# What is a Program?

"A **group** of **related projects, subprograms**, and **program activities** that are managed in a **coordinated way** to obtain **benefits** not available from managing them individually."

# What is Program Management?

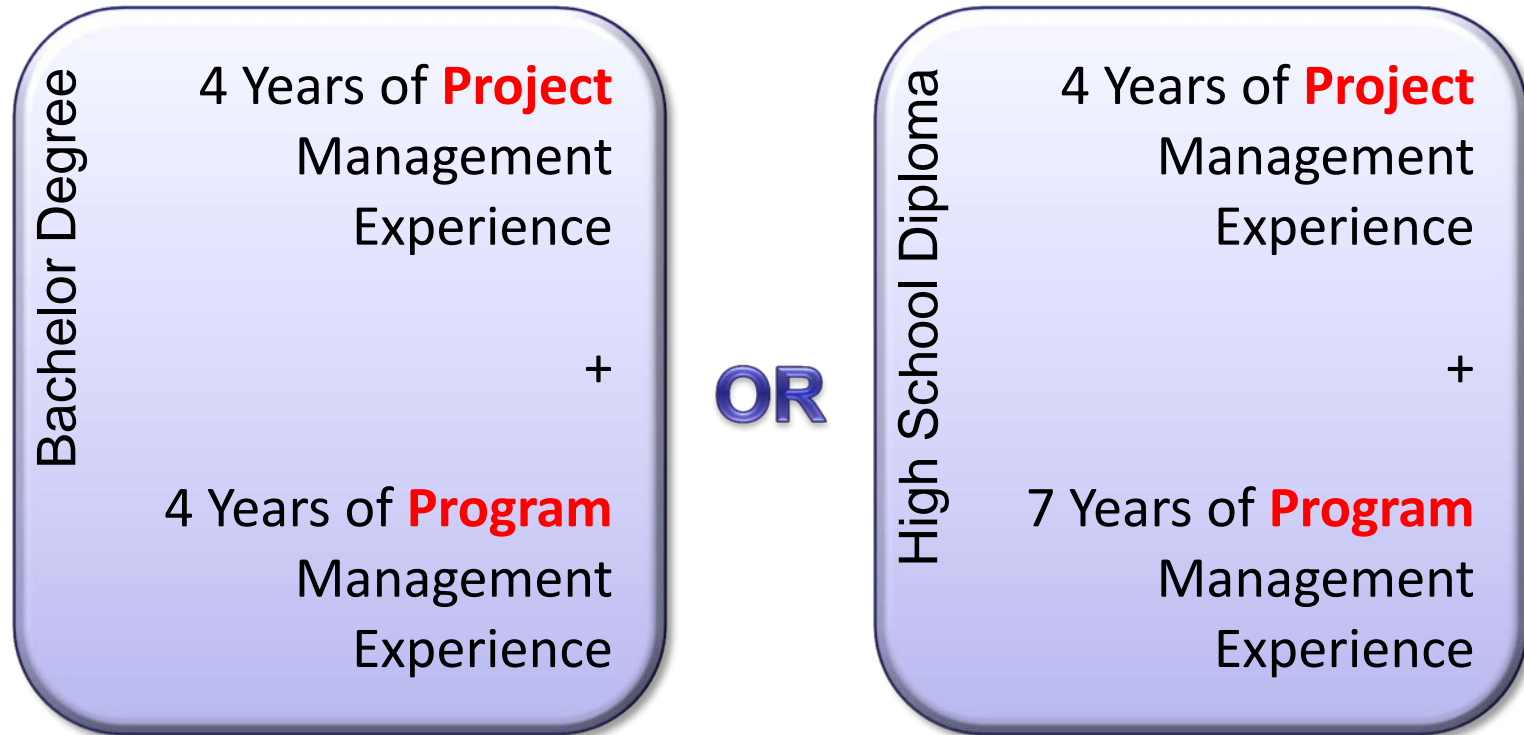
*"Program management is the **application of knowledge, skills, tools, and techniques** to a program to meet the **program requirements** and to obtain **benefits and control** not available by managing projects individually."*

