



Change of Doing Business indicators from 2012 to 2018




Proximity to Operations

Visa-free regime

Ukraine's migration policy allows citizens of 69 countries to use a visa-free regime. Visa is not required for a stay of up to 90 days within a 180-day period for EU, UK, USA, UAE, Canada, etc.

Other countries must get the Ukrainian visa to enter the country. For certain countries a simplified visa application process is available.

E-visa

Since April 2018 foreigners-holders of passports of 44 specified countries* may apply for Ukraine's electronic visa (e-Visa). Single entry tourist or business visa valid for up to 30 days.



Visas upon arrival in airports

Foreigners holding passports of these 31 countries** may apply for their single-entry short-term (C type) 15-day tourist or business visas on arrival at "Boryspil" / "Kyiv (Zhuliany)" / "Odesa" international airports.







Office Property Market

The office property market in major cities of Ukraine has overcome the crisis due to economic recovery and increased demand for new office space, particularly by IT-sector and BPO companies, resulting in a significant decrease in vacancy. Nevertheless, in view of the improved market dynamics, many developers are now increasingly considering new development projects in major cities of Ukraine.

Methodology

In this report, we chose to focus on Ukrainian potential and competitive advantages as a destination for an SSC/BPO. We highlighted the following factors that play a vital role when considering opening or relocating an SSC/BPO: an overview of air logistics (proximity to operations),

the labor market as compared with other CEE countries, and an office market analysis. We selected five of the largest Ukrainian cities for providing background information.
