one that had stayed on the ground.

The second principle is the

warping of space by gravity. An example of this is that of a worm on the surface of an apple. If the worm uses a hole and goes through the apple, the distance to the far side would be less than if it had traveled around the circumference. Likewise, if a space traveler could go through a place in space which gravity has warped into a "wormhole," the distance to the destination would be greatly shortened.

The new theory states it would be possible to turn such a wormhole into a time machine by accelerating one end of the wormhole to a speed nearly that of the speed of light while keeping the other end stationary. By entering the stationary end it is believed that on coming out of the other end, a person would have traveled backwards in time.



SPYING ON THE KOOKS Part Three

THE NEXT VICTIM

In the fall of 1982, Linda Moulton Howe, a Denver television producer who was best known for her program on the alleged link between UFOs and cattle mutilations, was asked by Home Box Office to do a special

to be titled UFOs¹—The ET Factor. Howe knew of Paul Bennewitz's claims, though she did not know that he was on the receiving end of a counterintelligence operation by AFOSI at Kirtland Air Force Base. Howe, in fact, was inclined to accept

Bennewitz's lurid ideas about cattle- and human-mutilating ETs and the U.S. government's complicity in these activities (according to Bennewitz, such activities were permitted in exchange for extraterrestrial technological secrets).

In January 1983, Peter Gersten, a New York attorney active in legal suits intended to pry classified UFO material from government agencies, met Richard Doty who told him that UFOs are from other planets, that three of them had crashed, and that the National Security Agency is in contact with extraterrestrials. under the rubric of Project Aquarius. Top-secret documents attest to an agreement in which ETs are permitted to mutilate animals and to land at a certain base. Doty said that popular entertainment is being used as a vehicle to prepare the American public for an eventual announcement that ETs are visiting the Earth.

When Howe visited New York in March 1983 to sign the HBO contract, she had dinner with Gersten, who repeated what he had heard from Doty. He said he would ask Doty if Howe could interview him. In early April she met with Doty in Albuquerque.

Doty handed How a document titled "A Briefing Paper for the President of the United States on the Subject of Unidentified Flying Vehicles" that listed dates and locations of crashes and retrievals of UFOs and their humanoid occupants. Included was <u>a crash at Aztec</u>, New Mexico, in 1948—a story well known to ufologists and believed to be <u>a certain hoax</u>. The document asserted that such beings, travelers from a nearby solar system, had used their genetic knowledge to direct the course of human evolution. On several occasions live aliens (called "extraterrestrial biological entities," or EBEs) had been kept in the custody of government agencies. A number of projects, including Aquarius, Sigma and Garnet, as well as a policy-making group called "Majority-12," dealt with various aspects of the visitation.

Howe was to be given thousands of feet of film on crashed discs, bodies, etc. "We want you to do this film," Doty told her, "we" being a group of cover-up insiders who wanted the truth to be told to the American people.

Over the course of a number of phone conversations in the weeks that followed, Howe was even promised an interview with an alien. Then Doty, after making other promises he did not fulfill. announced he was officially out of the project. Others would be in touch with her, he said. She did receive some phone calls from other individuals allegedly representing government agencies, but she was never able to contact them. In time those calls stopped, too. Howe lost her contract with HBO.

DENIALS BY DOTY

In March 1988, in a letter to ufologist Larry W. Bryant, Doty denied that he had ever discussed UFO secrets and made promises about film footage to Howe. Howe responded by producing a sworn statement and copies of her correspondence from the period with both Doty and HBO. In 1989, Moore said that "in early 1983 I became aware that Rick [Doty] was involved with a team of several others...in playing an elaborate disinformation scheme against a prominent UFO researcher [Howe]." The episode was a counterintelligence sting operation, part of the "wall of disinformation" intended to "confuse" the Bennewitz issue and to "call his credibility into question."

Knowing of Howe's interest in Bennewitz's work, Moore said, "certain elements within the intelligence community were concerned that the story of his having intercepted low frequency electromagnetic emissions from the Coyote Canyon area of the Kirtland/Sandia complex would end up as part of a feature film. Since this in turn might influence others (possibly even the Russians) to attempt similar experiments, someone in a control position apparently felt it had to be stopped before it got out of hand." From what he could see, Moore related, "the government seemed hell bent on severing the ties that existed between [Howe] and [HBO]."

Doty was not telling the truth when he disputed Howe's version of their meeting. Bound by a security oath, Doty could not speak freely. Moore said that the alleged Aztec crash was something Doty had added to the document Howe saw after Moore had described to him his investigation of the hoax.

MJ-12

In December 1984, Moore's associate Jaime Shandera received a roll of 35mm film which. turned out to contain a purported briefing paper prepared by the first head of the CIA for President-elect Eisenhower. The paper claimed that an "Operation Majestic-12," consisting of a dozen top scientists, military officers and intelligence specialists, had been set up by Presidential order to study the remains of a UFO which crashed in New Mexico and the bodies of its four humanoid occupants.

Moore and Shandera's sources (they called them "birds" because they had given each an avian name: Condor, Falcon, Hawk etc.) directed them to go to the National Archives, where they found, in recently-declassified top-secret Air Force Intelligence files, a brief memo that refers to a meeting of the "MJ-12/SSP [Special Studies Project]." Although it does not say what

"MJ-12" is, it seems to confirm that a group by that name does exist. Still, its authenticity would be called into question when it was released.

The controversy over the MJ-12 document and the Cutler/ Twining memo has raged ever since. By 1990, grave doubts had been raised about the authenticity of the former. <u>Critics have</u> found that President Truman's signature on an alleged executive

WAS THE "FALCON" RICHARD C. DOTY?

On March 1, 1989, an Albuquerque ufologist, Robert Hastings, issued a 13-page statement, with 37 pages of appended documents, full of serious charges against Moore and his sources:

"First, it has been established that 'Falcon,' one of the principle [sic] sources of the MJ-12 material, is Richard C. Doty...How do I

order bringing MJ-12 into being is exactly like that on an another letter. Apparently a forger appended a real signature to a fake letter. It appears

the MJ-12 document is just another addition to the disinformation paper flow.

UFO COVER-UP

In October 1988, two of Moore and Shandera's sources, "Falcon" and "Condor," appeared on a national television show titled <u>UFO Cover-up?—Live</u>. They produced no supporting evidence and made two assertions that viewers found hilarious: that the EBEs prefer ancient Tibetan music and that they have a taste for strawberry ice cream. In his 1989 Las Vegas speech, Moore conceded that at least some of what Falcon and Condor said was "disinformation."

...the EBEs prefer ancient Tibetan music and...they have a taste for strawberry ice cream.

> know that Doty is 'Falcon?' During a recent telephone conversation, Linda Moulton Howe told me that when Sgt. Doty invited her to his office at Kirtland AFB in early April 1983, and showed her a purportedly authentic U.S. Government document on UFOs, he identified himself as code-name 'Falcon' and stated it was Bill Moore who had given him that name.

> "Also, in early December 1988, a ranking member of the production team responsible for the 'UFO Cover-up?—Live' television documentary confirmed that Doty is 'Falcon.' The same indi

vidual also identified the second MJ-12 source who appeared on the program, 'Condor,' as Robert Collins who was, until recently, a Captain in the U.S. Air Force. Like Doty, he was stationed at KAFB when he left the service late last year."

Hastings' revelations, made before Moore's speech the following July, anticipated some of Moore's admissions, such as that Doty was involved with the manufacture of the Weitzel and Ellsworth documents. Hastings also noted major discrepancies between the "Majority-12" paper Howe saw and the "Majestic-12" briefing document. For instance, the former mentioned the alleged Aztec crash; the second said nothing about it. Hastings wrote, "[I]f the briefing paper that Sgt. Doty showed to Linda Howe was genuine, what does that say about the accuracy (and authenticity) of the Eisenhower document? If, on the other hand, the former was bogus and was meant to mislead Howe for some reason, what does that say about Richard 'Falcon' Doty's reliability as a source for MJ-12 material as a whole?" Hastings also criticized some of Moore's actions.

Moore and Doty emphatically denied that the latter was Falcon. Howe stood by her story.

AND THE SOURCE FOR BIZARRE UFO CLAIMS IS ...

Even wilder stories began to be told at the fringes of ufology. John Lear, Bill Cooper, Bill English and John Grace ("Val Valarian") elaborated on the already large body of flyingsaucer folklore and disinformation by linking them with wild conspiracy theories favored by the political far right.

As Moore himself acknowledges, all this began as an effort to disinform a single deluded man who stumbled on to a sensitive secret at Kirtland Air Force Base (which may or may not have had anything to do with UFOs). It ended in the virtual sabotage of much of the ufology of the 1980s.

Moore remains convinced that there is at least a small amount of truth in the stories he has been told. Although hundreds of questions remain, nobody in a position to know seems willing to answer in a way that would assure us we are hearing the truth. Doty refuses to talk with any ufologist but Moore. Robert Collins, with whom I have spoken on a number of occasions, denies he is Condor, but he certainly talks like Condor-that is, like a man whose stories are as fascinating as his evidence is nonexistent.

