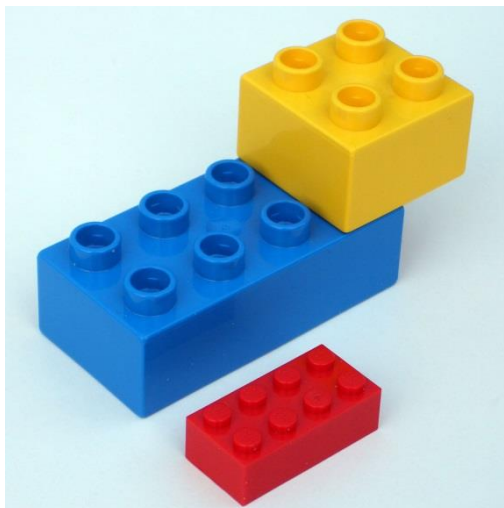

1. First Year modules for students of Stage 1 BA Humanities – English, Drama and Film pathway

Incoming Stage One BA English, Drama and Film Students



REGISTRATION KEY DATES: (provisional – check the UCD Registry website to confirm these dates - <http://www.ucd.ie/students/keydates.htm>)

From **23 August 2018 Step 1 of online registration** begins for all incoming CAO Stage 1 students. In Step 1, you will complete personal information, upload photo for Student Card, pay fees. Incoming CAO students can normally begin Step1 of online registration within three working days of accepting their CAO offer.

On **29 August 2018** between 8.00am and 1.00pm you will **book your Registration Start Time** (a time specific to you at which you can begin to register for your Stage 1 modules). Confirmation of your Start Time for module registration will be sent to your UCD email.

From 30 August 2018 Step 2 – Module Registration begins for all incoming CAO Stage 1 students. Check your UCD email for confirmation of your Start Time.

* In addition to taking modules within the School of English, Drama, Film and Creative Writing, you can take a General Elective module in Semester Two, which is a Stage One module in any subject area.

STAGE ONE English, Drama and Film - IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE:

- All Stage One modules in DN530 BA Humanities are worth five credits each
- You will need **60 credits altogether** at Stage One (i.e. 12 modules in total)
- You have a better chance of success if you **balance your workload** so that you take six modules in each semester (rather than taking five in one semester and seven in the other).