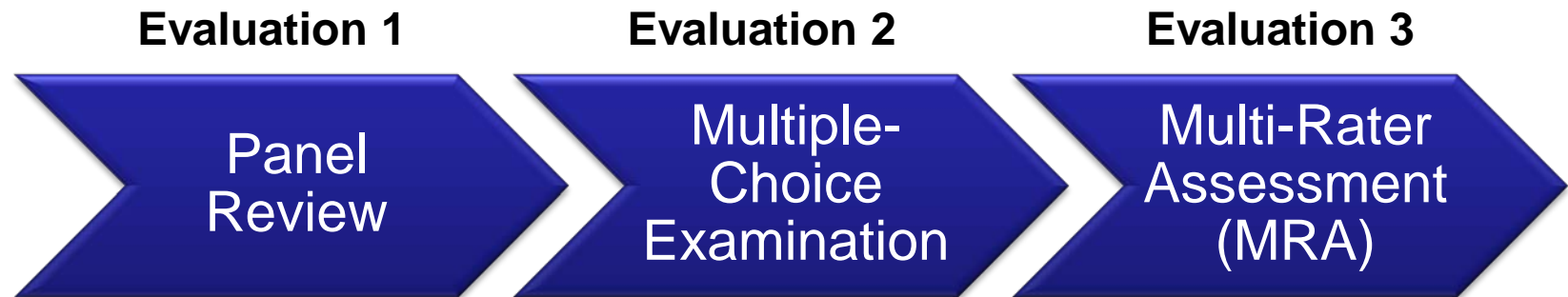

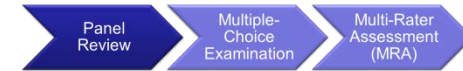

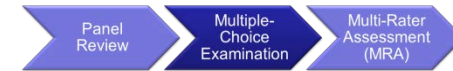


## Evaluation 1—Panel Review:

- Demonstrate your work as an experienced program manager
- Describe in <350 words your program management experience in each of the following domains:
  1. Strategic Program Management
  2. Benefits Realization
  3. Stakeholders Management
  4. Governance
  5. Program Life Cycle
- Composed by Program Management Experts – PgMP’s

# PgMP Credentialing Process



## Evaluation 2—Multiple-Choice Examination:

- 170 Questions (20 unscored) in 4 hours
- Exam structure:
  - Domain 1 – Strategic Program Management: 25 Questions, 15%
  - Domain 2 – Program Life Cycle: 75 Questions, 44%
  - Domain 3 – Benefits Management: 19 Questions, 11%
  - Domain 4 – Stakeholders Management: 27 Questions, 16%
  - Domain 5 – Governance: 24 Questions, 14%
- Scores: Proficient, Moderately Proficient, Below Proficient
- Results: **PASSED** or **FAILED**