COCRLIN THE PROPHET

erlin: poet, druid, king, teacher, wizard, counselor—his name evokes many images and his story holds a lascination that has, if anything, grown during the 14 centuries that have passed since his death. Of all of the manifold talents said to have been possessed by this remarkable man, Merlin's prophetic ability stands out. Merlin had excellent success as a prophet and there is evidence that he may have acted in this capacity for four or more Kings and Princes of Britain. As a boy he prophesied for Vortigern, then Ambrosius Aurelianus and Uther Pendragon. He may have been Arthur's prophet, but there is actually little strong corroborating evidence to this effect. Rhydderch Hael of Strathclyde and possibly Prince Meldred, Rhydderch's enemy, also had occasion to avail themselves of Merlin's services as a prophet.

Hundreds of years later, some critics would complain that most of his prophecies were too ambiguous to have much meaning, but Merlin's first known predictions were very straightforward.

As a boy, Merlin told King Vortigern that "tomorrow, Emrys (Ambrosius) and Uthyr, the sons of Constantine, will land at Totness—will, with one mind, persecute thee—for they will come with twelve thousand warriors and recover their rights from the Saxons—make the cheeks of the Saxons red with Saxon blood."

History records that Vortigern left the area quickly. History also tells us that Uthyr (Uther) and Emrys (Ambrosius) did indeed land at Totness and defeat the Saxons. Each became king of Britain and were destined to be inextricably linked with Merlin.

A SEER RENOWNED

In his "The Prophecy of Britain," ("Arymes Prydein Vawr") the early British poet Golyddan alludes to Merlin's prediction that the Britons would recover their country again. With its 7th-8th century dating, this prophetic work establishes Merlin's fame as a seer centuries before Geoffrey of Monmouth supposedly "created" him, as claimed by the Merlin debunkers.

 It was, in fact, Merlin's great fame as a prophet that caused Geoffrey to include Merlin's prophecies in his seminal work c. 1136 The History of the Kings of Britain (Historia Regum Britanniae). Geoffrey said that he had started writing The History of the Kings of Britain when "the prevalence of rumours about Merlin" led Alexander, Bishop of Lincoln, to whom the Historia is dedicated. to ask Geoffrey to translate Merlin's British prophecies into Latin. This is further evidence that the Merlin debunkers like A. O. H. Jarman are wrong about their contention that Geoffrey "created" Merlin out of a combination of whole cloth and scraps of lore.2

() The seventh book of the History of the Kings of Britain contains the "Prophecies of Merlin" comprising well over 100 separate prophecies, many reminiscent in tone to those attributed to Nostradamus. In Geoffrey's c. 1148 work, Life of Merlin (Vita Merlin), Merlin makes another hundred prophecies, and when Merlin's prophecies are referred to in works of British history and lore, it is this body of prophecy that is most often used as a source.

Additional prophetic insights attributed to Merlin appear in the ancient British poems and oral history. Many of the 12th-century Celtic bards made references to Merlin as a prophet, such as in the following representative verse by Welsh Bard Llywarch Ab Llywelyn (1160 to 1220): Merdhin [Merlin] prophecied That a king would come From the Cymry nation, Out of the oppressed. Druids declared. That liberality shall be renewed From the progeny of the eagles of Snowdon.3

MERLIN'S APPROACH TO PROPHECY

There is an interesting dialogue in Geoffrey's History of the Kings of Britain concerning Merlin's attitude toward prophecy. Merlin had a policy against on-the-spot, stunt-like impromptu requests for fortune telling. British king Ambrosius Aurelianus bade Merlin to foretell the future, "for he wanted to hear some marvels from him," and Merlin answered:

"Mysteries of that sort can-

not be revealed except where there is the most urgent need for them. If I were to utter them as an entertainment, or where there was no need at all, then the spirit which controls me would forsake me in the moment of need."

PROPHETIC TECHNIQUES

Merlin uses several prophetic techniques. When Vortigern asks Merlin to explain the battle of the Dragons described in Nennius' The History of Britain (Historia Brittonum, c. 800) and Geoffrey's The History of the Kings of Britain, Merlin immediately bursts into tears, draws "the breath of prophecy" and goes into a prophetic trance.5 This is reminiscent of the techniques of some mediums. Summoned by Uther Pendragon, Arthur's father, to explain the significance of a brilliant, anomalous star that appeared several times, Merlin again bursts into tears, takes a deep breath, and prophesies aloud."

Merlin also practices divination through celestial signs, most likely using a Druidic form of astrology. In both *The History of the Kings* of Britain and the Life of Merlin, he makes predictions based on comets, planets and stars.

PROPHECIES FULFILLED

Many of Merlin's prophecies have "come true." According to Geoffrey. Uther Pendragon "had been given this title because it was by means of a Dragon that Merlin had prophesied that he would become king."" Uther had two dragons fabricated from gold and gave one as a present to the congregation of the church in Winchester. The second dragon was used as a standard in battles and became his symbol. Geoffrey tells us that from that point on he was known as Uther Pendragon, which means "a dragon's head."

Merlin also foresaw the crowning of Arthur, the "Boar of Cornwall" and, in the Life of Merlin, is said to have correctly predicted the death of Rhydderch Hael, king of the Strathclyde Britons.

There are a good number of other prophecies in the *Life of Merlin* that were fulfilled, including Merlin's prediction that "The city of Dumbarton shall be destroyed."⁴ Dumbarton was destroyed by the Pictis in 736. John Jay Parry, in his notes on the Life of Merlin, lists over a dozen examples of successful Merlinian prophecies found therein.⁹

The mid-12th century Welsh Chronicle of the Princes of Wales (Brut Y Tywysogion) includes an account of the fulfillment of one of Merlin's better-known prophecies. Merlin's Welsh name, Myrddin, is used:

Year 681 ...And in that year Cadwalader the Blessed, son of Cadwallon, son of Cadvan, king of the Britons, died at Rome, on the twelfth day of May; as Myrddin had previously prophesied to Vortigern of Repulsive Lips; and thenceforth the Britons lost the crown of the kingdom, and the saxons gained it."⁹

The Chronicle of the Princes of Wales includes one other mention of Merlin, in this case in reference to a very specific double prediction that proved true centuries after it was made:

Year 1279. The ensuing year, Edward ordered the coining of new money; and that the halfpennies and farthings should be made round. And thus was

fulfilled the prophecy of Myrddin, when he says, "The symbol of the exchange shall be split, and the half shall be round."ⁿ

The first stanza of The Black Book of Carmarthen (c 1200) text of Merlin's poem "Apple Trees" ("Afallenau") states that there will be a "Wednesday of blood in the valley of the Machafwy in Elfael, when the English will be victorious,"12 Welsh scholar A. O. H. Jarman writes that "there can be no doubt that the first prediction refers to the disastrous defeat suffered by the Welsh at the hands of the English at the battle of Machafwy on August the 12th, 1198, which fell on a Wednesday."13

MERLIN INFLUENCES JOAN OF ARC

One of Merlin's prophecies may have had far-reaching historical effects. According to Lamartine, Joan of Arc was strongly influenced by a prophecy attributed to Merlin. This prophecy predicted that the kingdom would be saved by a young, chaste maiden.¹⁴

As Merlin's prophecies came true, his fame as a prophet spread. In his account of the great plague in London in 1665, Defoe writes that fortune tellers and prophets were plentiful and that "they displayed the head of Merlin as a sign."¹¹ In other words, Merlin became the symbol of successful prophecy so much so that his visage became the "logo" for prophets. In 1805, almost two centuries later, Edward Donovan wrote: "The invincible attachment of the Welsh to the prophecies of Merlin, to this day, is astonishing; there are thousands, even now who are firmly persuaded that, sooner or later, his prophecies must be accomplished."⁴

There are hundreds of Merlin's prophecies that have been thought to have come true, and there are some that have been passed down orally for centuries.

In Abergwill, originally Carreg Fyrddin (note the closeness of "Fyrddin" to "Myrddin," Welsh for Merlin) is Merlin's Stone. Merlin is said to have predicted that one day a raven would drink a man's blood off the stone. In 1876, a man searching for treasure underneath the stone was crushed when the stone fell on him."

MERLIN THE PROPHET VS. MERLIN THE MAN

One of the problems with the academic acceptance of Merlin as a historical personage is that historians' beliefs of what is or is not possible in their reality dictates certain aspects of their view of history. The distinguishing factor separating history from legend in the minds of many historians, and folklorists as well, is the presence of the magical in legend. In rejecting what seems to be legend, historians and other academics largely reject out of hand all events or aspects of

events involving "magic." This is damaging to a fuller picture of history as it excludes the unusual and anomalous, subjects in which the vast majority of historians have little or no knowledge. The rationalistic view of the world is maintained by those who either know little of strange, magical and anomalous phenomena or reject such phe-

nomena summarily. Their rationalism has become a part of their belief system and, with a crusading zeal, they guard the body of accepted knowledge from any strange intruders. Prophecy is one of these intruders.

