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To save on ink - change your print quality on your printer to fast.


To do:

Click print - properties - change print quality from standard to fast.

This will give you a lower quality page but will save on ink.


Under the Sea Lapbook

- Print up the cover sheet onto white card stock.
- Have children color and cut out.
- Add Under the Sea label and picture to a piece of blue card stock and trim the blue card stock. (See picture below).
- Cut the under the sea label in half, and attach to both sides of the lap book, so that when the lap book is closed, the label connects.
- Add picture to the front of the lap book. (You will apply glue or double sided tape to only the left side of the blue card stock so the lap book opens.)



Draw a line to the beginning letter of each




Storage for What Lives Under the Sea?

- Make a pocket for book by using a piece of blue card stock.
- Measure the width you want and cut it down.
- Using double sided tape on both sides and bottom of blue card stock, attach to the bottom.
- Tape or glue the octopus and coral pictures to the back of the lapbook.





Glue or tape to the back of the lapbook. (On the pocket you make). Make a pocket out of card stock to store I See Monsters book.





Under the Sea Counting


- Print up on regular copy paper.
- Have children count each square, write the number of sea animals, color and cut out.
- Place in order and staple to make a counting book.
- Attach to the inside of the under the sea lapbook using double-sided tape or glue.




Print up on regular copy paper

- Print up on white card stock.
- Have children color their fish, along with the fin, draw an eye and cut out all pieces.

(The square with the fish, fin, eye and fish facts).

- On the fin there is a dotted line fold on the line.
- Glue the fish facts onto the fish.
- Put glue on the small folded section of the fin. And place it over the fish facts. You will want to make sure the dish facts are covered by the fin.
- Glue on eye and draw a smile using a black magic marker.
- Glue the rectangle with the finished fish to the inside of the under the sea lapbook.







Fin Cut out – Fold on the dotted line.


Fun Under the Sea Facts Flip Book


- Print up the following 3 sheets onto regular copy paper.
- Trim and place in order staple at top to create a flip book.
- Using double sided tape or glue attach to inside of lapbook.














Under the Sea Flip Book


- Print up the following sheet onto regular copy paper.
- Trim
- Attach to a flipbook and attach to the inside of the lapbook. Right hand side.

Dimensions for the flipbook:

3 sheets of card stock 9 1/2 inch by 3 1/2 inch. (Cut out 2 strips with one color cardstock and 1 strip using another color of cardstock. Put together.






Vocabulary Words and Picture Cards Directions:


Copy the vocabulary words onto white card stock. B & W set - color - cut out the picture cards on the black line.


Additional idea: Print up 2 copies for each child, trim and let them use as a memory game.






Print up on white card stock. Color - Cut out leaving white border around the picture. Punch holes with a hole punch. Have children lace using lacing string.





Pocket for Lacing Cards. - Trim and attach to lapbook. See picture for placement.



What Sea Animal am I?


- Print up the following sheet onto white card stock.
- Have children color and cut out.
- Fold each sea animal description strip in half with the sea animal description in front.
- Take a scissors and cut on the dotted line. This is where the tab will slip into when closed. (Have an adult cut on the dotted line).
- Have children read the description and glue the matching sea animal inside the strip.
- Attach to lapbook.



	What sea animal am I?	
Fold in half - glue this side. Place in lapbook	I have 4 pair of arms – thought some people would say I have 8 legs. I have 3 hearts and I am a very fast swimmer.	

What sea animal am I?	
There are over 4500 species of me. I have a distinct sideways walk and I communicate with others of my kind by drumming or waving my pinchers.	

What sea animal am I?	
I have the name of a land animal in my name but I am not related to one. I don't swim very well but rely on my dorsal fin to help me move. I swim upright and that is very different from other aquatic life.	






Squid

Squid have gills just like fish. They are often mistaken for octopus. While they two are similar they are different types of creatures.

Every squid features three hearts. They also move through the water tail first instead of head first.

Some of the larger squid can weigh more than 1,000 pounds.

Book comes in 2 formats


- With dotted words

Print first 2 sheets back to pack. Fold in 1/2.


Print up last 2 pages back to back. Fold in $\frac{1}{2}$ and place inside the cover.

Staple if desired. (You will need a longer stapler in order to do this. Can be purchased at Office Max or other office supply store).