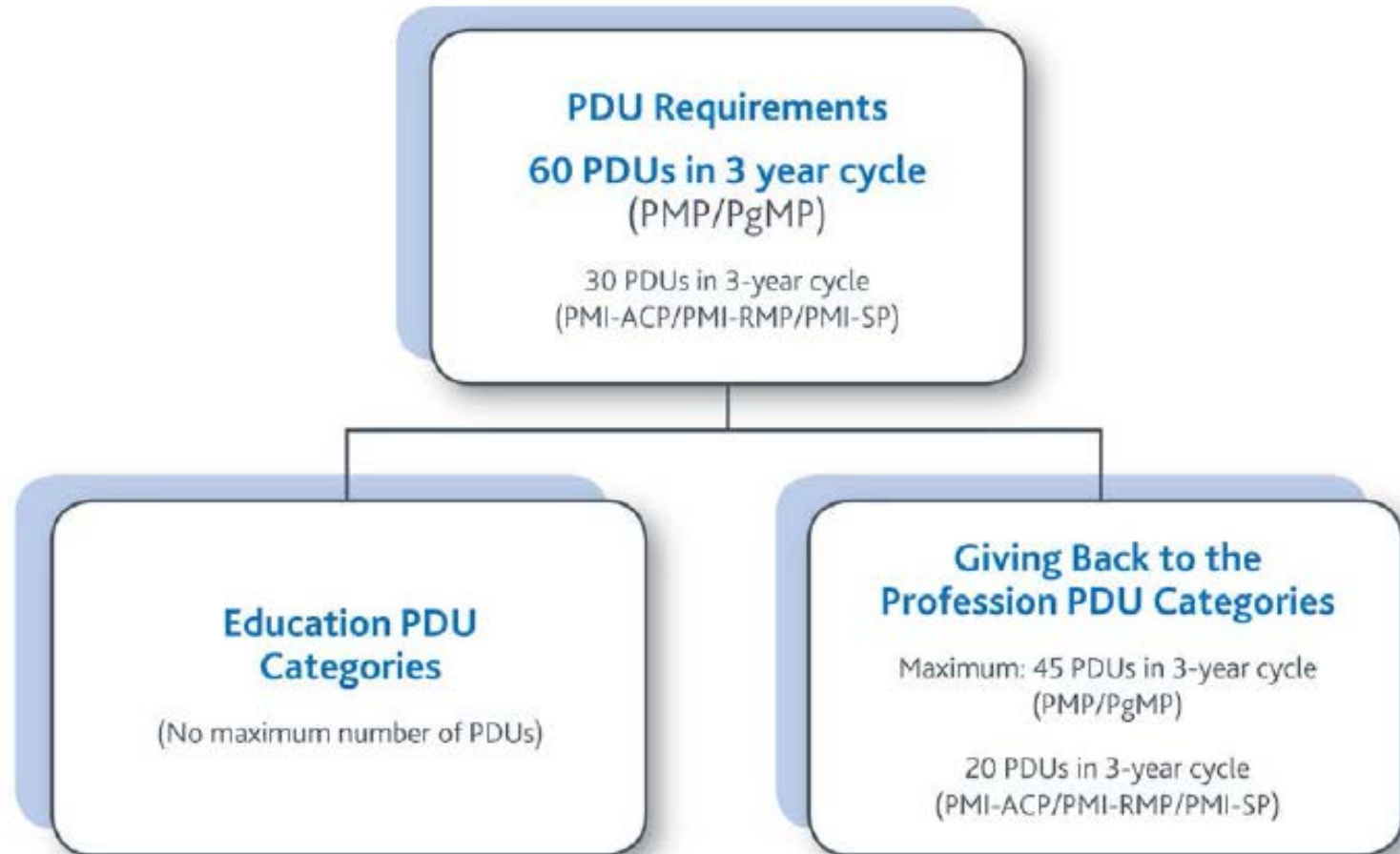
# PgMP Credentialing Process



## Evaluation 3—Multi-Rater Assessment (MRA):

- Similar to a 360-degree review process
- 12 reference contacts to review your competence as a program manager + 1 Self Evaluation:
  - 4 Above Level: Persons to whom you report
  - 4 At Level: Someone with the same/similar level of you
  - 4 Below Level: Project managers/Reports (direct or matrixed)
- 44 statements to be responded by you and by your evaluators
- Results: **PASSED** or **FAILED**

## Lessons Learned

- Be prepared to be audited – high rate of audited applications
- Be clear and consistent while answering your Panel Review questions
- Respond the questions using first person – avoid “textbook” responses
- Read the **Standard** at least **five times** – thinking as you read
- Do not try to memorize the ITTO’s, try to understand instead
- Read the **PMBOK Guide 5<sup>th</sup> Edition** at least once
- Understand the **PMI PgMP<sup>®</sup> Examination Content Outline**

## Lessons Learned

- Take practice tests – see your weak areas and review the material
- Reserve at least 3-4 hours per day during approximately 3 months
- Undertake a PgMP Prep Course – not mandatory, but it helps a lot
- Control your time during the exam – do not waste time in one question
- Inform at least 1 extra evaluator in each category – risk management
- Understand the boundaries between projects and programs
- PMI will work individually with every PgMP applicant, so use it