Prophetic powers have no place in the rationalistic worldview and therefore the fact that Merlin was a prophet, and that many if not most of his works were of an oracular nature, presents some interesting and telling problems. An argument by San-Marte, that the prophetic portions of Geoffrey of Monmouth's Life of Merlin contain allusions to events that had not yet occurred

in Geoffrey's day and thus could not have been written by him, demonstrates his inability to accept the possibility that prophecy exists.¹⁸ San-Marte rejects the simplest, most logical explanation: that Merlin's prophecies may have come true after Geoffrey's death.

In his discussion of the dating of the Merlin poetry in The Black Book of Carmarthen, A.

O. H. Jarman states that "the latest datable reference in these poems is to King John's expeditions against Gwynedd in 1211, which involved the seizure of Degannwy and the sacking of Bangor, and the subsequent revolt of the Welsh under Llewelyn in 1212. This is found in a prophecy probably composed soon after the event, though attributed to Myrddin [Merlinl,"19 Jarman's dating of the Merlin poems is based on the notion that the most recently occurring event included in the prophecies must set the dating. Other scholars such as John Williams and Sharon Turner date the poems in the sixth century (the time of Merlin), but Jarman cannot do so, for it would mean admitting that Merlin was able to foresee historical events centuries before their occurrence

PROPHECIES CONNECTED WITH MERLIN

There are a number of prophecies that are connected with Merlin. One concerns Merlin's grave and is attributed to Thomas the Rhymer:

- When Tweed and Pausayl join at Merlin's grave
- Scotland and England shall one monarch have.²⁰

This ancient prophecy came true dramatically when, on the day that James VI of Scotland was crowned James I of England, the river Tweed overflowed its banks and became united with the brook Pausayl at Merlin's Grave at Drummelzier.^a

There is also a prophecy associated with his Oak tree: When Merlin's Tree shall tumble down Then shall fall Carmarthen town.²²

The tree was killed in the 19th century by a Puritan who wanted to end the local practice of holding romantic liaisons under the tree. After its death, the stump was well cared for out of respect for the ancient prophecy. At one point it was bedded in concrete.

In recent years the Carmarthenites removed the stump, which had become a traffic hazard, leaving only a piece of Merlin's Oak which is in a museum in Carmarthen.³⁰ Carmarthen has yet to fall, but the stump has not been gone for very long as these things go. Were I an inhabitant of Carmarthen, Merlin's hometown, I would not feel overly secure, for even if the prophecy of Merlin's Oak is not fulfilled, there are still the following ancient prophecies:

Llanllwch has been

Carmarthen shall sink

Abergwili shall stand.24

Me⁷lin also predicted that Carmarthen would sink when a lake in Dyfed, Llyn Eiddwen, dries up. According to Chris Barber, author of Mysterious Wales, "there are still old folk in Carmarthen who believe that one day the town will sink."⁸¹ It remains to be seen whether their beliefs are justified, but considering Merlin's reputation as a prophet, it might not be a smart move to buy any real estate in Carmarthen.

CONTROVERSIAL THEORIES-



PARADIGM

Beginning in this issue, FATE will occasionally present new and controversial scientific theories.

Here, the author uses the theoretical model or *paradigm* of the aura to explain psychic phenomena, "free" energy and gravity. Is he right? You be the judge.

Some observers believe that the controversial devices that claim to produce more energy than they consume may actually operate on *ambient free energy*—a form of energy existing all around us, the nature of which has been eluding our scientists. Most free energy researchers are outside of mainstream science, which still denies the existence of such energy.

The controversial Joseph Newman is a Mississippi inventor who designed a mechanical engine which allegedly produces more energy than it uses. He has been trying for years to get a patent on it without success (presumably because no logical theory exists to explain it). A similar claim regarding energy production/ consumption was made more recently by a team of researchers in Utah and England, who explained their device by claiming they had achieved fusion of atomic nuclei at room temperature-"cold fusion"-which, if true, would open the way to tapping the nearly-limitless energy inside the atom. Their claim was later discounted by the scientific world

I believe that non-fraudulent devices which claim to produce more energy than they use could operate by tapping into ambient macrocosmic energy (here at Earth's surface, "Earth energy"). Such machines would resonate, or "tune into," an energy that exists all around us, and draw in that energy.

The free-energy field today is as much of a free-for-all as it ever was. Researchers continue to come up with free-energy devices, "healing energy" crystals, and the like. Each researcher has his or her own theory for how they work, with no two theories agreeing. Joe Newman claims his device works via the action of energy-particles which he calls "gyrotrons." These have properties not known to science. A similar device, designed by a German named Hans Nieper, supposedly uses gravitational forces. But there has been no wide-ranging, theoretical model (paradigm) able to address the important scientific questions and the anomalous energy phenomena. And, of course, there are no systematic experimental protocols for testing such a paradigm.

The lack of interest shown by most physicists toward these anomalous products may not be justified. Despite its many accomplishments in electronic/magnetic technology, physics still lacks a clear understanding of magnetism and gravitation, and physicists might be expected to have some interest in examining alternative avenues that may have a bearing on more common, recognized energy systems. Perhaps energy systems as they exist in Nature are fundamentally different in some way from the technological systems our scientists use and upon which they base their theories.

What about psychic and other paranormal phenomena, such as spontaneous human combustion? Do they involve the same "mystery energy" as free-energy devices? Orthodox science still doesn't admit the reality of paranormality—a posture that doesn't carry very well with the substantial number of people who believe they have experienced or witnessed unquestionable instances of telepathic and other paranormal phenomena.

Telepathy is a common psychic theme. The clarity and definition of telepathic mental images over vast distances indicates that such transmissions must travel via a medium with virtually infinite features.

Another psychic theme is metal bending. I personally know of sessions in which novices are taught to psychically bend metal utensils.

THE "AURA" PARADIGM

An "aura" paradigm of energy would be very attractive for

explaining these kinds of phenomena. According to this model, all solid objects—including humans and metallic objects—would have auric energy fields. The energy waves of two dissimilar objects, when resonating with each other (as when you "tune in" your radio to a specific radio station's frequency) react with each other.

Auric energy could be associated with or attached to the tiny particles comprising matter, so that auric energy would exist within as well as near solid bodies. An object like a spoon could be affected by auric energy transmissions resonating at the frequency of the spoon's aura and that come from another body such as that of a human.

THE NATURE OF AURIC ENERGY

The fact that science has not delineated such an energy up to now suggests that auric energy, if it exists, would have to consist of energy transmissions of a different nature than the atomic particles and energy particles thus far characterized by physics—electrons, neutrons, and so on. The *medium* of auric energy transmis-

> sions would necessarily have to be of the same nature—a kind of super-fine ether composed of tiny particle-units. It would be a medium that theoretically could allow transmissions of a more

dynamic and precise nature than the kinds of energy systems used by science. This theoretical medium would allow for phenomena with virtually infinite ranges and other features as described in the literature of psychic phenomena.

In the 1920s, when Einstein's theory of gravity was adopted by science, one of the major competing theories of gravity was that of a U.S. Navy scientist named T.I.I. See, who proposed that gravity arises from a wave-effect in a universal ether. See's model was endorsed by Edgar Cayce and Nikola Tesla. See pointed out that energy waves, such as light waves, become wider (their amplitude increases) the closer they are to a heavenly body like Earth. He proposed that gravity waves, magnetic waves, and all other waves must do so also. His model of gravity involved the concept of a "vacuum" created in the ether by the widening of "waves of force" near to a body like Earth. (See did not explain why waves widen close to a body.)

The aura model supplies the missing link in See's model. To understand how this would work, one first would have to see how this aura theory applies to magnetism on a planet like Earth and to planetary magnetic fields.

THE SECRET OF GRAVITY In an aura model of energy,

the massive Earth has the controlling or "parent" aura. All smaller auras, like that of humans, metals, etc. acquire a variety of features (such as magnetism) as they resonate with Earth's surrounding energies (magnetic-type directionality is a pervasive theme in psychic phenomena, such as telepathy, metal bending, dowsing, etc). The aura model of energy must focus on Earth magnetism.

The aura model leads to a much simpler model of Earth magnetism than the currently accepted model. The latter is based on a complicated series of hypothetical radioactive and other processes in the central core, 2,000 miles down. In an aura model. Earth's three laverscore, surface crust, and intervening mantle-would each emit a vast auric energy field from its huge mass, and the three fields would resonate with each other to produce the planetary energy field. The magnetism of this field (Earth's magnetic field) results from the way these field resonations occur. Physicists call this linear resonation.

This vast auric energy, close to a heavenly body such as Earth, would include a large quantity of magnetized or auric energy particles. The ether in space would be relatively nonmagnetized when compared to the aura of a planet. Therefore, the energy of the auric particles of the ether in space will be different from the energy of the particles when the ether approaches a body such as a planet.

