Foliar Spray: Apply two sprays, six weeks apart the first year, followed by annual application soon after first growth begins in Spring.

Arborvitae: Aphids, Bagworms, Mites — Mix 2 tsp. in 1/2 gallon of water, (4 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Azaleas: Lace bugs, Leaf miners, Mites, Tea scale, White flies — Mix 1 tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (2 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Birch: Aphids, Leaf miners — Mix ½ tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (1 Tbs. in 3 gals.). For Leaf miners, apply when leaves are expanded (about mid-May) and repeat in early July. Paint Method: For Leafminers, undiluted DRAGON® CYGON® 2E Systemic Insecticide can be painted on the bark of the tree, which then absorbs the chemical into its "system" and carries it to the leaves with the sap. Cypress: Bactra moth larvae — Mix 1 tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (2 Tbs. in 3 gals.). Apply as a drenching spray.

Day Lilies: Aphids, Thrips — Mix 2 tsp. in 1/2 gallon of water, (4 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Euonymus: Aphids, Scale — Mix 1 tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (2 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Fiscus Nitidia: Thrips — Mix 1 tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (2 Tbs. in 3 gals.). DO NOT use on potted plants.

Gardenias: Tea scale, White flies — Mix 1 tsp. in ½ gailon of water, (2 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Gerberas: Thrips — Mix 1 tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (2 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Gladiolus: Aphids, Thrips — Mix 1 tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (2 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Iris: Aphids, Iris borer, Thrips — Mix 1 tsp. in ½ gals. of water, (2 Tbs. in 3 gals.). For <u>Borer</u> control, spray when new leaves are 5-6 inches tall.

Oak: Golden oak scale — Mix 2 tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (4 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Pine, Juniper: Aphids, Bagworms, European pine shoot moth, Midges, Mites, Nantucket pine tip moth, Zimmerman pine moth — Mix 2 tsp. in ½ gallon of water, (4 Tbs. in 3 gals.).

Potatoes (0), Tomatoes (7) — Aphids, Leafhoppers, Leaf miners — Mix $\frac{2}{3}$ -1 $\frac{1}{3}$ tsp. per gal. of water.
