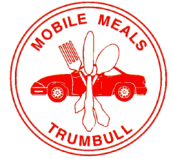

The Kitchen Corner:

Italian Sausage Kale Soup

Preparation time: 15 mins
Cook Time: 20 mins
Yield: 2 quarts

- 1 1/2 pounds Italian turkey sausage links, casings removed
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 8 cups chopped fresh kale
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes (optional)
- 1/2 cup white wine or chicken stock
- 1 carton (26 oz) chicken stock
- 1 can (15 oz) white kidney or cannellini beans, rinsed and drained

- Crumble sausage into a Dutch oven; add onion. Cook and stir over medium heat until the meat is no longer pink. Drain, reserving 1/4 cup drippings; set sausage aside. Sauté kale in reserved drippings until wilted. Add the garlic and, if desired, pepper flakes; cook for 1 minute. Add the wine; cook 2 minutes longer.
- Stir in the stock, beans, diced tomatoes, dried tomatoes, pepper and sausage mixture. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 15-20 minutes or until kale is tender. Enjoy!