See pointed out that if an ether exists, its elastic power must be enormous because it would have a stupendous number of minuscule particles. It would exert more force in space than close to a cosmic body, where the ether "thins out" and where wave transmissions "widen out."

The aura model contends that solid bodies' atoms are in a constant flux, continuously emitting and absorbing very fine auric energy-particles. Thus, close to a solid body, the ether particles would be modified (magnetized) by their interactions with the atoms and auric influences of the bodies. The ether would thin out. Etheric particles would combine into larger units like atoms, resulting in a smaller number of larger particles. In space, the ether would consist of a much larger number of smaller particles. The latter would be much more forceful, gravitationally.

CONCLUSION

The kind of cosmic model one is finally led to by the aura/ether concept is one of a dense ether out in space exerting powerful gravitational force toward cosmic bodies, where the ether is thinned out by resonating with the atoms of the bodies. This cosmic model is much simpler than the accepted model. Many believe that the simplest model which explains all phenomena is the best one, making the auric model more compelling than those that postulate multiple forces and multiple dimensions, and deny the existence of auric forces.

Newton's mathematical formula for the force of gravity—gravity being inversely proportional to the square of the distance between two objects—suggests that gravity is a single, simple force. Gravity, as mathematically described by Newton and Einstein, does not mix with the rest of particle/energy theory, so physicists have been postulating additional forces to make it fit. The true solution may lie elsewhere.

Only recently have we become aware of the energies contained within the planet. Gravity, the magnetic field, and the radioactivity in the earth all required that instruments be invented before they could be measured. The purpose of this article has been to present rationale for the existence of auric forces not yet perceived by science, and to suggest that we ought to think of our world as comprising not just objects but auras.

Why do mountain climbers—both amateur and professional— run in terror off the Scottish mountain named Ben MacDhui?

Who-or what-is the figure that they see?

A t a lofty height of 4296 feet, Ben

MacDhui of the Cairngorms range is second only to Ben Nevis as Scotland's tallest mountain, and second to none as its most mysterious. It is usually reached by a 20-mile-long path leading away from the Glenmore Lodge and extending through the arduous Lairig Ghru pass. Ben MacDhui was once a rarely-visited, lonely locale, but its towering peak with flat-topped summit began to attract increasing attention from mountain climbers when mountaineering became popular during this century's early years.

It was not long, however, before strange tales were brought back by intrepid visitors to this dark, brooding mountain-tales of ghostly music, inexplicable laughter and voices, and other uncanny phenomena. Most dramatic of all were reports concerning apparitions of colossal size, crunching footsteps that followed the climbers and, above all else. an unaccountable and uncontrollable fear that frequently drove them down and away from the mountain in a fit of blind panic.

These last three phenomena in particular seemed to share a common origin, unhesitatingly identified by the area's residents as being an entity that they firmly believed to inhabit Ben Mac-Dhui's upper reaches, and known locally as Am Fear Liath Mor. or in English as the Big Grey Man. For many years, this mysterious matter attracted much attention in Scottish newspapers and journals, with many reports and explanations appearing. Such coverage culminated in 1970 with the publication of The Big Grey Man of Ben MacDhui; an indispensable book on the subject and written by Cairngorms-bred author Affleck Gray.

In more recent times, however, interest has waned. This is surprising as many of the more modern thoughts and ideas raised in relation to various other mysterious phenomena are particularly relevant to the Big Grey man enigma. Consequently, almost 20 years after Gray's book appeared, it seemed more than timely to take the opportunity of re-analyzing the subject by applying some of those concepts to it. First, however, here are a few of some of the more startling encounters and experiences reported from Ben MacDhui.

THE PROFESSOR IS TERRIFIED

Probably the most famous of all such reports was that of Norman Collie, published in 1926. Until then, the subject had not attracted much serious attention. But Collie was one of the period's most experienced and respected mountaineers as well as Professor of Organic Chemistry at the University of London. He was also an austere man by nature who vehemently shunned sensationalism. Here was a witness with impeccable credentials, whose words could not be readily dismissed.

Collie was the speaker at the Annual General Meeting of Aberdeen's Cairngorm Club in December 1925. He announced that on his last visit to Ben MacDhui he had been descending from the Cairn while surrounded on all sides by dense mist. "...I began to think I heard something else than merely the noise of my own footsteps. For every few steps I took I heard a crunch, and then another crunch as if someone was walking after me but taking steps three or four times the length of my own." He attempted to laugh at himself for being fanciful, and continued walking, but the eerie sounds followed on behind him (with the mist that immersed him hiding their source from his view). Finally, he admitted that "... I was seized with terror and took to my heels, staggering blindly among the boulders for four or five miles nearly down to Rothiemurchus Forest." Not surprisingly, he vowed never to go back to that menacing mountain, and ever afterwards remained convinced that there was "...something very queer about the top of Ben Mac-Dhui."

THE DOCTOR SEES A BIG GREY MAN

During the early 1920s, Collie was contacted by another renowned mountaineer, Dr. A.M. Kellas, who had learned of Collie's Ben MacDhui experience before it had become widely known, Dr. Fellas informed Collie that while climbing that mountain with his brother Henry, he had spied a figure that he described as "...a big grey man ... " walking from the Lairig Ghru pass up and around the 10foot-tall Cairn toward Ben Mac-Dhui's summit, where it disappeared from view. Dr. Kellas affirmed that the mystery figure seemed to be at least as tall as the Cairn itself. This is a historic report, for it was responsible for providing Am Fear Liath Mor with its English appellation.

The December 1925 issue of the Aberdeen Press and Journal contained further news concerning this incident, based upon information given by Henry Kellas to W.G. Robertson, a friend. Apparently the Kellas brothers had awaited the Big Grey Man's reappearance at the summit, but "...fear possessed them ere it did reach the top, and they fled. They were aware it was following them, and tore down by Corrie Etchachan to escape it."

NO SAFETY UNDER SHELTER STONE

In the summer of 1940, and in the company of a friend with whom he was residing during a holiday, More Highland Folktales author R. MacDonald Robertson spent a night inside a famous. enormous block of stone on Ben MacDhui known as the Shelter Stone-as travelers frequently take shelter and rest beneath it. During that night, they were awakened by the growls of Robertson's pet bull terrier, and could soon discern the sound of crunching footsteps, approaching nearer and nearer along the gravel path outside. The identity of the footsteps' originator, however, was never discovered, for without warning, the sound of the steps just faded away, after which Robertson's dog relaxed once more.

In The Big Grey Man of Ben MacDhui, Affleck Gray reported that one evening in 1942, while in the vicinity of the Shelter Stone and gazing out toward Loch Avon (A'an), the experienced mountain climber Syd Scroggie

suddenly-perceived " ... a tall, stately, human figure, appear out of the blackness on one side of the loch, and clearly silhouetted against the water pace with long, deliberate steps across the combined burns just where they enter the loch." The figure was not wearing a rucksack, and was soon hidden from view by the darkness on the loch's opposite side. Intrigued, Scroggie lost no time in reaching the locality of his sighting and searching it thoroughly for footprints and any other sign of the figure's movements, but he found nothing. Similarly, he called out in the hope of receiving a reply but none came. Instead, he experienced a distinct, eerie sense of unease, one that sent him on his way back with all speed to the welcome security of the Shelter Stone!

SHOOTING THE BIG GREY MAN

As far as I am aware, the month of October in 1943 has a unique claim to fame in this saga by hosting the only instance on record of someone actually shooting the Big Grey Man! Mountaineer and naturalist Alexander Tewnion had been walking along the Lairig Ghru one day that month on the lookout for some game to shoot and thereby supplement his wartime rations. He had begun to descend the track through Corrie Etchachan's deep trough, when suddenly he became aware of the sound of long, striding footsteps just behind him. As he recalled to the Scots Magazine in June 1958, they immediately brought to mind the strange narrative many years earlier of Professor Collie. So he peered at once through the mist in the direction of the footsteps, and was startled by a mysterious shape that loomed up menacingly, momentarily withdrew, and then charged directly at him!

Instantly, Tewnion drew out his revolver and fired three shots straight at the figure, but they had absolutely no effect—the threatening shape was still coming! Needless to say, he lost no time in turning around and fleeing precipitately downward, toward Glen Derry and safety!

These are just some of the unnerving and uncanny incidents, but how can they be accounted for?

GEOLOGICAL ARTIFACT?

The Hexham heads are a couple of small stone artifacts that were found in a garden at Hexham, England, in 1972, and since have been associated with a number of seemingly supernatural occurrences, including the

In *Tales of the Hexham Heads* (1980) by Paul Screeton, a possible solution for the wolfman entity is postulated by inorganic chemistry specialist Dr. Don Robins. The theory could be readily applied to the Big Grey Man mystery too.

Dr. Robins' theory proposes that various minerals may be capable of encoding (storing) a type of electrical energy. Under certain specific conditions a kinetic image could actually be released. Among the supporting evidence that Robins provides is that of the visual similarity between modern-day threedimensional holograph's interference patterns and the chemical nature of certain mineral compounds—a geological holograph'

Could this be the source of the Big Grey Man? Certainly one could hardly conceive of a more conducive locality for such activity than a rocky mountainous peak like Ben MacDhui. And if such mineralogical manifestations could incorporate both visual and aural components, this could then explain the crunching footsteps and huge figure reported from that mountain.

