I. Course Overview: Level 1 – የኮርስ መ ግቢያ - ኣንደኛ ደረጃ

Amharic is the national language of Ethiopia, spoken by over 22 million people and many millions more Ethiopians and others around the world. The Beginning Amharic course provides basic skills in conversation, reading and writing in Amharic. The course utilizes communicative and immersive language learning method where minimal English is used in the classroom.

Students will learn to read and write using the Geez alphabet, and practice applied linguistics using relational conversations relating to daily social activities pertaining to personal and family activities, hospitality, business, education and other relevant routine discussion topics as they immerse themselves into the Amharic language.

II. Course Learning Objectives: Level 1 - የኮርሱ የትምህርት ዓላጣዎች: ኣንደኛ ደረጃ

The primary objective of the Elementary Amharic course is to enable students develop basic conversation, reading and writing skills that will enable them engage with other Amharic speakers in their communities. By means of the language learning, students will also gain fundamental understanding of the social and culture environments that will enable them to engage in education activities and become productive members of the society. At the end of the course students will develop basic language skills that will enable them to converse, read and write at basic levels and engage in community service.

After completing the course students should be able to:

- Read and write basic Amharic using the Geez script in digital, and manual formats
- Understand basic sentence structures, vocabulary and grammar of the Amharic language

- Apply the acquired language skills to further academic studies to further personal educational advancement and social engagement



V. Class Participation / Attendance Expectations - ከተማሪዎች የሚጠበቅ መሳተፍና ውይይት 50%

Reading, writing, speaking, active class participation and discussion are the core component of the course. Regular attendance and punctuality is a requirement. Attendance grade will be zero for any day of class missed since there won't be any criteria for evaluating your class performance for that day. If you must miss class, it is your responsibility to notify your instructor and find out what you missed. Classes are structured to be interactive, intended to model real world scenario conversations and applied communications. Class activities may involve presentations and demonstrations of real-world situations that people experience on a regular basis. As an immersive language class, it is expected and highly recommended that in class students carry out conversations and formal discussions in Amharic only.

VI. Weekly Assignments - ሳምንታዊ ስራዎች: (20%)

Every week students are assigned to work on hand-writing, reading and speaking assignments based on the weekly activities and levels of engagements. Assignment levels and scope include writing alphabets, words and sentences consisting that will allow students to engage in Amharic language conversation.

VII. Midterm Exam - ያጋማሽ ፈተና (10%)

Midterm Exam consists of the concepts and activities covered in Weeks 1-4 and compiling and editing the weekly deliverables to tell a story about the students' activities and learning interests.

VIII. Final Exam - የመጨረሻ ፈተና: (20%)

The Final Exam consists of the interactions, concepts and activities covered in Weeks 6-9 and compiling and editing the weekly deliverables to tell a story about the students' activities and educational goals.