This theory does not, however, answer why Ben MacDhui should yield such a preponderance of petrological phantoms as compared with other British mountains in general. Could this anomaly be due to certain specific and crucial, but currently unrecognized, differences in geological composition, historical background, and/or other attributes?

OPTICAL ILLUSION?

Many reports of phantoms have undoubtedly resulted from optical illusions. We can all recall incidents in which we have perceived an object to be something totally different from what it first appeared to be. Such frequent occurrences are due to our brain making assumptions regarding the appearance and identity of a poorly- or briefly-seen object, and then "filling in" the missing details, so that we think we have seen it in greater detail than is really the case.

R.A. Proctor described such an illusion in an article entitled "Notes on Ghosts and Goblins" (Cornhill Magazine, April 1873). Very distrught after his mother's death, he awoke one night to perceive, standing at the foot of his bed in his moonili college bedroom, a white image of his mother—he could even discern tears in her eyes. He gazed at the image for some time, then leaned forward to observe it more closely. Instantly it transformed itself into his college surplice hanging down from its hook, with the "tears" becoming the silvered buckles of a rowing belt hung over the surplice!

When he deliberately lay back in his original position in an attempt to revisualize the illusion, he found that he could not. His surplice and belt remained as such before his eyes, for now that his brain was aware of their true identity, it could not be fooled again into "filling in" the details to create the image of his mother.

One form of optical illusion involving this principle, and which is extremely pertinent to the Big Grey Man phenomenon, is termed the autokinetic effect. This illusion occurs when there is a lack of visual clues for an observer to use in determining whether or not an object is moving. The result of this is the observer's perception of apparent movement by the object when in reality the latter is completely immobile.

Climber William Hutchison Murray gave a good example of the autokinetic effect in his book Mountaineering in Scotland (1947). While in the Cairngorms one day, he saw what he believed to be two climbers traversing from east to west across the snowscape ahead of him. As he approached these "climbers," they paused, apparently waiting for him. Ultimately, however, when he was about 100 yards away, he discovered their true identity—they were a pair of black boulders! The autokinetic effect explains certain sightings of phantasmal figures and giant beings seemingly observed on desolate mountains.

HALLUCINATION, OR BROCKEN SPECTER?

As a result of the very considerable publicity that followed Professor Collie's Big Grey Man account, visitors to Ben MacDhui not infrequently contemplate the legends and rumors regarding its mysterious entity while actually climbing its lonely slope. Those who do not think of it directly are generally aware of the phenomenon. Consequently, given a sudden, unexpected sound or strangely-shaped wall of mist, it could be readily envisaged how the startled minds of such climbers could "fill in the details" to create, especially if further influenced by autokinetic illusions too, a very real (to them) phantom or presence that they would sincerely believe to be the Big Grev Man.

In contrast to such psychologically-induced optical illusions, however, hallucinations—images housed within the mind of the "observer" and based not upon any external object—comprise a very different situation. More-

over, it is very difficult to believe that apparent encounters with the Big Grey Man by experienced mountaineers could be explained in this manner.

Yet another phantom form, and one that could be participating to the Big Grey Man mystery, occurs in mountainous regions under certain climatic conditions that cause a person's shadow to become greatly magnified, which in turn is sometimes thrown onto a cloudbank or patch of mist. This eerie effect is known as a Brocken specter, named after a peak in the German Harz Mountains from which the effect was first recorded. Clearly this could be responsible for various sightings of huge beings on Ben MacDhui and associated terror.

Certainly it can be an unnerving spectacle to the uninformed observer; so too can be the weird shapes sometimes produced by local condensations of water vapor. Naturally, however, neither of these could explain the aural components of Big Grey Man encounters. Various precipitation effects could, but these, conversely, could not explain the sightings, thereby failing to provide a comprehensive solution.

AN ENERGY TRACE?

Techniques such as Kirlian photography seem to reveal that living organisms release intense amounts of energy during periods of extreme emotion-energy, that can leave behind in a given locality a concentrated invisible trace even after the organism itself has moved away. The energy trace theory proposes that if a locality in which such a trace has been released experiences on some future occasion a similar emotive disturbance, the original trace may develop and actually become visible for a time, and in turn provide an explanation for reports of phantoms and ghosts. Such a process would be analogous to the original image on a photographic plate becoming visible when developed.

It can also be seen that the process could have great bearing on the Big Grey Man enigma. Some mysterious events reported on Ben MacDhui have occurred directly after the climbers concerned had been contemplating the Big Grey Man legends. Following the energy trace theory's line of argument, could their thoughts, intensified by their solitary, hitherto undisturbed travels upon the mountain, have triggered the appearance of some energy trace image originally created by earlier visitors to Ben MacDhui? The energy trace theory additionally postulates that some people release greater amounts of energy than others, thereby offering an explanation for why many climbers have not experienced anything strange on Ben MacDhui, namely that these must have followed people who did not release sufficient energy themselves to create any original invisible trace image.

ELECTROMAGNETIC PHANTOM?

Perhaps phantoms could be energy forms occupying the immediate boundaries of the visible spectrum of electromagnetic radiation, i.e., the infrared (IR) and ultraviolet (UV) regions. Ghost-like images, unseen by photographers, have been captured on film sensitive to these wavelengths.

According to one researcher, locality photographs exist that reveal ghostly heat (IR) images of people and vehicles that left the locality in question many hours before it was photographed. Heat (IR) images may explain many "photographed phantoms," especially those in contemporary attire.

Could the phantoms of the UV wavelengths conversely be the genuine article—real ghosts? According to frequent documentation in literature appertaining to paranormal phenomena, investigations of notable psychics have often revealed that their eyes' color-sensitive spectrum is displaced to the right of everyone else's. That is to say, the eyes of psychics appear less sensitive than those of other people to the visible spectrum's red zone, but overtly sensitive to the violet extreme and seemingly even beyond that, into the UV zone (normally invisible to human eyes). If this is indeed true, and if psychical phantoms (whatever they may actually be) reflect UV light, this would account not only for their visibility to psychics and invisibility to everyone else, but also for many examples of mysterious photos that clearly depict forms unseen by the photographer yet which are evidently something more than mere heat images.

The Big Grey Man might be an electromagnetic phantom, an entity beyond the vision of most humans (hence the rarity of sightings in comparison with the frequent reports of footsteps) but whose presence is still sensed. Of course, this is wholly speculative at present.

"WINDOW" AREAS

In addition to Ben MacDhui, many other localities in Britain and elsewhere seem to possess mystical attributes. These appear linked not to the people who experience them but to the localities themselves. Such locations are popularly held by researchers of the paranormal to be "window" areas, portals through which visitors from other dimensions can enter our world's time and space. Applying this theory to the Big Grey Man mystery, it could be postulated that Ben MacDhui is a "window" area.

One might assume that such an inter-dimensional interface would surely be monitored and protected by some form of warden or guardian. This entity's function would be to ward off any potential intruder (deliberate or accidental), ensuring by every means available to it that everyone kept well away from the portal's vicinity. It can be seen that the above description corresponds perfectly with the reported activity and behavior of the Big Grey Man.

A LAST WORD

Is the above scenario possible, or just science fiction? Are any of the theories discussed here the correct one? Who can say?

What can be said, and with certainty, however, is that there are many very experienced and respected mountaineers willing to testify that Ben MacDhui does possess a number of unsolved mysteries, including an entity that apparently seeks most emphatically to keep them that way.

On September 12, 1940, 14-yearold Jacques Marsal was playing with two young friends and a neighbor in an oak forest outside the village of Lascaux, 300 miles south of Paris, France. Suddenly, their dog disappeared into a hole, barking furiously as he sought to escape.

The boys lowered the neighbor into the hole, and when they lifted him out, he appeared filthy, shaken and claimed that he had seen ghosts.

It would seem that the boys had found a real *Alice in Wonderland* rabbit hole—but they actually found something far more wonderful.

Returning the next day, the boys found a large cave whose walls were decorated with colorful paintings of leaping stags, buffalo and prehistoric horses. Archaeolo-gists who came to study the paintings said that they dated back to about 14,000 B.C.

In 1964, however, it was determined that the carbon dioxide in the visitors' breath was harming the paintings, and the cave was closed to the public. A replica was built nearby and opened in 1983.

names run off the tongue, with similarities between some of them. Could it be that the creatures also are similar? I would suggest that the answer is yes, and for many reasons.

I am fortunate to have a huge number of photos, drawings and descriptions of these creatures. Since not everyone knows these names, let me explain that Nessie inhabits Loch Ness and is the best-known lake monster. Chessie hails from the Chesapeake Bay region of Maryland, and Tessie is found in Lake Tahoe, on the California/Nevada line.

Mokele M'bembe guards small (three miles long) Lac Telle in the Republic of the Congo, (a place that will eat up an investigator's money), Ogopogo wiggles around Lake Okanangan in British Columbia, and Champ is the queen of Lake Champlain, which crosses NY, Vermont and Canada. All are alleged lake monsters, all have differences, and all have some similarity. For a detailed background of each, see the bibliography in the book by Henry Bauer, The Enigran of Loch Ness.

DIFFERENCES AND SIMILARITIES

What then, are these differences and similarities? Nessie has been sighted and filmed in many shapes, but most often in two basic forms: a plesiosaur shape and a snake shape. Chessie seems to be mostly a serpentine shape, according to Mike Frizzell, of the Enigma Project in Reisterstown, MD.

Tessie is rarely seen, and was filmed just once in a roll of film that the local chamber of commerce, who owns the film, will not allow to be viewed, lest it scare away tourists. In the film and descriptions by witnesses, it is also a long object that never shows a head, flipper or fin.

Ogopogo has been described mostly as a serpentine shape, recently with a fluked tail by one witness; with no tail flukes by most others. Occasionally a humped back is reported.

Champ is mostly seen as a serpentine object, like a telephone pole that moves, except with undulations. Two visual aids, however, show something else. The Mansi photo shows a humped back with a long neck and a head, and the Hall video shows a hump with a neck as well. Yet, a number of photos taken by Ms. Kelly Williams shows another serpentine telephone pole.

Mokele M'bembe is special and will be discussed below.

Although some of the descriptions and photos of the same (or different) creatures are similar or identical, some are wildly different. A researcher must ask, "How can we reconcile all these differences?"

A SOLUTION IN A NEW THEORY

If we stick to the old idea that these creatures are animals, we are caught in a dead end, for no animal, or animals, could account for all these variations that seem at times incompatible. It is simply too much to expect that a basilosaurus (an ancient whale). a plesiosaur, a giant snake and a monster worm could all exist side by side in these different lakes. Michael Meurger has written a book called Monsters of Canadian Lakes, and in it he points out that different lakes have different-looking lake monsters, and other lakes have several different kinds of lake monsters. It is hard enough to accept one basic monster without having to accept the idea of several different kinds, all coexisting in different lakes.

As a solution, I offer a new version of an older idea about Nessie and those of like ilk. Ted Holiday (see his book *The Goblin Universe*) and others in the past have suggested that Nessie may have come from, and gone back to, some other dimension, and may not be a normal animal at all. This concept is very difficult to prove and is beyond our current scientific ability to test. Most researchers feel that Holiday's ideas are too far out.

However, if we rephrase these ideas into a more testable hy-

pothesis, the results may explain both the similarities of Nessle, Chessie, etc., as well as the differences. At the same time, it may bring about a re-focus on the lake phenomenon problem. The zoological path has proven to be a dead end.

Let us look at Nessie, Chessie, etc., as an energy phenomena that can change to solid matter for short periods of time-perhaps even energy phenomena that has either guidance or intelligence, or an ability to react to the expectations and/or knowledge of their observers. An energy form might take the shape of a moving energized streak in the water. If it is able to feed off the expectations of its observers, it could take a more definite form as it moves along. Perhaps in lakes where there are no viewers the phenomenon might not take any form at all.

A good example is Lake Tahoe and Tessie. Few people expect a lake monster to appear in high and remote Lake Tahoe. Few lake monster experts visit there. Thus, the phenomenon asserts itself as a long, narrow body with no head and no tail. Perhaps if researchers were to live there, future sightings might feature a head, hump and tail.

Miss Alexandria David-Neel, a French scholar and traveler, has written in her book, Magic and Mystery of Tibet, of the idea of forming "tulpoids" or creatures made from mental constructs, "mind creatures." If it is true that the mind can form physical or semi-physical beings, then maybe the lake monsters are given much of their form from the thoughts, conscious or otherwise, of the observers.

A RECENT EXAMPLE

I was at Loch Ness in 1983, the 50th anniversary of Loch Ness research, trying to use robot video to catch the image of Nessie. Our results were marginal with this technique. One day while waiting for a TV program to air about our efforts, I observed a series of rings being formed in the water about mile away. Fish do this, but these rings caught my attention because they were being formed in a straight line, one ring after another, some ten feet apart.

I watched with ten power binoculars, and saw, I thought, two small, straw-shaped objects, less than two inches long, surfacing to form each ring, then submerging. I waited, tried to film them with a telephoto lens, and watched some more. At one point I thought I saw a pink body, perhaps six feet long, almost surface, and then submerge. It had neither fins, head nor tail that I could see. The body slightly reminded me of a Florida manatee. The film did not turn out, and I resolved to watch for this again the next time the water was calm.

Later, on one of the last days spent at the Loch, we had a caravan at Achnahannet, some miles away from the Clansmen Hotel where the first ring-sightings had occurred. At 8 A.M., I noticed the same sort of rings forming, this time going toward Fort Agustus to our right. I pulled out a movie

camera and proceeded to shoot the rings as they formed, perhaps at three mph, going down the Loch in the calm water. As I filmed with three people watching, I wondered if it would surface. I had to stop twice to wind the film, and as the film ran out, the rings subsided and petered out.

I thought nothing much would come of the film, and paid little attention to it until I returned to the U.S. However, after a number of viewings, it gradually became apparent that more than a series of rings had been filmed. What appeared at first to he a mere water disturbance became a progression of form on the water rather than in it. The white rings expanded to form a long streak. The streak undulated,

> like a pair of linked inchworms, and these in turn became a comet-like form, taking on a shape similar to a Concorde jet, on the calm, blue water.

> To my surprise, enlargements showed a gray rounded face, sometimes with two horns mounted above, looking at the four of us around the camera. To do this, the thing had to crank its head over at a 90 degree angle, looking sideways and up, while still moving forward. Dr. Maccabee agrees that there is a trianglular nose, and other views see a set of eyes, and a mouth with

some heavy duty teeth—like a set of short walrus tusks—mounted aiming downward. The face image has little contrast, which is typical of energy phenomena of a less controversial type, such as moving mist, or windstorm. Overall, it seems a cross between a cat, an otter and a walrus. It was found to measure ten feet, so otters are out, cats are out, and there are no ten-foot white walruses in Loch Ness. Los Angeles zoologists agree that it is nothing known to them.

Each frame of the film shows a changed form and a changed face. Further in the film the object changes again to a linear water disturbance, a frothy line on the surface. After I had wound the camera, the object changed again and continued to change.

The last head to appear is the most bizarre, and the hardest to accept. In six frames, up comes a white blob, unformed, and in under one second the head took on definite features. It looks like a man's head, bald, with two tufts of hair, somewhat rectangular, rounded in shape, with wide open eyes, a nose and mouth. In two more seconds, it has gone down under the water, and at that point the film stops, needing to be wound again.

The last sequence shows just an occasional ring in the water, then nothing. The water is calm, as if nothing had happened.

Dr. Maccabee agrees that the object moves, and is probably animate, and that it looked at us. Zoologists at the Los Angeles Museum of Natural History agree that the film shows no known animal or fish. Other zoologists discount even a school of small fish. Operation Deepscan, a sonar effort at Loch Ness in October 1987, discovered that schools of bait fish do exist, but at least 50 feet down and not on the surface. Thus, the object seems to be the Loch Ness phenomenon, or Nessie.

My point in this analysis is to show that it may be possible that our own thoughts affected the image that the pheomenon radiated to our camera. As it progressed to our right, it may have grown in substance due to input from our collective thoughts about what Nessie should be like. As it got beyond range, it subsided to nothing. It starts as almost nothing, grows to a ten-foot object, becomes a series of appearing and disappearing heads, then subsides to nothing-something like a bell curve in intensity. Of note might be that the John Cobb Memorial was one mile away, and Cobb, a racer, died in a jet boat in 1952 at that spot. Cobb was bald, and had thin hair on the sides of his face.

Perhaps Nessie, Tessie, Chessie

and the others have been affected by the preconceptions, or lack of same, of lakeside viewers. The very strongest images with the most detail—heads, humps, tails, tails with spikes and backs with triangular stegosaurus-type projections—are found in Loch Ness, which draws a very literate and educated group of visitors. Nobody expects a Tessie, nor a sedzedi of the Congo army has drawn a very worm-like rendering of M.M., based on his own sighting of the creature. It looks more like a large worm or snake than like any brontosaurus, or even plesiosaur.

In the '70s, explorer James Powell asked natives about the creature and showed them pho-

Chessie, so their images are less complex. Champ has almost as much press as Nessie, and thus its image is often complex.

Ogopogo is felt by many people to be so far from Loch Ness that any similarity is remote, so its image, fed from the minds of visiPerhaps the same energy phenomenon is in all the lakes of the world, and it reflects to viewers what their background, racial memories, education, and expectations send to the phenomenon.

tors, is more Chessie-like, i.e., telephone-pole style.

THE MYSTERY OF MOKELE M'BEMBE

Mokele M'bembe is the dollar drainer of the African continent. Herman Regusters, who saw the creature in 1981, has made a hump-and-neck type drawing that brings to mind Nessie. Zoo director Marcellin Agagna has done the same. Colonel E. Mostos of animals like hippos and elephants, with other photos of re-creations of prehistoric animals mixed in. Invariably, the natives picked either the brontosaurus or the plesiosaur.

These images may have reinforced a tulpoid Mokele M'bembe's shape. Where the earliest pygmies and other local natives got their mental images from, we do not know. In any case, there are more reports of MM being of the plesiosaur form than the snake form, and thus it tends to be different from the northern hemisphere lake monsters. The mechanics of its mental-energy feeding process, however, appear to be the same, with the same result. Mokele M'bembe seems to be more in the lake monster mold than the dinosaur mold, and it is most often encountered in the water, over its head-not the usual habitat for a brontosaurus.

There do exist stories of sea serpents in the southern hemisphere, and while these are not lake monsters, I will throw in a brief account of a sea serpent seen by a hotel manager from Mamatanai, New Ireland, Papua New Guinea, while I was there in 1983, debunking stories of natives eating mermaids. It seems that twice in the '70s this manager, an Englishman, had encountered a 50 foot serpent, lying underwater on the sea bottom in a lagoon near Ramat Bay. He described it as looking like Chessie: a large, snake-like thing, and he avoided disturbing it lest it decide to eat him for lunch. Ramat Bay was where many of the alleged mermaids were seen, which later were proven to be dugongs, a relative of the manatee.

INTELLIGENT ENERGY?

Perhaps the same energy phenomenon is in all the lakes of the world, and it reflects to viewers what their background, racial memories, education, and expectations send to the phenomenon. The more sophisticated the viewers, the more likely the image received is equally sophisticated. However, this may not be completely true in all instances. The images seen are too varied to be of mere animals, and a better theory, which physics can someday test, is a theory of intelligent energy, reflecting our own thoughts and images to us.

I propose that Nessie, Chessie, Tessie, Ogopogo and Champ are all the same phenomenon. So too is Mokele M'bembe, but with some regional and perhaps foreigner-influenced input that results in it seeming to be of the hump and neck type.

If the alleged lake monsters are viewed as being unknown energy phenomena, all the apparent contradictions fall away and the path is cleared for physics to make sense of something where zoology could not.



THE PRESIDENTIAL DEATH CYCLE



Every 20 years since 1840, an elected president has died in office. This did not happen to President Reagan (elected 1980). Why not? And most importantly, will it happen again?

BLAME IT ON THE PLANETS

It would seem that a reasonable mind would consider the socalled "Death Cycle" mere superstition. As for astrologers, why should it matter to them? Who ever said that the 20-year cycle had to be astrological?

Well, I did, for one. And so did several astrologers before me. It doesn't take a very clever mind to read what went on in the heavens on those separate occasions of the deaths of presidents. It has been known for some time that the death cycle almost perfectly coincides with a "transiting Jupiter/Satum conjunction. While in *transit* in their orbits around the Sun, the planets Jupiter and Saturn (from our earth-bound perspective) seem to occupy the same degree of celestial longitude—the imaginary North-South line that dissects the external globe of the heavens.

Jupiter-astrological symbol of growth, expansion, plenty, liber-

alism and generally benevolent matters—takes about 12 years to pass through the 12 signs of the zodiac.

Saturn—a planet symbolic of hard lessons to be learned, of endings, sorrows, frugal times and conservatism—takes more than twice that time to make its own way through those 12 signs. Every 20 years, they align.

The empirical evidence-gathering upon which astrology has been based for thousands of years demands that astrologers stay alert to what goes on in the world. The current events of the times of those conjunctions reveal that they were also central to periods of debilitating depressions and/or major shakeups in the economy—either regional, affecting just the U.S. or the Western hemisphere, or worldwide, but focusing on the U.S.

ECONOMIC WOES AND PRESIDENTS' DEATHS

Here are the economic times that accompanied the deaths of the presidents aforementioned:

1. The Debt Repudiation Recession, a slump that lasted between 1841 and 1844.

2. Reconstruction woes plus the Secession Depression of 1865-1866.

3. The Secondary Post-War Depression of (pre-)1880.

4. In 1900, overlapping and

contradictory astrological cycles brought boom times that eradicated all the ill effects of Jupiter/ Saturn.

5. The Primary Post-War Depression of 1920-1923.

6. The economic crisis caused by America's entry into WW II.

7. The period of economic priority shifts corresponding with the step-up in the Cold War that created a defense-oriented economic boom and the setting up, many believe, of false premises in the basic economy.

JUPITER/SATURN CONJUNCTION

The Jupiter/Saturn conjunction occurred on the following dates and in the following zodiacal signs:

- •January 26. 1842, in Capricorn;
- October 21, 1861, in Virgo;
- April 18, 1881, in Taurus;
- November 28, 1901, in Capricorn;
- September 10, 1921, in Virgo;
- August 8, 1940, in Taurus (and due to retrogradation, also on February 15, in Taurus);
- February 19, 1961, in Capricorn;
- December 31, 1980, in Libra.

Now, since this event takes place every 20 years, give or take a few months, it stands to reason that the *aspect* (the Jupiter-Saturn conjunction) occurred in 1820 and 1800 as well, all times when there were American presidents in office. None of those men died in office.

Long before Ronald Reagan, why were Jefferson and Monroe immune?

THE KENNEDY CURSE

In 1976, my book The Kennedy Curse, an astrological view of the woes of the nation's First Clan, was published. Originally entitled An Astrologer Tracks Down the Kennedy "Curse," it was a look at the "karmic" elements in the combined chart of the Kennedy family-how that element resonated in the charts of lack. Bobby, Joe Jr., Teddy and others. And, since John F. Kennedy had been the most recent victim of the 20-year cycle, I devoted a chapter to an analysis of that cycle.

Plus, people were worried about Teddy Kennedy. If he was elected in 1980, would he be the next victim—the next in line for the Kennedy Curse, as well as the 20-Year American Curse?

My attention was turned to the earlier conjunctions I mentioned—those occurring before 1840. Why indeed did no tragedy or economic depression occur?

DEADLY CONJUNCTIONS DEPEND ON FATAL ELEMENT

The sole astrological difference between the earlier benign times accompanying the conjunction and the events surrounding the seven deadly ones was the *Element* in which they occurred.

The 12 signs of the zodiac are broken down by astrologers into four sub-groupings called Elements. These are the primordial elements: Fire, Earth, Air and Water. The first two times the conjunction occurred after the formation of the U.S. presidency, it occurred in signs that were of the Element Fire, Because of several technical factors-including the fact that the conjunction might occur at 19 years four months one time, and at 21 years another time-there is no guarantee that they will continue to occur in signs of the same Element.

THE GREAT MUTATION CYCLE

The tendency for the alignment to shift into other signssigns of different Elements—is called the Great Mutation Cycle. This cycle would not occur if the heavens were perfect and all the planets in perfect alignment in their orbits, but the revolution of Saturn about the Sun takes more than twice the time as Jupiter's. Due to this, the seven Jupiter/ Saturn conjunctions that occurred after the 1820 alignment in Fire were in the Element Earth, apparently the fatal Element. (For almost 150 years before 1820, the eight conjunctions of the two planets had occurred in the Element Fire.

Due to the same Great Mutation, the recent conjunction that occurred in 1980 took place in the Element Air.

Fire represents will, forcefulness, and limitless growth.

Much expansion occurred on the North American continent during the years of the Fire conjunctions, and the new economy began to flourish. Maybe experience and empirical evidence will show us that the conjunction is always beneficial in Fire. We already know it is detrimental when it is in Earth. But, to truly know how we will fare under the Fire Element, we must wait until the 22nd century or so, when they begin to occur in that Element again.

There are many reasons to expect benevolent manifestations when the conjunction occurs in Fire. One is that expansive Jupiter is at home in Fire (this is an astrological consideration based on the fact that astrologers see the planets and "lights" as having "rulership" over individual zodiac signs. Within this system, the planet Jupiter is seen to "rule" the Fire sign Sagittarius), while the more solemn Saturn is at "home" in the Element Earth (for similar reasons). Insofar as one is seen as growth and general benevolence and the other represents endings and tough lessons to be learned, we tend to experience either tragedy or growth—depending on the Element in which the conjunction occurs.

OKAY FOR TED KENNEDY TO RUN FOR PRESIDENCY

When it came to advising Teddy Kennedy via my book, I could only encourage his candidacy by assuming that the 20-Year Cycle would not repeat itself in 1980.

My reasoning was based on two things: I was aware that, for the first time in the United States' history, the Jupiter/Saturn conjunction would occur in the Element Air—in the sign of Libra.

The majority of astrologers are aware that, among the Elements, Air has the closest affinity with Fire. Thus, I felt it would be reasonable to expect that the manifestation of the aspect would more resemble the Jupiterian rather than the Saturnian.

I considered the counter-argument that the sign which Saturn co-rules, Aquarius, is Air, while Jupiter's co-ruling sign, Pisces, is Water. Wouldn't Saturn's Air influence affect the aspect's manifestations, since it is in Air?

While the ominous implications may be true, Aquarius' coruler Saturn is less symbolic than Capricorn's Saturn of matters terminal and does not, like Capricorn, represent frugal, hard times, or sorrowful endings.

My conclusion: it might not hurt to try, Teddy. My studied, astrological conclusion was that an American President elected in 1980 would not necessarily die in office.

Hinkley came close to negating that conclusion. Will the association of Saturn with Air bring close calls in future Air conjunctions?

FUTURE PREDICTIONS: THE GRAY CLOUD LIFTS

The shift back to conservatism in general (astrologically, Saturn's influence) seems to have been a temporary tonic to the economy. Astrologers know that, while Saturn is all things conservative, Air is conducive to trade and brisk business. What suggests itself by the world economy during the time of the 1980 conjunction is an increasing tendency toward internationalization that will gradually pull world economic dominance away from the United States, perhaps toward a corporately-linked world economy.

The occurrence of the aspect in Water is a century away, so it would be ludicrous to speculate on what it will mean.

Are we rid of the fear of presidential death in office for at least another century, while the lessominous Air Element conjunctions of Jupiter and Saturn play out? In any case, are we rid of the worry in our own lifetime? Unfortunately, the answer is no.

Due to the Great Mutation, the next time Jupiter and Saturn are conjunct, around the Presidential Election of the year 2000, it will, for the last time for hundreds of years, occur in the mortal Element of Earth.

It is likely that the brief uplift the conservative surge brought to the economy in recent years will sag over the next four or five years. If so, it will weigh down the nation's economic infrastructure to the point where it is ready to cave in on itself.

It will be the sickness of the economy here that will drag us into the late '90s and give us the beleaguered one who will serve as president for a short while until forces outside himself, or his own health, bring him (or her) down.

Death and Depression—not a very pretty outlook, but one that must be heeded, especially when making economic decisions over the next several years.

The gray cloud lifts once and for all by the time of the 2020 election when the conjunction enters a century-long period that occurs in Air. The curse will be over.

Carolyn Chapman was essentially an old-fashioned reader who worked for private clients exclusively. Many of the predictions she made to me over the years came to pass. But it was the unexpected visit of Dr. Andrew

appeared standing next to the medium! "Oh how nice," Mrs. Chapman said. "That's my late husband paying me a visit."

He was never arrested and charged

I was flabbergasted! My late uncle Otto Stransky was a famous composer. When I knew him his wife, Alice, had gray hair, though from his memory, I suppose, she

Carolyn, Ethel, Sybil and Betty are over there now, on the Other Side where they must be regarded as very special people which indeed they were, and are.

Today, there is Yolana Lassaw, the New York medium, holding forth at the Le Triumphe apartments on East 58th Street. Her clientele ranges from ordinary housewives to Senators and movie stars. She has clairvoyance

as well as deep trance ability, and works frequently with various police departments (for free) trying to clear up unsolved crimes, or looking for missing persons. Her success percentage is impressive, as is the list of successful predictions she has made to me over the years since I first helped develop her gifts.

On January 11, 1979, Yolana stat-

ed that one Oriental country would invade another shortly. On February 17, China invaded Vietnam. On January 16, 1979, she spoke of a "terror ride on a train going to Coney Island." On February 26, a holdup man terrorized and victimized people on just such a train.

ROSANNA ROGERS

In Cleveland, Ohio, Rosanna Rogers—part Gypsy, part German—has her own cable television program dealing with psychic work. But her greatest talent lies in an in-depth interpretation of the ancient Tarot cards to an extent no other card reader has ever achieved. Rosanna has designed her own deck, even illustrated it herself, and ranks high in my estimation as a reliable and knowledgeable professional.

While recently re-listening to her tape recorded predictions going back several years, I realized how accurate she really was. Living in a very picturesque old house on Svec Avenue in Cleveland's less affluent area, she nevertheless gets a steady stream of clients coming back again and again for her card readings and "what's ahead" counsel.

serve as psychic tools, but she combines the cards with astrology and ESP in a unique blend of clairvoyance. In January 1983, she told me I would be divorced. It happened three years later. She foretold that I would be working with "overseas money" during the month of June...this is about to happen for 1990 in connection with a film. In 1986 she spoke of my getting a magazine-publishing contract. I did, in 1988.

Like all psychic readers, exact time eludes her, but events are clear. Astrologers who do not or should not predict results—only conditions to be expected, trends, situations, etc.—work differently because theirs is a mathematically based craft. Psychics use their emotions to probe the unknown, and in the dimension into which they reach, time as we understand it in the physical world simply does not exist.

PSYCHICS GET ONLY PART OF THE FUTURE

Based on many years of exploring this field, I believe that the reason why some psychic readers get part of the future but not all is due to a higher order of things which wants us to know only that which is good for us to know at any given time—noo more, no less. And that is as it should be.



INTIMATES THROUGH TIME: Edgar Cayce's Mysteries of Reincarnation By Jess Stearn Harper & Row, San Francisco, CA. Hardcover, 1989, 280 pcs., \$17.95

Here are recounted seven of Edgar Cayce's past lives, as Cayce himself remembered them during his sleeping or trance states. During these lives Cayce constantly struggled to overcome his carhal desires in favor of his spiritual development, not often succeeding until this last life.

According to this book, Cayce was quite a ladies' man in his past lives. Many of his past-life companions were with him again in this century, and I found it interesting to see the parts they played, jealousies laid to rest and how they all worked out the past relationships in their most recent lives.

The ladies who were involved with Cayce (past and present lives) remined me of the oldguard Spiritualists. In the book, the conversations about past lives and names, identities, etc. in those lives are nonchalant and casual, completely accepting. Interesting recollections were included like Cayce as Ra-Ta in ancient Egypt, fathering many children with specially chosen beautiful young women in a generating program in order to propagate a new, superior race. In this culture they practiced surgery to remove feathers, appendages, etc., to make people more beautiful and perfect.

There was some repetition of information about Cayce from Stearn's other books about him. If you are new to Cayce this will be helpful in understanding his background, but a repeat if you have read other Cayce material.

Stearn's retelling of Cayce's "readings" (psychic readings given on medical advice and answers to problems given while Cayce was in a sleeping or trance state) are easter to understand than in Cayce's own trance language.

There is so much wariness of channelers now, yet Cayce's information is readily accepted by many people. He evidently has proven himself by the sheer

number of verified medical healings, although his misses should not be overlooked.

Stearn doesn't offer any actual proof that these lives were indeed the past lives of Edgar Cayce. The very notion of past lives is still highly debatable. Nor is any proof offered here testifying to his successful healings.

Although I have read many books about Cayce and his teachings, Intimates Through Time was the most human.—Phyllis Galde

As the authors explain, this erroneous attitude is typical of much of our negative thinking about ourselves. This book reaffirmed that it's okay to be okay.— Alexander Keetle

It is said that all of the universe operates on vibrations, and that each number has a vibration.

This book is an in-depth look at the science of vibration numerology. More than just a book that helps you to figure out the value and meaning of your name, the authors delineate such areas as desire numbers, dormant numbers, self numbers, ability numbers, and others.

Many systems of character study, such as astrology and palmistry, while good, leave much to the subjective abilities of the interpreter. I like numerology because it is clear-cut, and there are fewer variables.

I also found useful the data sheets enclosed in the back of the book for ease in filling out pertinent number analyses.—Angela J. Jones

Coleman, after much research, has revealed the life of the enigmatic Slick, who was killed in his 40s in a mysterious plane crash, thereby ending an important era in cryptozology.

This is also the history of the abominable snowman, detailing all known factual data on it since its discovery in 1921. Included are reports on Marlin Perkins' and Sir Edmund Hillary's attempts to debunk its existence which resulted in halting further research on the hairy hominoid.

Coleman has carefully provided solid reports of explorers' and native Tibetans' experiences in the Himalayas with these mysterious creatures. Yetis are real.— Phullis Galde

A CHRISTIAN NATION?

While Ms. Jo Allers of Moab, Utah, may personally take issue with the U.S. being referred to as "a Christian Nation," (FATE, September 1989, "Report from the Readers") she does not apparently know it is! SHIFTY POLES

John Keel's "Beyond the Known" (FATE, September 1989) discusses the wandering of the magnetic poles. Of interest is the theory that the magnetic poles have actually reversed repeatedly throughout geologic history. As magma cools, iron bearing minerals align according to the magnetic field of the day and retain a weak, remmant magnetism.

Study of the remnant magnetism indicates when the magnetic pole reversals have occurred. The periods between the reversals are quite varied. The North magnetic pole can literally shift to become the South magnetic pole.

The current drift in the magnetic field is interesting but minor compared to full scale magnetic field reversals. The cause of these reversals is not yet known but speculated about.— Raumond U. Roberts, Norman, OK
